1. This project initiated to verify authenticity of Troop Roster, "A" Co, Depot Bn, Cebu Brigade, 28 February 1942, submitted in the case of Anacleto G. Naraiso. Name and signature of commanding officer is shown as Pedro Y. Chica, 1st Lt., Inf-Res.

2. Roster contains the names of 111 individuals. Examination of 201 files revealed the following information:

- a. 201 files:
 - 97 located
 - 14 negative or unable to identify with name on roster
- b. USAFFE determinations (VA-WCC-D&A):
 - 23 positive (17 with POW archives)
 - 9 negative
 - 8 negative for POW - no USAFFE determination made
 - 57 no determinations
- c. Alleged grade:
 - 87 compatible with roster
 - 9 one grade discrepancy with roster
 - 1 two grade discrepancy with roster
- d. Alleged organization:
 - 88 compatible with roster

4. 201 file of 1st Sgt Luis M. Conge (listed on roster) contains certified true copy of Par 6, SO#210, Hq 8th Mil Dist, PA, Cebu City, dtd 17 Dec 41. Certified as true copy by Pedro Y. Chica, 1st Lt. Inf-Res (CO on roster involved). Orders list names of 110 enlisted reservists (no grades shown - 95 with PA sn's) called to active duty effective on date of induction, with assignment to "A" Co, Depot Bn, Hq Visayan-Mindanao Zone. Orders contain statement "above detail has been made with the concurrence of the Commanding General, Visayan-Mindanao Force, USAFFE." Command line is shown as "By order of Major Gonzalez", with Emiliano C. Cabatingan, 1st Lt, Inf-Res, shown as Adjutant. Orders also show "Approved: I.C. Scudder, Lt. Col., Inf, U.S. Army, Brigade Commander." Foregoing SO#210 is consistent with SO#2, Hq 8th Mil Dist, USAFFE, Cebu City, dtd 2 Jan 42, on file in Records Section, regarding command line, adjutant, and approving U.S. Army officer. No other special order for 8th Military District during period involved found on file in Records Section. Note: The 110 names (w/o MI) listed on SO#210 ~~ARE~~ and the same as the 110 names of EM appearing on roster in question, although not in the same order and with some variations in spellings.

5. 201 file of same 1st Sgt Luis M. Conge also contains certified true copy of Par 3, SO#3, "A" Co, Depot Bn, Hq V-M Force, USAFFE, dtd 16 Jan 42. Also certified as true copy by 1st Lt Pedro Y. Chica. Orders pertain to promotions for 16 PA enlisted personnel effective on date of orders. (Previous ranks not shown) Command line is shown as "By order of Lieutenant Colonel SCUDDER," with William F. O'Connor, 1st Lt, Inf, USA, shown as Adjutant. No special orders for same organization found on file in Records Section. Note: Grades shown on roster involved are consistent with promotions indicated in SO#3.

6. The signature of 1st Lt Pedro Y. Chica appearing on roster compares favorably with that shown in his 201 file. He alleged on his Form 23 that he was inducted into USAFFE on 26 Dec 41 and assigned as commanding officer of Co A, Depot Bn, Cebu Brigade. His USAFFE is established by archives, including list of PA officers, Cebu Forces, who surrendered to the Japanese at Camp X, Cebu on 17 May 42, which shows his rank and organization as "1st Lt, Depot Bn, Brigade." (Ref: USAFFE File 384.1, Fldr 6) His file contains positive WCC determination showing he was released from O'Donnell Concentration Camp on 19 Jan 43. Organization for three other PA officers on aforementioned list is also shown as "Cebu Brigade."

7. History of military activities in Cebu as told by Colonel Irvine C. Scudder (Cebu Force Commander) and Lt. Col. Howard J. Edmands (Commander Cebu MP Regt) contains the following information pertinent to the Cebu Brigade:

a. Col. Scudder was appointed commander of the Cebu Brigade o/a 13 Dec 41. On that date the 82d and 83d Infantry Regiments (originally assigned to the 81st Division) were transferred to the Cebu Brigade.

b. A Brigade Hq Co of 200 men was authorized o/a 23 Dec 41.

c. Lt. Col. Jose Gonzales (inducting officer involved) was authorized to induct PA personnel into the USAFFE.

4. 201 file of 1st Sgt Luis M. Conge (listed on roster) contains certified true copy of Par 6, SO#210, Hq 8th Mil Dist, PA, Cebu City, dtd 17 Dec 41. Certified as true copy by Pedro Y. Chica, 1st Lt. Inf-Res (CO on roster involved). Orders list names of 110 enlisted reservists (no grades shown - 95 with PA sn's) called to active duty effective on date of induction, with assignment to "A" Co, Depot Bn, Hq Visayan-Mindanao Zone. Orders contain statement "above detail has been made with the concurrence of the Commanding General, Visayan-Mindanao Force, USAFFE." Command line is shown as "By order of Major Gonzalez", with Emiliano C. Cabatingan, 1st Lt, Inf-Res, shown as Adjutant. Orders also show "Approved: I.C. Scudder, Lt. Col., Inf, U.S. Army, Brigade Commander." Foregoing SO#210 is consistent with SO#2, Hq 8th Mil Dist, USAFFE, Cebu City, dtd 2 Jan 42, on file in Records Section, regarding command line, adjutant, and approving U.S. Army officer. No other special order for 8th Military District during period involved found on file in Records Section. Note: The 110 names (w/o MI) listed on SO#210 and the same as the 110 names of EM appearing on roster in question, although not in the same order and with some variations in spellings.

5. 201 file of same 1st Sgt Luis M. Conge also contains certified true copy of Par 3, SO#3, "A" Co, Depot Bn, Hq V-M Force, USAFFE, dtd 16 Jan 42. Also certified as true copy by 1st Lt Pedro Y. Chica. Orders pertain to promotions for 16 PA enlisted personnel effective on date of orders. (Previous ranks not shown) Command line is shown as "By order of Lieutenant Colonel SCUDDER," with William F. O'Connor, 1st Lt, Inf, USA, shown as Adjutant. No special orders for same organization found on file in Records Section. Note: Grades shown on roster involved are consistent with promotions indicated in SO#3.

6. The signature of 1st Lt Pedro Y. Chica appearing on roster compares favorably with that shown in his 201 file. He alleged on his Form 23 that he was inducted into USAFFE on 26 Dec 41 and assigned as commanding officer of Co A, Depot Bn, Cebu Brigade. His USAFFE is established by archives, including list of PA officers, Cebu Forces, who surrendered to the Japanese at Camp X, Cebu on 17 May 42, which shows his rank and organization as "1st Lt, Depot Bn, Brigade." (Ref: USAFFE File 384.1, Fldr 6) His file contains positive WCC determination showing he was released from O'Donnell Concentration Camp on 19 Jan 43. Organization for three other PA officers on aforementioned list is also shown as "Cebu Brigade."

7. History of military activities in Cebu as told by Colonel Irvine C. Scudder (Cebu Force Commander) and Lt. Col. Howard J. Edmands (Commander Cebu MP Regt) contains the following information pertinent to the Cebu Brigade:

a. Col. Scudder was appointed commander of the Cebu Brigade o/a 13 Dec 41. On that date the 82d and 83d Infantry Regiments (originally assigned to the 81st Division) were transferred to the Cebu Brigade.

b. A Brigade Hq Co of 200 men was authorized o/a 23 Dec 41.

c. Lt. Col. Jose Gonzales (inducting officer involved) was authorized to induct PA personnel into the USAFFE.

8. Conclusions:

Organization, grades, and dates of induction (23-29 Dec 41) as alleged by individuals listed on roster, together with evidence contained in true copies of call to active duty and promotion orders, and history of Cebu Brigade, indicates that Co A, Depot Bn, Cebu Brigade was a USAFFE organization. Additional evidence is contained in the fact that 23 of the 32 claims received (VA-WCC-DA) have been determined positive for USAFFE, with 17 of the 23, including the commanding officer, being determined positive for POW status. Approximately 90% of the files are consistent with roster regarding alleged organization, grades, and Commanding Officer. Also, the fact that the individuals listed on roster alleged induction with Co A, Depot Bn, Cebu Brigade, indicates they were assigned to the organization on and prior to 28 Feb 42, date of roster.

9. Recommendations:

a. Attached roster be accepted as an authentic USAFFE archive.

b. Roster ^{BE} indexed, cards filed in Master Card File, and copy of roster be placed in Decimal File 330.32. Folder 145.

c. Memo for Record, denoting presence of roster be placed in 201 file for each individual listed, and new files to be initiated for the negatives and/or those names for which no file could be identified.

d. Attached copies of call to active duty orders (Par 6, SO#210) and promotion orders (Par 3, SO#3) are not acceptable as official documents since they are only typewritten copies. However, recommend that the information contained in the orders be accepted ~~as authentic~~ since it can be substantiated by allegations in 201 files and the evidence revealed in study of subject roster. Further recommend that information be made available on Memo for Record recommended under Par C above.

8. Conclusions:

Organization, grades, and dates of induction (23-29 Dec 41) as alleged by individuals listed on roster, together with evidence contained in true copies of call to active duty and promotion orders, and history of Cebu Brigade, indicates that Co A, Depot Bn, Cebu Brigade was a USAFFE organization. Additional evidence is contained in the fact that 23 of the 32 claims received (VA-WCC-DA) have been determined positive for USAFFE, with 17 of the 23, including the commanding officer, being determined positive for POW status. Approximately 90% of the files are consistent with roster regarding alleged organization, grades, and Commanding Officer. Also, the fact that the individuals listed on roster alleged induction with Co A, Depot Bn, Cebu Brigade, indicates they were assigned to the organization on and prior to 28 Feb 42, date of roster.

9. Recommendations:

- a. Attached roster be accepted as an authentic USAFFE archive.
- b. Roster, indexed, cards filed in Master Card File, and copy of roster be placed in Decimal File 330.32. Folder 145.
- c. Memo for Record, denoting presence of roster be placed in 201 file for each individual listed, and new files to be initiated for the negatives and/or those names for which no file could be identified.
- d. Attached copies of call to active duty orders (Par 6, SO#210) and promotion orders (Par 3, SO#3) are not acceptable as official documents since they are only typewritten copies. However, recommend that the information contained in the orders be accepted *upon verification* since it can be substantiated by allegations in 201 file and the evidence revealed in study of subject roster. Further recommend that information be made available on Memo for Record recommended under Par C above.
