Personally appeared before me, the undersigned, duly authorized by law to administer oaths in cases of this character, Everett L. Warner, Lt. Col., Ser No O-125572, who after being duly sworn, deposes and says, to wit; That he has been told by reliable individuals, Japanese and Filipino, that Theodore Kalalaka, Lt Col., O-16841, died on Nov. 1, 1942 and Albert M. Ziegler, 2nd Lt., Ser No O-890522, died on November 8, 1942, and both were buried in the Catholic Cemetery, at Bayombong, Nueva Viscaya, Philippine Islands; That Albert M. Ziegler, told him, prior to decess, that he saw the dead body of Walter M. Cushing, Major, Ser No O-890361, who was killed in combat with the Japanese in September 1942 near Barrio Masaya, Isabela, Philippine Islands; That personal knowledge of the condition of health of Kalalaka and Ziegler and attending circumstance after the report of death convince him of the truth of the reports; That Ziegler's statement concerning Cushing's death was very direct and definite; Also that the Japanese report Cushing as being killed and it was they that exhibited the body to Ziegler; That he believes all three of the above men are dead.
