had already been informed of the commission and call to active duty of said enlisted men by virtue of copies of General Orders No. 27 which was previously furnished that Headquarters.

5. Various affidavits of other Divisional, Regimental Commanders and respective Commanding Officers of above named enlisted men all attest accordingly that:

(1) Capt Juan L Gacad, O-28121 INF, formerly a T/Sgt in Bataan, was ordered to assume position as Acting Regimental S-1, 22nd Inf Regt, in the capacity of Third Lieutenant, Infantry, from 10 Feb 42 up to capitulation of Bataan.

(2) 2d Lieut Carlos S Sion, O-46881 AGS, formerly a Sgt in Bataan, was ordered to assume position as Platoon Ldr and Unit Supply Officer, "M" Co, 22nd Inf Regt, in the capacity of Third Lieutenant, Infantry, from 8 Feb 42 up to fall of Bataan, in the place of 3d Lieut Eugenio Locquiao, Pltn Ldr and Unit Supp Off, who vacated his place and assumed the place of 3d Lieut Sixto Mabitasan who was wounded in action and hospitalized up to the fall of Bataan.

(3) 2d Lieut Enrique J Aldaba, Inf, formerly a M/Sgt in Bataan, was sent to the firing line to replace an officer KIA. (Rank as 3d Lieut already confirmed by AFWESPAC).

(4) T/Sgt Dionisio E Moya, Inf, who was ordered to assume the position of Chief of Records Section, CIAG, 21st Div, in the capacity of Second Lieutenant, Infantry, from Feb 42 up to fall of Bataan. The officer who should have been the head of that Section was sent to the rear echelon.

(5) F/Sgt Lamberto Bonrostro, Inf, who was ordered to assume the position of Commanding Officer, Hq & Hq & Serv Co, Hq Bn, 22nd Inf Regt, from 10 Jan 42 up to fall of Bataan, in the place of 3d Lieuts Onofre Mangibin who was separated from his Unit and Benjamin Campo who was found to be inefficient in the performance of his duties as commissioned officer.

(6) F/Sgt Cristeto B Fangon, Inf./- (No supporting papers in his 201-file).

(7) S/Sgt Alejo F Costales, Inf, who was ordered to assume the position of Commanding Officer, Hq & Hq Co, 3rd Bn, 22d Inf Regt, from 30 Jan 42 up to fall of Bataan, in the place of 3rd Lieut Juan Fernandez, former CO of said Company who was KIA at MLR, Pilar-Bagac Road Line, Bataan.

(8) F/Sgt Evaristo E Mendalla, Inf, who was ordered to assume the position of Platoon Ldr, "M" Co, 22nd Inf Regt, in the capacity of Third Lieutenant, Infantry, from 8 Feb 42 up to fall of Bataan, in the place of 3d Lieut Ricardo Dorion, ExO, who vacated his place and assumed the place of 3d Lieut Miguel Ordon, CO, who was WIA and hospitalized up to fall of Bataan. (No 201-file available)

6. It appears from the supporting evidence submitted that the papers re confirmation of ranks of the above named officers and enlisted men which were sent to GHQ, Fort Mills, Corregidor, thru the then Capt Stonecipher, were tracer copies to serve as reminder to USFIP Headquarters.

7. It can be noted from a careful study of General Orders No. 27 that the Commanding General, USFIP, was furnished a copy of said General Orders prior to the trip of Capt Stonecipher to Ft Mills, Corregidor. It is then very evident that USFIP Headquarters had already acted favorably on the matter before Capt Stonecipher arrived in Ft Mills, Corregidor.

8. It can then be deduced that when Capt Stonecipher arrived at Ft Mills, he was given copies of Special Orders appointing subject enlisted men to commissioned ranks in the Reserve Force, PA, and which was delivered to the CG, 21st Div, for appropriate action, as evidenced by the wording of paragraphs 21 and 22 of General Orders No. 38, the most important

I. FINDINGS:

1. The following named officers and enlisted men of the 21st Division were included in General Orders Nos. 27 and 38, Hq 21st Division, re commission and call to active duty of enlisted men on 30 March 1942:

As outstanding evidences, there are presented duly authenticated copies of paragraph 16, General Orders No. 27, which appointed said enlisted men to "acting Second and Third Lieutenants" in the Infantry and ordered them to active duty in the field under battle conditions pursuant to the authority of the Commanding General, USFIP; and paragraphs 21 and 22, General Orders No. 38, which confirmed the appointments of said enlisted men, as being necessary in the military service, to the grades of Second and Third Lieutenants in the Reserve Force, PA, with date of rank as of 30 March 1942 as confirmed in orders by the Commanding General, USFIP, by authority of the President of the Commonwealth of the Philippines.

3. Pertinent paragraphs of the General Orders referred to above read as follows:

"Paragraph 16, General Orders #27 - Pursuant to authority of the Commanding General, United States Forces in the Philippines, the following appointments of enlisted men to the acting ranks as indicated, and are ordered to active duty in the field under battle conditions effective this date, March 29, 1942, are hereby made:

"Paragraph 21, General Orders #38 - Having been confirmed in orders by the Comd'g. General, United States Forces in the Philippines, by authority of the President of the Commonwealth of the Philippines, as being necessary in the military service, the appointment and call to active duty of each of the following, to grade indicated, in the Philippine Army, to rank from March 30, 1942, are announced effective upon acceptance:" (INCL #2)

"Paragraph 22, General Orders #38 - Pursuant to the authority of the Commanding General, USFIP, each of the following named Reserve Officers who have been called to active duty for the duration of the emergency, is entitled to pay at the rate as indicated:" (INCL #2)

4. Affidavits of Brig Gen Mateo M Capinpin, then CG, 21stDiv, and Maj Aurelio L Lucero, the Asst Chief of Staff, G-1, 21stDiv, attest that the papers re confirmation of ranks of the subject enlisted men was brought to USFIP Headquarters, Ft Mills, Corregidor, by Capt Stonecipher, then American Supply and Transportation Officer, 22ndInf. Based on the statements of the affiants as mentioned above, it is evident that the recommendation brought by the said Capt Stonecipher was just tracer copies; for USFIP Hq

pertinent portion of which reads as follows: "Having been confirmed in orders by the Commanding General, United States Forces in the Philippines x x x". This statement proves beyond doubt that Special Orders were actually issued by a competent headquarters.

9. A study of the 201-file of each of the enlisted men mentioned hereon show that the claimed promotion ranks are commensurate with the positions and commissioned ranks they were then actually holding in Bataan for about two months before they were commissioned from the status of "acting commissioned" officers to actual "commissioned" ranks; that there was actually an existing T/O vacancy; that the said T/O vacancy have existed because a number of officers became battle casualties or were inefficient in the performance of their duties, hence, for the best interests of the service it became eminently necessary for division commanders to replace these officers with qualified and deserving enlisted men who have shown exemplary leadership and ability in the performance of their duties in the field under battle conditions, pursuant to the authority of the Commanding General, USFIP, vested on Division Commanding Generals.

10. The circumstances which surround the promotion of the enlisted men listed hereon and the circumstance leading to the fact of issuance of Special Orders covering such promotions, being transmitted to the subordinate units of the Division by the issuance of Division General Orders as far as the enlisted men are concerned were normal under the circumstances then at Bataan, for they disclose a chain of circumstances which give creditability to the evidences presented establishing the issuance of the orders of promotion.

II. CONCLUSIONS:


The promotion to commissioned ranks and subsequent call to active duty as reserve officers of subject enlisted men listed hereon were finally approved and Special Orders announcing such promotion were issued by GHQ, Fort Mills, Corregidor, as evidenced by the wording of General Orders No. 38.


III. RECOMMENDATION:

The confirmation of promotion to commissioned ranks, as indicated above, and the call to active duty as reserve officer effective 30 March 1942 of the officers and enlisted men listed hereon is APPROVED.
