Divisional organization, date and place of induction, inducting officer alleged by the individuals listed on the induction order is compatible.

Troop roster dated 28 February 1942 appears to be a signed carbon copy of the original (first page). Signature of Commanding Officer is compatible with signature shown in his 201 file. Roster contains identical names as induction list with exception of Commanding Officer Remegio Marquez who joined 22 February 1942 and Vicente M. Santos who alleges to have been inducted 10 January 1942 at Dansalan, Lanao.

Panfilo Alajar, Arcadio L. Dumlao and Remigio O. Marquez who were officers with the 5th Lanao Company (PC) have USAFFE service established by NSLI and POW archives. History of the 81st Division indicates Constabulary of Lanao attached to the 81st Division with the Tamparan Detachment in Division reserve. History further indicates Remegio Marquez, 2nd Lt. Commanding Officer and 2nd Lt. Arcadio Dumlao, JO of the 5th Lanao Company, Tamparan, 1 March 1942.







1. Project initiated to verify the authenticity of an induction list of the 5th Lanao Company, PC dated 12 January 1942 (True Copy) and an incomplete roster of the 5th Lanao Company, PC dated 28 February 1942.
2. Induction list contains names of 43 individuals and incomplete roster contains 40 names. 38 names that appear on induction list also appear on roster. Two names appear on roster that are not on induction list and there are six names on induction list that do not appear on roster.
3. 39 files were located. Records contained therein reveal the following:
  - a. 19 files contain VA reports; 9 with positive USAFFE-PA service and 10 with negative reports.
  - b. 39 files contain information alleging induction at Tamparan, Lanao on 12 January 1942.
  - one* c. 33 files contain information alleging Captain Alajar as inducting officer; has information alleging a Captain Juban and 1 a Captain Miller. The induction officer is not shown in the other files.
  - d. 26 files contain pre-war archives: 22 shown on General Order 17 dated 22 July 1940 with serial numbers identical with those shown on induction list. Four others are listed on General Orders 216, Army Headquarters dated 17 November 1941. (Call to Active Duty).
  - e. Signature of Remegio Marquez on roster is comparable to signature appearing in his 201 file. Remegio Marquez, listed on roster as 2nd Lt., assigned Commanding Officer 22 February 1942. On his Form 23, he alleges that he was JO of 10th Lanao Company, (PC), inducted 12 January 1942, assigned Commanding Officer 5th Lanao Company (PC) in March 1942. His service is established by Certificate of Induction dated 10 January 1942, 10th Lanao Company; NSLI and Casualty Report.
  - f. Panfilo Alajar is listed on roster as Captain, CO; transferred 22 February 1942. He alleges induction 12 January 1942. He also alleges being assigned as CO of 2nd Zamboanga Company about April 1942. He has an NSLI record.
  - g. Arcadio L. Dumlao is listed on roster as 2nd Lt., Acting JO. He alleges induction 12 January 1942 and that he was JO of 5th Lanao Company. He is listed on Special Orders 268, Army Headquarters dated 11 November 1941 as called to Active Duty and his name appears on Camp Keithley Prisoner of War roster.
4. Appendix IV (page 75) 81st Division and Attached units dated 1 March 1942 *etc* shows: 5th Lanao Company, Tamparan with Commanding Officer 2nd Lt. Remegio Marquez and 2nd Lt. Arcadio Dumlao as JO.
