


1. Project initiated to verify authenticity of four lists of released war prisoners who landed at Ubay, Bohol on or prior to 5 Jun 43. Lists were prepared by guerrilla units of the Bohol Force (8th Mil Dist) and contain alleged information pertinent to Ex-POW's from O'Donnell Concentration Camp. Three of the lists (dated 6 & 11 Jun 43 one not dated) were located among records of guerrilla activities forwarded to MPRC by Chief, Comptroller Division, TAGO (1953) for incorporation with archives in RPR B. The other list, dated 24 Apr 43, was located in 201 File for Demetrio B. Fernandez.

2. The two lists dated 6 & 11 Jun 43 contain the same names (some variations in spellings) and addresses of 124 released war prisoners, (no ranks shown) who landed at Ubay, Bohol on 5 Jun 43. The 124 names shown on these lists are also listed in Manila Tribune dated 22 May 43 (some variations in spellings) under the caption "Bohol Ex-Soldiers sent Home." This evidence, indicating the released war prisoners left Manila Area for Bohol o/a 22 May 43, tends to substantiate the information contained in the two lists. 201 Files for the individuals listed show that 97 have been determined positive for POW status, 13 determined negative, 2 no determinations, and 7 files contain miscellaneous papers only. Files were not located for 5 individuals (no negative search made). Allegations in 201 Files, regarding date left Manila Area and/or date arrived in Bohol, and home address correspond with related information shown on two lists involved.

3. The one list (not dated-noted in Par 1) is a partial list of released war prisoners that arrived at Ubay, Bohol before 5 Jun 43. List contains names and addresses of 21 released war prisoners (no rank shown). 201 Files for the individuals listed show that 17 have been determined positive for POW status, 1 determined negative (Pos for USAFFE), 2 names (last name only shown on list) have not been identified, 1 file was not located. Alleged dates individuals left Manila Area and/or arrived in Bohol, indicate arrival in Bohol prior to 5 Jun 43, as stated on list involved. Alleged home addresses are compatible with those shown on the list.

4. The list dated 24 Apr 43 contains the names and ranks of 12 individuals and states they are released Japanese prisoners proceeding to Ubay (Bohol) aboard a banca. 201 Files located for 9 of the names listed, 5 of which also appear on foregoing partial list of released war prisoners who arrived at Ubay, Bohol before 5 Jun 43. 3 files not located. All 201 Files contain positive determinationf for POW status. Except for two one-grade discrepancies, alleged ranks are consistent with those shown on list. 8 of the 9 alleged they left Manila Area and/or arrived in Bohol during period Apr-May 43. The other individual failed to allege any specific information regarding date left Manila Area and/or arrived in Bohol.

5. Records of the Bohol Force(on file in Rec Br, RPRD) show the guerrilla organization, officially recognized as the Bohol Area Command on 21 Oct 43, was in existence on or prior to 20 Nov 42. Records indicate that units of the organization were engaged in guerrilla or anti-Japanese activities at or in the vicinities of Talibon and Ubay, Bohol during period Apr-Jun 43. In line with their activities, it appears that they were in a position to have knowledge of released war prisoners who returned to the area in which these units were stationed. Information on file shows that the individuals

Based upon the nature and origin of these lists, the information contained therein is not acceptable as the sole determining evidence of USAFFE or POW status. However, the consistency of information contained in the lists, with that alleged in 201 Files and shown in Manila Tribune dated 22 May 43, tends to establish the veracity of the information contained in the lists. This veracity is further established by the fact that 118 of the 134 files located contain positive determinations for USAFFE and POW status. Although not acceptable as the sole determining evidence of USAFFE or POW, the information contained in the lists should be considered sufficient basis to warrant acceptance as secondary or supporting evidence of USAFFE or POW status, or possibly Missing status.

7. RECOMMENDATIONS:

- b. That the lists be accepted as secondary or supporting evidence of USAFFE or POW, or possibly Missing status.
- c. That the lists be filed with this Project for ready reference in any case which may arise.

TO: SUBJECTS: The Chief S-2, Bohol Force I would like to add:

1. One hundred twenty-four (124) released war prisoners mostly affected with Malaria landed in Ubay June 5, 1943 headed by Lt. Manile. List of men here attached.

2. Due to no instructions given by the Detachment Commander of Ubay, some of these released prisoners went directly to their home town while the rest are on the way to Carmen to report. Only 4 reported before the office of the S-2 3rd Battalion.

3. According to investigation, no JC is with the party except Pedro Clema, Mayor of Fauglae and a wanted person in the Bohol Force.

4. The undersigned could not act swiftly on the ground that the communication re-this matter reached this office too late. Had the DCO of Ubay reported this matter on time, these released prisoners should not have been scattered instead we could let them report to Carmen as per standing regulations.




