

- f. A search of USAFFE archives failed to reveal any evidence to verify the roster involved. Only two individuals' files indicate NSLI with effective date shown as 1 Feb 42. Historical data, although showing only brief references, indicates the non-inducted portion of 82d Inf Regt was mobilized and inducted 24 Nov 41 at Argao, Cebu. The regiment originally a component of 81st Division was detached from the Division o/a 8 Dec 41. On 9 Dec 41, Company F along with other units was ordered to embark for Davao via Cagayan. The Battalion arrived at Cagayan 10 Dec 41 and proceeded to Davao. No references found regarding organization's activities during period 11 Dec 41 to 5 Mar 42. On 6 Mar 42 the Battalion was assigned to Communications Zone, Mindanao. History also indicates the 82d Inf Regt (Less 2d Bn) was incorporated in the Cebu Brigade o/a 2 Jan 42, with a provisional battalion replacing the original 2d Bn previously sent to Davao.
- g. The foregoing historical data showing battalion assigned to Communications Zone, Mindanao corresponds with the statements made by some individuals who claimed they were last paid by the Finance officer of that organization.
- h. History of "A" Corps, Western Mindanao, 10th MD (Guerrilla) shows that many of the USAFFE personnel on Mindanao did not surrender. This evidence may account for the fact that only a few of the individuals alleged POW service.
- i. Historical data relating to Japanese attack and invasion of Davao, 20 Dec 41, (Par 5) together with statements by commanding officers of battalion in question, indicates considerable evidence to support the numerous death claims involving individuals listed on roster.
- j. A comparison between the formats shown on attached induction roster and other rosters of this type on file in Records Section, RPRB, failed to reveal any significant evidence, since many of these rosters are of various formats. However, there is on file a duplicate copy of Troop Roster Co D, 1st Bn, 82d Inf Regt, 25 Feb 42 (accepted as authentic USAFFE archive 28 Mar 55) listing names and service numbers in the same order as shown on roster involved. Memo for Record, relating to accepted troop roster, shows most of the individuals listed thereon alleged induction 24 Nov 41. With exception of NCO's or Cadre, this date was assumed to be the induction date for personnel shown on the roster. This induction date corresponds with that shown on roster involved in this study, and alleged in 201 files for individuals concerned.
- 9. The foregoing data reflects a definite compatibility between induction roster, inducting and commanding officers, available information concerning history of organization, and 201 files for individuals listed on roster. This data also appears to be sufficient evidence to establish the facts that the organization, although only recently organized, was ordered and proceeded to Davao o/a 9 Dec 41; while lacking in training, arms and equipment, participated in defense of Davao during Japanese attack and invasion 20 Dec 41; and suffered numerous casualties during the encounter.


- f. A search of USAFFE archives failed to reveal any evidence to verify the roster involved. Only two individuals' files indicate NSLI with effective date shown as 1 Feb 42. Historical data, although showing only brief references, indicates the non-inducted portion of 82d Inf Regt was mobilized and inducted 24 Nov 41 at Argao, Cebu. The regiment originally a component of 81st Division was detached from the Division o/a 8 Dec 41. On 9 Dec 41, Company F along with other units was ordered to embark for Davao via Cagayan. The Battalion arrived at Cagayan 10 Dec 41 and proceeded to Davao. No references found regarding organization's activities during period 11 Dec 41 to 5 Mar 42. On 6 Mar 42 the Battalion was assigned to Communications Zone, Mindanao. History also indicates the 82d Inf Regt (Less 2d Bn) was incorporated in the Cebu Brigade o/a 2 Jan 42, with a provisional battalion replacing the original 2d Bn previously sent to Davao.
- g. The foregoing historical data showing battalion assigned to Communications Zone, Mindanao corresponds with the statements made by some individuals who claimed they were last paid by the Finance officer of that organization.
- h. History of "A" Corps, Western Mindanao, 10th MD (Guerrilla) shows that many of the USAFFE personnel on Mindanao did not surrender. This evidence may account for the fact that only a few of the individuals alleged POW service.
- · i. Historical data relating to Japanese attack and invasion of Davao, 20 Dec 41, (Par 5) together with statements by commanding officers of battalion in question, indicates considerable evidence to support the numerous death claims involving individuals listed on roster.
- j. A comparison between the formats shown on attached induction roster and other rosters of this type on file in Records Section, RPRB, failed to reveal any significant evidence, since many of these rosters are of various formats. However, there is on file a duplicate copy of Troop Roster Co D, 1st Bn, 82d Inf Regt, 25 Feb 42 (accepted as authentic USAFFE archive 28 Mar 55) listing names and service numbers in the same order as shown on roster involved. Memo for Record, relating to accepted troop roster, shows most of the individuals listed thereon alleged induction 24 Nov 41. With exception of NCO's or Cadre, this date was assumed to be the induction date for personnel shown on the roster. This induction date corresponds with that shown on roster involved in this study, and alleged in 201 files for individuals concerned.
- 9. The foregoing data reflects a definite compatibility between induction roster, inducting and commanding officers, available information concerning history of organization, and 201 files for individuals listed on roster. This data also appears to be sufficient evidence to establish the facts that the organization, although only recently organized, was ordered and proceeded to Davao o/a 9 Dec 41; while lacking in training, arms and equipment, participated in defense of Davao during Japanese attack and invasion 20 Dec 41; and suffered numerous casualties during the encounter.

7. 201 File for Patricio T. Sangutan (listed on roster) contains an alleged true copy of induction roster together with a certification indicating it was copied from the duplicate roster involved in this project. This alleged true copy contains the following notation after the name and service number of Emiliano Cabejo, 837A - 205: "(Not inducted D L Cosper)." Notation does not appear on copy of roster in question. No 201 file located for individual concerned. Since the foregoing alleged true copy fails to indicate that the notation was supported by the induction officer's written signature or initials, it is not considered as an official entry on the roster.

8. Summary:

- a. 201 files identified for 66 of 79 individuals listed on roster. Some under different spellings than shown on roster. Brief negative search failed to locate any 201 files for other individuals.
- b. 21 files contain VA claims, 5 of which were certified positive, and 16 negative. 14 of the claims (2 positive) allege DOD as o/a 20 Dec 41. 9 individuals filed WCC claims, with 2 being certified positive (USAFFE only), 5 no record, and 2 negative. MPA determinations show 55 positive (5 revoked) 4 negative, and 7 files do not indicate any determination under MPA.
- c. Except for some minor variations, 201 files are consistent regarding alleged induction 24 Nov 41 at Argao, Cebu with Co F, 2d Bn, 82d Inf Regt. The same consistency is shown concerning alleged inducting and commanding officers, Station assignments, and combat engagement with the enemy (20 Dec 41 at Matina, Davao). Approximately one-third of the individuals have guerrilla archives indicating some evidence of USAFFE. 24 files contain affidavits of commanding officer Celso C. Enriquez testifying to their induction into USAFFE. His 201 file contains positive certification of USAFFE, and indicates he was commanding officer of the organization at the time and place of their alleged induction.
- d. The records of Capt. Duane L. Cosper, 0-35 672, US Army, (KIA 9 Jan 45) contain evidence showing he served as Unit Instructor with 82d Inf Regt from 24 Nov 41 to 2 Dec 41. This evidence tends to prove that he was the inducting officer as shown on roster involved.
- e. 201 files for Battalion commander and commanding officers of Hq Co, Cos E, G and H, 2d Bn, 82d Inf Regt, all contain either positive USAFFE certifications or sufficient USAFFE archives to establish the same. Their allegations concerning operations and combat activities correspond with that alleged for organization in question. Information revealed in Report of Field Investigation (noted in Par 3f) is compatible with the foregoing allegations and also indicates the organization suffered heavy casualties during the Japanese landings at Matina, Davao on 20 Dec 41.



7. 201 File for Patricio T. Sangutan (listed on roster) contains an alleged true copy of induction roster together with a certification indicating it was copied from the duplicate roster involved in this project. This alleged true copy contains the following notation after the name and service number of Emiliano Cabejo, 837A - 205: "(Not inducted D L Cosper)." Notation does not appear on copy of roster in question. No 201 file located for individual concerned. Since the foregoing alleged true copy fails to indicate that the notation was supported by the induction officer's written signature or initials, it is not considered as an official entry on the roster.

8. Summary:

- a. 201 files identified for 66 of 79 individuals listed on roster. Some under different spellings than shown on roster. Brief negative search failed to locate any 201 files for other individuals.
- b. 21 files contain VA claims, 5 of which were certified positive, and 16 negative. 14 of the claims (2 positive) allege DOD as o/a 20 Dec 41. 9 individuals filed WCC claims, with 2 being certified positive (USAFFE only), 5 no record, and 2 negative. MPA determinations show 55 positive (5 revoked) 4 negative, and 7 files do not indicate any determination under MPA.
- c. Except for some minor variations, 201 files are consistent regarding alleged induction 24 Nov 41 at Argao, Cebu with Co F, 2d Bn, 82d Inf Regt. The same consistency is shown concerning alleged inducting and commanding officers, Station assignments, and combat engagement with the enemy (20 Dec 41 at Matina, Davao). Approximately one-third of the individuals have guerrilla archives indicating some evidence of USAFFE. 24 files contain affidavits of commanding officer Celso C. Enriquez testifying to their induction into USAFFE. His 201 file contains positive certification of USAFFE, and indicates he was commanding officer of the organization at the time and place of their alleged induction.
- d. The records of Capt. Duane L. Cosper, 0-35 672, US Army, (KIA 9 Jan 45) contain evidence showing he served as Unit Instructor with 82d Inf Regt from 24 Nov 41 to 2 Dec 41. This evidence tends to prove that he was the inducting officer as shown on roster involved.
- e. 201 files for Battalion commander and commanding officers of Hq Co, Cos E, G and H, 2d Bn, 82d Inf Regt, all contain either positive USAFFE certifications or sufficient USAFFE archives to establish the same. Their allegations concerning operations and combat activities correspond with that alleged for organization in question. Information revealed in Report of Field Investigation (noted in Par 3f) 15 compatible with the foregoing allegations and also indicates the organization suffered heavy casualties during the Japanese landings at Matina, Davao on 20 Dec 41.




- g. 201 Files for several other officers and enlisted men of Co F, 2d Bn, 82d Inf Regt (USAFFE est.) reveal information consistent with foregoing alleged service and combat activities of organization involved. 201 files for Commanding Officers, Hq Co, Cos E, G, H, and various other officers of 2d Bn, 82d Inf Regt (USAFFE est.) also contain information, referring to station assignments and combat activities, compatible with that alleged for Co F, 2d Bn, 82d Inf Regt. Records of Valentin del C. Estrera (CO Co E deceased) contain true copy of Letter of Condolence, 16 Mar 42 allegedly signed by W. T. Holloway Cook, MAJ, AGD and showing DOD as 20 Dec 41. VA certification shows he was KIA on 20 Dec 41.
- 4. A search of USAFFE archives, historical files, and other evidence on file in RPRB, revealed only meager information concerning operations and combat activities of Co F, 2d Bn, 82d Inf Regt. Available information shows the officers and key personnel of this organization were inducted into the USAFFE o/a 1 Sep 41, and other members of the unit mobilized and inducted 24 Nov 41 at Argao, Cebu. Historical data indicates the unit along with other units of the 82d Inf Regt was originally a component of the 81st Division, USAFFE, and along with same regiment was detached from the Division o/a 8 Dec 41. History of 81st Division (Historical Ref File 74, P-40) contains the following reference relating to station assignments of 2d Bn, 82d Inf Regt: "On this day also, (9 Dec 41) the 2nd Battalion of the 82nd Infantry, was ordered to embark for Davao via Cagayan. An advanced post was established at Tagbilaran (Bohol)." Project "J" File 500-2, Page 53 (not signed), Misc Corres, Visayan - Mindanao Force 1941-42 shows the following notation: "Dec 10, 2d Bn, 82d Infantry arrived by boat at Cagayan, proceeded to Davao." No information found regarding organization's activities during period 11 Dec 41 to 5 Mar 42. RPRB SOP, 5-2 (App 13), 81st Division, shows 2d Bn, 82d Inf Regt assigned to Communications Zone, Mindanao on 6 Mar 42. History of "A" Corps, Western Mindanao, 10th MD, (Guerrilla) shows that many of the USAFFE personnel on Mindanao did not surrender, but took refuge in the hills and mountainous areas on the island.
- 5. The aforementioned death claims and organizations heavy casualty losses (Par's 3a (1) and 3f) are allegedly connected with the Japanese attack and invasion of Davao, 20 Dec 41. Historical data, concerning this event, shows the USAFFE forces defending Davao (subject unit allegedly active in this area at this specific time) were organized only a short time prior to the invasion. With only limited training, no combat experience and out-numbered especially in arms and equipment, they offered little opposition to the invading forces. History shows the defending forces on the beach were also subjected to hostile fire from carrier-based aircraft, Naval vessels and tanks.
- 6. The name of the induction officer on roster in question has been identified as pertaining to Capt. Duane L. Cosper, 0-355, 672, CAC, who was killed in action 9 Jan 45. His records show he was placed on temporary duty with the Philippine Army at Ubay, Bohol as of 25 August 1941. His records contain Letter, Nes VMF, USAFFE, 5 Dec 41, Subject, Efficiency Report, showing his rank as 1st Lt, and indicating he served as Unit Instructor, 82d Inf Regt from 24 Nov 41 to 2 Dec 41. The written signature on roster does not appear to compare favorably with that shown in records. However, this evidence alone is not considered sufficient basis to question the validity of the roster.

- g. 201 Files for several other officers and enlisted men of Co F, 2d Bn, 82d Inf Regt (USAFFE est.) reveal information consistent with foregoing alleged service and combat activities of organization involved. 201 files for Commanding Officers, Hq Co, Cos E, G, H, and various other officers of 2d Bn, 82d Inf Regt (USAFFE est.) also contain information, referring to station assignments and combat activities, compatible with that alleged for Co F, 2d Bn, 82d Inf Regt. Records of Valentin del C. Estrera (CO Co E deceased) contain true copy of Letter of Condolence, 16 Mar 42 allegedly signed by W. T. Holloway Cook, MAJ, AGD and showing DOD as 20 Dec 41. VA certification shows he was KIA on 20 Dec 41.
- 4. A search of USAFFE archives, historical files, and other evidence on file in RPRB, revealed only meager information concerning operations and combat activities of Co F, 2d Bn, 82d Inf Regt, available information shows the officers and key personnel of this organization were inducted into the USAFFE o/a 1 Sep 41, and other members of the unit mobilized and inducted 24 Nov 41 at Argao, Cebu. Historical data indicates the unit along with other units of the 82d Inf Regt was originally a component of the 81st Division, USAFFE, and along with same regiment was detached from the Division o/a 8 Dec 41. His records contain Letter, has VMF, USAFFE, 5 Dec 41, Subject, Efficiency Report, showing his rank as 1st Lt, and indicating he served as Unit Instructor, 82d Inf Regt from 24 Nov 41 to 2 Dec 41. The written signature on roster does not appear to compare favorably with that shown in records. However, this evidence alone is not considered sufficient basis to question the balidity of the roster.

- (3) Grade and Organization at time of induction: 57 allege Pvt, F Co, 82d Inf Regt 1 alleges Cpl, F Co, 82d Inf Regt 6 allege Pvt, different companies, 2d Bn, 82d Inf Regt 2 allege Pvt, 2d Bn, 82d Inf Regt
- c. Most of the individuals on Forms 23 are consistent regarding name of commanding officer, organization's subsequent locations in Bohol and Davao early in December 1941, and encounter with the Japanese at Matina, Davao o/a 20 December 1941.
- d. Two (2) files contain alleged true copies of Record of Induction into USAFFE at Argao, Cebu on 24 Nov 41. Approximately one-third of the individuals have guerrilla archives in 201 files or on file in Records Section, RPR Br, indicating probable evidence of USAFFE service.
- e. Twenty-Four (24) files contain affidavits of Celso C. Enriquez, wherein he alleges being Commanding Officer of Co F, 2d Bn, 82d Inf Regt, and claims personal knowledge of the individuals' induction into USAFFE. His USAFFE, verified by NSLI and call to active duty, has been certified positive to VA with date of induction shown as 1 Sep 41. His Forms 23 and other information in 201 file indicate he was commanding officer of alleged organization at Argao, Cebu on 24 Nov 41. 201 file contains an alleged true extract copy of SO #34, Office Senior Inspector, Camp Lapu-Lapu, Cebu City, 15 Nov 41, indicating subject officer was to be relieved from further assignment and duty at Tubigon Cadre Training Center, Tubigon, Cebu o/a 19 Nov 41, and was to report to the unit instructors, U. S. Army at Argao, Cebu o/a 20 Nov 41, for the purpose of mobilizing the non-inducted portion of the 82d Inf. Extract shows his rank, name and organization as: "3rd Lieut. Celso C. Enriquez, Co F." (copy of the foregoing SO #34 not found on file in Records Section, RPRB.) Records also show he was awarded the Purple Heart for wounds allegedly received in action 20 Dec 41 at Davao City (Matina Beach).
- f. Report of Field Investigation, 18 May 50, in the case of Fidel C. Sagayno (listed on roster allegedly deceased) also contains statements by Celso C. Enriquez, relating to locations and activities of his company during period 24 Nov 41 to 20 Dec 41. He also states his company made contact with the enemy and engaged them in combat from dawn until 1100 hours on 20 Dec 41 at Matina (Talomo) Davao City and then retreated to the second line of defense. He further states that during the engagement his company lost eleven men and due to the presence of the enemy they failed to recover the bodies of the casualties and left them on the beach at the aforementioned place. Investigation also contains statements by Luis B. Jakosalem (Positive USAFFE to WCC NSLI and call to active duty) alleged Commanding Officer, 2d Bn, 82d Inf Regt, to the effect that his battalion engaged the enemy during their landings at Davao, 20 Dec 41, and suffered heavy casualties.

- c. Most of the individuals on Forms 23 are consistent regarding name of commanding officer, organization's subsequent locations in Bohol and Davao early in December 1941, and encounter with the Japanese at Matina, Davao o/a 20 December 1941.
- d. Two (2) files contain alleged true copies of Record of Induction into USAFFE at Argao, Cebu on 24 Nov 41. Approximately one-third of the individuals have guerrilla archives in 201 files or on file in Records Section, RPR Br, indicating probable evidence of USAFFE service.
- e. Twenty-Four (24) files contain affidavits of Celso C. Enriquez, wherein he alleges being Commanding Officer of Co F, 2d Bn, 82d Inf Regt, and claims personal knowledge of the individuals' induction into USAFFE. His USAFFE, verified by NSLI and call to active duty, has been certified positive to VA with date of induction shown as 1 Sep 41. His Forms 23 and other information in 201 file indicate he was commanding officer of alleged organization at Argao, Cebu on 24 Nov 41. 201 file contains an alleged true extract copy of SO #34, Office Senior Inspector, Camp Lapu-Lapu, Cebu City, 15 Nov 41, indicating subject officer was to be relieved from further assignment and duty at Tubigon Cadre Training Center, Tubigon, Cebu o/a 19 Nov 41, and was to report to the unit instructors, U. S. Army at Argao, Cebu o/a 20 Nov 41, for the purpose of mobilizing the non-inducted portion of the 82d Inf. Extract shows his rank, name and organization as: "3rd Lieut. Celso C. Enriquez, Co F." (copy of the foregoing SO #34 not found on file in Records Section, RPRB.) Records also show he was awarded the Purple Heart for wounds allegedly received in action 20 Dec 41 at Davao City (Matina Beach).
- f. Report of Field Investigation, 18 May 50, in the case of Fidel C. Sagayno (listed on roster allegedly deceased) also contains statements by Celso C. Enriquez, relating to locations and activities of his company during period 24 Nov 41 to 20 Dec 41. He also states his company made contact with the enemy and engaged them in combat from dawn until 1100 hours on 20 Dec 41 at Matina (Talomo) Davao City and then retreated to the second line of defense. He further states that during the engagement his company lost eleven men and due to the presence of the enemy they failed to recover the bodies of the casualties and left them on the beach at the aforementioned place. Investigation also contains statements by Luis B. 


