Lt. Carlson's team # 52 joined us
this date. He was placed in
command per orders.

24 Sept. '45

Visited and searched Shinagawa Camp
and Omori Ward camp with Lt. Carlson's
Team. Records found and sent in.
Shinagawa had a large stock of GI
clothing under lock and key.
Omori Camp had been cleaned
out to be used as a camp for
Jap P.O.W.'s
Team #43, Lt. Penders, checked in.

25 Sept. '45

visited Japanese GHQ along with Lt. Carlson and Lt. Pender. Directed to Lt. Gen. Tamura and Maj Gen Ueda. A lengthy discussion ensued the results nil. Apparently anxious to help - we got little from them but bows. He (Gen. Tamura) directed us to a Lt. Col. Sakaba who was not to be found on arrival. Apparently Gen. Tamura had lied to us in that we were told that he had phoned Col. Sakaba and that he was there to help us. When we reached Omyo Main Camp, the Col. was not to be found. Nor were any telephones operative in the Camp.

26 Sept. '45

Unable to contact Lt. Col. Sakaba
Made an appointment to meet him
0930 27 Sept. '45.

Visited St. Mary's Hospital
Due to illness this officer did
little this date

Visited Takatanobaba and found totally
destroyed.
