MEMORANDUM: Lost Archive Records Re: Feleses, Leonardo

SUBJECT: Location of Archive (Sep 41 roster Combat Co, 81st Inf)

1. An Archive extract, GSXRP Form #7A, shows one Felices, Leonardo, Cpl as appearing on an Archive of "Comb Co, Hq Bn 81 Inf Cp Lapulapu" with remarks: "Attch above orgn 30 Sep 41." (PA 81-1 Pg 37)

2. No archive reference card can be located and the specific archive remark cannot be found on available Archives. Contents of Archive references folder PA 81-1, was split and placed into new reference folders, prior to Records being brought to U.S. Archives from PA 81-1 can be located in 330.32 F38 and 38A (81st Inf), however page 37 (and 36) and possibly other pages are not included therein. Pages numbered 1 thru 4; 6 thru 8; 10 thru 35; and 38 thru 43 of the PA 81-1 sequence can be identified. The numbers of 4 pages cannot be ascertained; however, subject's name did not appear on any of <sup>these</sup> ~~unnumbered~~ pages.

3. Investigation File of 81st Inf revealed names of several former members of Combat Co, 81st Inf.

Of the seven names checked, six would have been in the position of being listed on roster Combat Co, 81st Inf, Sep 41. Four of the six files contain an extract (GSXRP Form 7A) containing similar info to that of S/I.

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4. With the exception of references pertaining to discharge and/or guerrilla archives, no archive reference index cards were found on file in MCIF for the six enlisted men.

5. Summary:

There are no records on file for Combat Company, Hq Bn 81st Infantry, however, there are rosters of 1st & 2nd Bn, 81st Infantry, September 1941, on file. Markings on folders indicate that they were once referenced as PA 81-1. (Note: Many of the archive records have similar markings that were used by some predecessor organization - The first digits of the symbol usually indicate the regimental designation and the digit(s) following the "dash" indicate the folder. (ie: "101-1" would mean the first folder of records concerning the 101st Infantry.) Extracts of (GSXRP Form 7A) referenced to other records have been found and traced to the appropriate counterpart in our current file set up. In cases concerning a numbered regiment, the reference was most usually correct.

No explanation can be offered for the absence of records that assuredly must have been under some predecessor's custodianship. A comprehensive search through our record holdings (USAFFE-PA and Project "J" Archives) have not located records in question, nor has any explanation for the loss thereof been found.

6. Recommend that the information contained on GSXRP Forms #7A concerning Combat Company, Headquarters Battalion, 81st Infantry Camp Lapulapu be accepted as an authentic archive report of a roster of above organization dated September 1941. Further recommend that a copy of this "Memo"

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be placed with USAFFE Archives 330.32 Folder 38 and 38A for information purposes.
