6 October 1945

Left Yokohama 1100 for Tachikawa Air Field
Arrived there 1450. Quartered and rationed.

7 October 1945

Left Tachikawa Field for Okinawa 1340 in a C-46
but turned back after flying one hour
because of bad weather.

8 October 1945

Waiting for weather to clear up - at Tachikawa

9 October 1945

15 October 1945

Left Yontan Airstrip Okinawa 0800 - Arrived
Nielson Field Manila 0200 - Reported to QM
Manila 2100. Rationed and quartered.

homeless citizens of Nagasaki team returned to Hq 27th Div.

1 October 1945

Received orders promoting Pts Grigware and Harms to Pfc - Prepared report on Tokyo Sub-camp No 4 (Nagoezu) and submitted ~~all~~ records found there to GHQ - Made plans to return to Nagasaki to inspect Pow Camp there.

3 October 1945

Capt Holroyd, Lt Inashima, Sgt Fredricks & Pfc Harms proceeded to Nagasaki to inspect two camps in that city - Inspected both and returned to Hq 27th Inf Div - Received orders to return to Rec Pers Det for duty (all both Lt Inashima).

4 October 1945

Prepared reports on T. K. b. Camp No 3 & Dispatch Camp of T. Kyo Sub-Camp No 3 at Nagasaki. Lt Inashima received orders to report to GHQ Advanced Echelon for duty - Capt Holroyd, Sgt Fredricks and Pfc Harms and Grigware departed from Niigata at 2120 by rail for Tokyo and Yokohama.

5 October 1945

Arrived Tokyo 0800 - Called Hq 8th Army for transportation to Yokohama - Jeep arrived 1000 - Team arrived at Yokohama 1205 - Quartered and rationed.

POW Camps in this area. - Capt Holroyd, Lt Iwashina and Sgt Fredricks again inspected Tokyo Camps 5 and 15 picking up additional records and information.

28 September 1945

Information on Tokyo Camps No 5 and 15 were assembled and reports on each prepared. - Capt Holroyd and Lt Iwashina, ~~inspected~~ Sgt Fredricks, & Pvt Grigware inspected camp for Chinese laborers (not interviewees, but contracted laborers) - Report made to 27th Div.

29 September 1945

Capt Holroyd, Lt. Iwashina, Sgt. Fredricks, 9 Pts. Genigware ⁴Haines ~~inspected~~ Tokyo Sub-Camp No 16. (by train) (Kanose) picking up records - Pvt. Hiroshi Azuma, Camp Commandant was interviewed and gave all information he had. - Also inspected Showa Denko Kabushiki Kaisha, plant where Pots worked.

30 September 1945

Prepared report on Tokyo Sub-Camp No 16 inspected 29 Sept 45 and submitted it to GHQ - Re-submitted report on Chinese camp to HQ 27th Div. - Planned inspection of Tokyo Sub-Camp No 4.

1 October 1945

Capt Holroyd, Lt Iwashina, ^{Yoshida} Sgt Fredricks, & Pvt Grigware proceeded ^{by} to Naectsu and inspected Tokyo Sub-Camp No 4 (Naectsu) and interviewed Nobuyuki Sugimoto, Naectsu Chief of Police for information about this camp - Then proceeded to Nagakita to inspect camp there. - Getting dark & POW Camp occupied by

22 September 1945

Recovery Team attached to the Americal Division reported and were given details as to what had been done and remained to be done in this area. - Began packing equipment for proposed move of 27th Div.

23 September 1945

Prepared Report of Personnel and Equipment for move to Niiigata and submitted it to Special Troops. Continued packing.

24 September 1945

Prepared reports of activities to date - continued packing - Maj Davies & Sgt Heathcote received orders to return to Manila and left the team to day. - Capt Holroyd, Lt. Inashina, Sgt Fredricks, and Pts. Gerigware & Barnes left Hiratsuka for Niiigata by train at 1545 (with Hq Co 27th Div).

25 September 1945

Arrived at Niiigata at 0605 and were assigned to quarters.

26 September 1945

Prepared map of new area of occupation of 27th Div. with Pow Camp locations - Capt Holroyd, Lt. Inashina, Sgt Fredricks, & Pts. Gerigware located and inspected Tokyo Camp No 5 and Tokyo Camp No 15 outside Niiigata and interviewed police stationed at these camps.

27 September 1945.

Capt Holroyd & Lt Inashina questioned Major Sadaya Seio of the Kempei Tai about the

POW Camps in this area. - Capt Holroyd, Lt Iwashina and Sgt Fredricks again inspected Tokyo Camps No 5 and 15 picking up additional records and information.

28 September 1945

Information on Tokyo Camps No 5 and 15 were assembled and reports on each prepared. - Capt Holroyd and Lt Iwashina, ~~inspected~~ Sgt Fredricks, & Pfc Grigware inspected camp for Chinese laborers (not internees, but contracted laborers) Rpt made to 27th Div.

29 September 1945

Capt Holroyd, Lt. Iwashina, Sgt. Fredricks, 9 Pfc's Grigware & ⁹Hanes ~~inspected~~ Tokyo Sub-Camp No 16 (by train) (Kawase) picking up ^{no} records - Pfc Hiroshi Azuma, Camp Commandant was interviewed and gave all information he had. - Also inspected Showa Denko Kabushiki Kaisha, plant where POWs worked.

30 September 1945

Prepared report on Tokyo Sub-Camp No 16 inspected 29 Sept 45 and submitted it to GHQ - Re-submitted report on Chinese camp to HQ 27th Div. - Planned inspection of Tokyo Sub-Camp No 4.

1 October 1945

Capt Holroyd, Lt Iwashina, Sgt Fredricks, 7 Pfc's Grigware proceeded ^{by train} to Naoetsu and inspected Tokyo Sub-camp No 4 (Naoetsu) and interviewed ~~to~~ Nabuyuki Sugimoto, Naoetsu Chief of Police for information about this camp - Then proceeded to Nagazaka to inspect camp there. - Getting dark & POW Camp occupied by

17 September 1945

Internment Camp No 1 was drawn up.

18 September 1945

Tec 3 Minoru Inashima (interpreter for Recovery Team No 8) Commissioned 2nd Lt Aos. - Routine duties.

19 September 1945

Maj Davies, Sgt Fredricks, Sgt Heethote and
Pvt Brigware proceeded to Miyazoshita and
Sengoku-Kogen, Nakano Province. - Stopped at
the home of the Bamentines and prepared
Reports of Recovery and Affidavit for Mr. Bert
Bamentine. - stopped at the residence
of the Sisters of the Precious Blood and
prepared new affidavits for Sisters St
Anne and Gertrude who now desire
repatriation to the U.S. - Returned to 17
2nd Inf Div, Hinaboku

20 September 1945

Capt Holroyd proceeded to Yokohama to check
procedure for evacuation of recoverees
approved - Capt Holroyd, Sgt Fredricks &
Heethote proceeded to Sengoku-Kogen to
inform Mrs Bamentine and children and
Sisters St Anne and Gertrude to be prepared
to move to Yokohama at 0900 31 Sept 45 and
then returned.

21 September 1945

Capt Holroyd departed for Sengoku-Kogen with
two jeeps and trailers to evacuate the
Bamentine family of three and Sisters St Anne
and Gertrude to Yokohama. --- Capt Holroyd
saw the above mentioned recoverees off to Hwangi
Airfield and returned.

14 September 1945 (cont.)

Inashima proceeded to Seigoku-Kogen, Hakone Province with food and Red Cross Kits for three Catholic nuns and for the Canadian family - Processed the Samaritine family (Canadian) of mother and two children (daughter 16 and son 12). - Proceeded to Miyanoshita and interviewed several civilians with reference to recovery - Proceeded to Atami in search of a prisoner of war camp, failed to find same and returned to Hinatsuka.

15 September 1945

Capt Holroyd contacted Canadian Recovery Team at Yokohama to get clearance for the Samaritine family. - Set up office in CIC building of Hq. 27th Inf Div.

16 September 1945

Capt Holroyd, Maj Davies, Sgt Inashima, & Pte Hermes proceeded to Miyanoshita, Hakone, & Hinatsuka Village where an investigation was made to locate Furoshi (Fuji) PW Camp with no success. - Passed through Gotohara, Yamakita and to Uchiyama and located Yamakita Internment Camp No. 1. Investigated Camp, located two graves - Complete report is being made and pictures of camp area are ^{to be} taken. - Returned to Hq. 27th Inf Div area.

17 September 1945

Pte Hermes proceeded to Hq. 8th Army to check on pow camp locations and recoveries, etc. - A rough draft of atrocities, etc at Yamakita

9 September 1945

Awaiting assignment and transportation.

10 September 1945

Assigned to Yokohama Dock area.

11 September 1945

Left Hiratsuka at 0750 - Arrived Yokohama 0835.
Assigned to porters and had recovered personnel processing explained.

12 September 1945

Instructed in recovery processing at Yokohama dock area. - Left Yokohama dock area 1310 - Arrived Hq 8th Army 1330 - Left Hq 8th Army 1430 - Arrived at Hq 27th Inf Div 1530.

13 September 1945

Maj Davies, Capt Holroyd, Sgt Frederick and Inashima left for Miyazoshita to process recoverees. - proceeded to Sengoku-Hakone Province and processed three Catholic nuns (Am, Br, & Fr) who did not desire repatriation - Returned to Miyazoshita after locating a Canadian family of four - At Miyazoshita processed two civilians (1 Am and 1 Italian) - Proceeded to Hakone in search of a convalescent Pow Camp - Did not locate camp at Hakone and returned to Hiratsuka. - Accomplished necessary rosters, etc.

14 September 1945

Maj Davies, Capt Holroyd, Sgt Frederick, Capt.

30 August 1945

Equipment assigned to CG Plane No. 8 - Personnel
to Plane No. 10. . Placed on 24-hr alert

31 August 1945

Routine duties

Arrived at Air Field at Atsugi, Japan 1330 and were
assigned to quarters in Hiratsuka.

8 September 1945

Awaiting assignment and transportation.

22 August 1945 (cont.)

Maps of area in which team will operate were obtained and studied.

23 August 1945

Procured future disposition of troops in Yokohama Area from G-3 and located Pow Camps in that Area as closely as possible - Submitted information concerning Pow Camps to G-1 for incorporation in a Memorandum to be given to Commanders of all units in the divisions.

24 August 1945

Routine duties. New occupation zone of 27th Div plotted on Recovery Maps and Pow Camps in that area located.

25 August 1945

Routine duties.

26 August 1945

Maj Daries and Capt Holroyd attended a meeting at 8th Army Hq. and discussed Recovery of Pow Procedure with officers of that Hq.

27 August 1945

Routine Duties.

28 August 1945

Routine Duties. Reviewed recovery processing procedure.

29 August 1945

Staff and the Division Surgeon.

20 August 1945

Capt Holroyd contacted CIC officer. —
Submitted data for airborne movement to
Hq Commandant. Capt Holroyd met the
Commanding General of the Division and
discussed procedures for repatriation.
Estimated number and strength of PW camps
in Yokohama Area from information found in
Manual on Location and Strengths Prisoners
of War and Civilian Internment Camps in
Japan (GHQ AFPPAC Miss-X Section).

Australian Recovery Team consisting of
Maj Davies, Sjt Heathcote (Aust) and
^{Tec 3} ~~Sgt~~ Inashima (USA) joined organization.

21 August 1945

Routine office work.

22 August 1945

Capt Holroyd and Maj Davies contacted the Chaplain
and the photographic officer of the organization.
