TO: Operations Officer

1. This project initiated to verify authenticity of mimeographed copy of SO #133, Hqrs 1st Repl Bn (PA), 21 June 1946. Orders contain three paragraphs and pertain to revocation of part of prior orders, transfers to hospital, and relief from active service of the Philippine Army.

2. Par 1, of orders in question, refers to revocation of so much of Par 2, SO #130, Hqrs 1st Repl Bn (PA), 18 June 1946 as pertains to Pfc Mauro Bautista, 087925. Foregoing SO #130 on file in Records Section, RPRB shows same enlisted man to be relieved from active service of the PA effective 19 June 1946. Apparently, as noted in following paragraph, the orders relieving him from active service were revoked and he was transferred to the hospital for medical examination and/or treatment.


3. Par 2 pertains to transfer of two enlisted men from 4th Repl Co, 1st Repl Bn to Det of Pnts, 26th Sta Hosp, effective 21 June 1946. Their names are listed as Pfc Juan Matulac, 066190, and Mauro Bautista, 087925. Medical cards and clinical records in their 201 files show they were hospitalized at 26th Sta Hosp during June-July 1946.

4. Par 3 contains authority for relief from active service of the PA and lists names of 7 PAP. 201 files located for 6 of 7 listed. Alleged service numbers, ranks, organization, date and authority for discharge, compares favorably with orders involved.

5. Format, numerical sequence, command line and signature shown on orders in question are compatible with other orders issued by same organization during June 1946, on file in Records Section, RPRB.

6. Recommend that SO #133, Hqrs 1st Repl Bn (PA), 21 June 1946, be accepted as authentic, that orders be carded, cards placed in Master Card File, and an autostat copy of orders be filed in PA Folder 13, Book 1-C, Decimal 300.4. Also recommend notation be placed on Par 2, SO #130 denoting revocation of orders in the case of Pfc Mauro Bautista, 087925.


