TO : Commanding General, USAFFE, APO 501, through Chief,
 Claims Service, USAFFE, APO 923.

1. In 1942, as a cooperative gesture, I offered the services of this office to the end of relieving the then fully occupied headquarters of the United States Army Forces in Australia of the administrative burden of settling claims arising under the provisions of new legislation now embraced within AR 25-90. Subsequently, upon request, this office assumed a similar burden respecting claims arising under the provisions of AR 25-100. It is believed that the time has now arrived when administrative efficiency demands that the settling of claims should cease being a function of this office.

2. Foreign Claims Commission No. 30, which has been doing the above described work in the claims field in this office, will soon lose one of its members, Colonel Albert M. Barron, J.A.G.D. Instead of replacing him by a new member the time appears to be propitious for the relief of this office from this field by the appointment of a new claims commission. It is recommended that this be done and that Claims Commission No. 30 conclude its work by processing such claims as remain in its hands, whereupon the Commission's files will be transferred to the office of the Chief, Claims Service, or such other place as you may desire.

3. Upon the cessation of claims work in this office there will be available for transfer to the Claims Service, USAFFE, Captain Edwin G. Sale, J.A.G.D., should he be desired. Captain Sale was sent to this office by The Judge Advocate General upon request as an expert in the field of claims embraced within the provisions of AR 25-100. His services have been invaluable in this connection and I unhesitatingly recommend him.

1. By direction of the Commander-in-Chief, Southwest Pacific Area, pursuant authority WD Ltr AG 153 (22 May 44) OB-P-WDCDS-MP-M, 12 July 1944, Subject, "Claims of military personnel and civilian employees of War Department or Army for damage to or loss, destruction, capture, or abandonment of personal property in service", Foreign Claims Commission No. 30, Melbourne, Victoria, Australia, composed of Brigadier General Ernest H. Burt, C-4196, U.S. Army, Colonel Elbert M. Barron, C-217679, JAGD, and Lieutenant Colonel Paul W. Dudley, C-281532, JAGD, is designated and authorized to settle claims of military personnel and of civilian personnel and of civilian employees of the War Department or of the Army for private property lost, damaged, destroyed, captured, or abandoned in the military service under the provisions of the Act of 4 March 1921 (41 Stat. 1436; 31 U.S.C. 218-222), as amended by section 6 of the Act of 3 July 1943 (57 Stat. 374; 31 U.S.C. 222a-222b), and AR 25-100.

2. No claim will be approved under this delegation in an amount in excess of \$1,000. When it appears that a claim should be approved in excess of that amount the claim and related papers will be forwarded to The Judge Advocate General, Washington 25, D.C.

3. Reports required by above referenced letter will be forwarded by Claims Commission No. 30 direct to The Judge Advocate General as therein prescribed, copies of which will be sent to Chief, Theater Claims Service, this headquarters.
