Status of ROTC cadets at the Ateneo de Cagayan, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental (See below) 26 Nov 52

- 1. Basis for this memorandum is "Memorandum" of Walter B. Lang, Chief, Religious Claims Section dated 16 Oct 52.
- 2. The names or identities of 35 ROTC cadets at the Atence de Cagayan, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental, allegedly training under Major Ferry Baldmin from 8 Dec 41 to 1 Mar 42 have not been established for the reason that the same have not been furnished by the requesting agency, and because there are no archives on this ROTC unit in this headquarters.
  - 3. An extensive research conducted on the case revealed:
- a. That the "Reserve Officer's Training Corps" of the Atoneo de Cagayan "was ordered to take up residence in the college gymnasium," on 8 December 1941, as indicated in the book "GUERRIIIA PADRE in Mindance" by Father Edward Haggarty (Page 4, par 1). However, no mention was made as to the length of time the RUTC cadets remained in the Atoneo gymnasium and/or when the cadets were ordered out of the gymnasium or the Atoneo premises,
- b. That the Commandant of the ROTC unit of the Ateneo de Cagayan was 1st Lt Wanuel de P. Peralta 0-37538. His military service, as indicated in his Form 23 are as follows:
  - 1 Jul 41 27 Dec 41 Commandant, ROTC Unit, Ateneo de Cagayan, Cagayan, Misamis Oriental - Col A. Garcia
  - 28 Dec 41 Inducted into USAFFE Tagoloan, Mis. Or.-Lt James J. Messmer 29 Dec 41 - 14 Jan 42 - CO, Labor Pool Co, 102nd Inf -
  - Cagayan Lt Gestoso
    15 Jan 42 13 Feb 42 Hq 101st Div; on dy Prov Bn,
    101st Div Kibawe, Bukidnon Gen Vachon
  - 14 Feb 42 30 May 42 CO, A Co, Motorized, 101st Div Sp Unit - Aroman, Cotabato

In an affidavit dated 12 January 1944, Lt Feralta, among other things, testifies: "... That various former cadets of the NOTO, Ateneo de Cagayan, who are now commissioned officers of the USFIF can also testify

as to the veracity of my promotion to Second Lieutenant, namely: It Patriciano Destajo, G-3, 109th Div: Lt Vic Gaabucayan, 1st Bn. 11th Inf: Lt Honorio Villaranda, 109th Inf Regt....

- c. An examination of 201 files of ROTC cadets mentioned by Lt Peralta revealed that Lt Victorino Gaabucayan and Lt Patriciano Destajo were both reservists by virtue of their having completed the prescribed ROTC training prior to the outbreak of war. Whereas, Lt Honorio G. Villaranda claimed no USAFFE service, although records on file indicate that Villaranda was "ROTC Basic Course Graduate" after having completed the "Special two & a Half months Cadre Training (ROTC) from Dec. 1941 to Jan. 1942, at the Ateneo de Cagayan.
- d. That an extensive 201 file examination of members of units of the 101st and 102nd Divisions, USAFFE, and the 10th MD guerrillas was conducted in an effort to establish the identities of cadets of the Ateneo de Cagayan ROTC with negative results.
- 4. On the basis of records of Lt Honorio Villaranda and reference to Father Haggarty's "Guerrilla Padre", it is believed that ROTC unit of the Ateneo de Cagayan, like ROTC units in Manila, were ordered into cadre training to qualify cadets for membership in the Philippine Army Reserve Force, as required in the National Defense Law of the Commonwealth of the Philippines; and because of the existing emergency, to prepare cadets for subsequent USAFFE service. It is believed that ROTC cadets were not inducted into the USAFFE during the period they were in cadre training, and that the cadre training of the ROTC unit of the Ateneo de Cagayan was terminated on or about January 1942.
- 5. On the basis of the foregoing findings, it is determined that ROTC Units were not inducted into the USAFFE, and service with an ROTC unit is not evidence of any USAFFE status. Individual members of ROTC units may have volunteered for service with regularly established USAFFE units subsequent to termination of ROTC cadre training. Proof of USAFFE service must be established in individual claims.

In reference to the attached correspondence dated October 16, 1952, with lat Indorsement, subjects "Status of ROTC in Cagayan de Ore City, Oriental Misamie, Philippines, Claim No. R - 150 - Atemeo de Cagayan, this headquarters has determined that the ROTC Unit of Atemeo de Cagayan was not among the units of the Philippine Commonwealth Army inducted into the service of the USAFFE.

This determination in no way affects the individual status of cadet members thereof, who, subsequent to their training in this unit, may have been properly inducted into bonafide USAFFS organizations.

The Ateneo de Cagayan has filed a claim under Section 7 of the War Claims Act of 1948. In a preliminary examination of this claim it has become necessary to determine the status of 35 members of the R.O.T.O. at the Ateneo de Cagayan, Cagayan, de Oro City, Oriental Missanis, Philippines who received training under the command of Major Perry Baldwin. The training period for this R.O.T.O. unit was from December 8, 1941 to March 1, 1942, which was before the surrender of the Philippines.

For purposes of adjudication under Section 7 of the War Claims Act, it is necessary to have a determination as to the status of this group of R.O.T.C. cadets under the command of Major Perry Ealdwin, i.e. whether the Army officially inducted this group into "armed forces of the United States", "USSIFP" or "USAFPS", and if possible the dates of inductions.

Your prompt cooperation in furnishing official information on the above question will be appreciated.



1. Basis for this memorandum is "Memorandum" of Walter B. Lang, Chief. Religious Claims Section dated 16 Oct 52.

- 2. The names or identities of 35 NOTC cadets at the Atense de Cagayan, Gagyan de Oro City, Misans Orientel, allegedly training under Major Ferry Baldwin from 8 Dec 41 to 1 Mar 42 have not been established for the reason that the same have not been furnished by the requesting agency, and because there are no archives on this NOTC unit in this headquarters.
  - 3. An extensive research conducted on the case revealed:
- a. That the "Reserve Officer's Training Corps" of the Atomode Cagyan "mas ordered to take up residence in the college gymnasium," on 8 December 1941, as indicated in the book "GURRHILA PADRE in Mindamed" by Father Edward Haggarty (Fage 4, par 1). However, no mention was made as to the length of time the HOTC cadets remained in the Atomoc gymnasium and/or when the cadets were ordered out of the gymnasium or the Atomoc premises.
- b. That the Commandant of the ROTC unit of the Ateneo de Cagayan was lst Lt Manuel de F. Peralta C-37538. His military service, as indicated in his Form 23 are as follows:
