PROPOSED EXPANSION OF THE
PUNCHED CARD INDEX
GUERRILLA AFFAIRS DIVISION (GAD) ROSTERS
TO INCLUDE THE REVISED ROSTERS

1. PROBLEM

a. The Recovered Personnel Records Branch proposes a one time project concerning the revised guerrilla rosters to -

(1) Create a punched card on each of approximately 37,500 individuals currently carried on the revised rosters

(2) Interfile the 37,500 cards into the current punched card index (approximately 250,000 cards) of the Recognized Guerrilla Rosters.

2. DISCUSSION

a. Background. At the time of the Philippine liberation approximately 250,000 guerrillas were recognized and their names entered on various rosters. These rosters were combined into one file known as the Guerrilla Affairs Division (GAD) Rosters. While the records were still in the Philippines, a punched index card was created on each individual to show name, grade, command (by a numerical designation), folder (roster) number, and page number (SEE Incl 1). Subsequent study and evaluation brought about creation of a revised recognized guerrilla file, 116 rosters, which authorized an earlier recognition date in the case of approximately ^{44,500}~~37,500~~ individuals included on the original rosters. (SEE Incl 2). No index cards were prepared on the revised rosters and approximately 120 inquiries each month require a manual search of the rosters without benefit of index (SEE Incl 3).

b. Equipment Requirements

(1) This Center currently has on rental the keypunch, verifier, interpreter, and sorter which would be required to create and alphabetize the 37,500 cards.

(2) Also on rental is a Reproducing Punch not required in the project as proposed. (Reference paragraph below)

(3) No additional tabulating card filing equipment would be required in RPRB. Sufficient expansion space exists in present equipment.

c. Manhours and Cost

(1) The manhours required and the approximate cost of creating and interfiling the 37,500 punched card index for the revised rosters are presented in detail for each machine and manual operation on inclosure number four. Approximately 530 manhours of machine operator time and 320 manhours of manual operations would be required at a labor cost of \$ 1,569.43. Adding the \$ 41.25 materials cost would bring the total estimated cost for the project to \$ 1,610.68.

(2) The possibility of mechanical interfiling of the new cards through the use of a collator was considered, but not favorably because -

(a) This Center does not have a collator on rental at this time. The merging of the cards would require 13 to 14 hours of machine time but the shortest rental period is one month with approximately eight months lead time on the order.

(b) The condition of the cards in the original file, now about ten years old, indicates that considerable jamming could be expected. The deck could be duplicated on new card stock by the Reproducing Punch currently on rental; however, again jamming would ^{also} be a factor. ^{in reproducing} If the cards were in excellent condition, reproducing the deck at 100 cards per minute would take 41 manhours. Interpreting would take an additional 69 hours. The 110 hours at \$ 1.84 (middle step of a GS 2) would cost \$ 202.40. Adding the \$ 275.00 cost of the 250 thousand cards at \$ 1.10 per thousand would bring the total cost of reproducing the current card file to \$ 477.00.

(c) All of the cards in the original file are not key-punched. As cards were damaged in searching over the years they were replaced with typed cards which would be rejected in the merging operation. The number of these cards is not known and variously estimated from 2,000 to 5,000. Taking an average of 3,500 cards, punching, ~~with~~ verifying, interpreting ~~and~~ and alphabetizing on the sorter would require approximately 50 hours of machine operator time. Manual interfiling would require approximately 79 manhours. The 79 manhours at \$ 1.84 (middle step of GS 2) would cost approximately \$ 145.36. Adding the \$ 3.85 cost of the 3½ thousand cards at \$ 1.10 per thousand would bring the total to \$ 149.21. Elimination of the manual interfiling, preparation of the 3,500 cards for mechanical interfiling would cost approximately \$ 95.85.

d. Savings. The branch chief has estimated 120 cases of the average monthly archive requests require a manual search of the revised rosters. The proposed expansion of the index file would save approximately 8 minutes per case, or 192 manhours per year. At \$ 1.96 per hour (middle step of GS 3) a savings of \$ 376.32 per year would be realized and the cost of the project offset in a little over 4 years. Whereas the savings are based on the current workload, it should be pointed out that there is continuing interest in the Philippine records and constant pressure being exerted in Washington to reopen many of the claims or expand benefits. The expansion of the index at this time could help considerably to soften the impact of any future crash project.

e. Future ADP Applications. In order to evaluate the economic soundness of correcting the deficiencies outlined in paragraphs 2c(2)(b) and 2c(2)(c) above, consideration was given to possible use of the file in some future ADP application in REEB. The cards are simply an index for the rosters and the data contained on the cards is solely index information.

If a decision was made at some future date to mechanize certain operations in RPRB it would be much more practical to capture the data from the rosters rather than the data on the index cards.

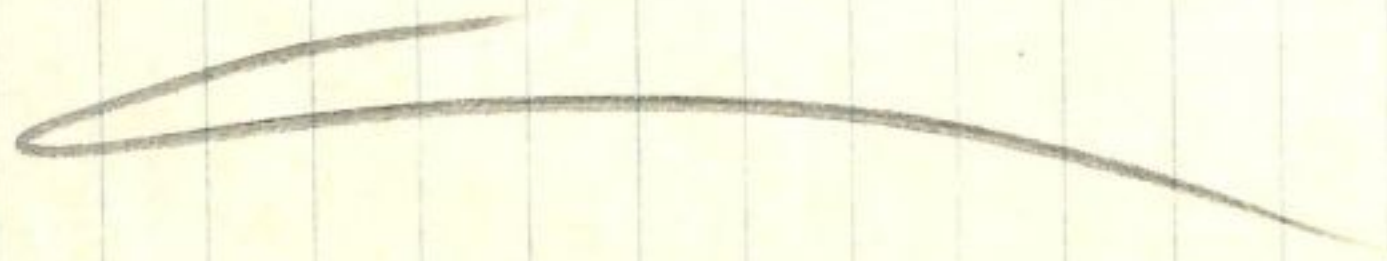
3. CONCLUSIONS. If funds and personnel are available, it would be economically and functionally sound to utilize existing free time on the presently rented EAM equipment to create punched index cards for the revised rosters, and interfile them manually in the Guerrilla Affairs Division (GAD) Roster Index. Based on ~~the~~ recent/estimated machine utilization data it was the project would be spread out over approximately a three months period; however, this is subject to revision after the impact of the retired records transfer is fully evaluated.

4. RECOMMENDATIONS. It is recommended that-
- a. A punched index card be created for each individual on the Revised Guerrilla Troop Rosters similar in design to inclosure number 5.
 - b. The cards be interfiled manually into the present index.

STANDING OPERATING PROCEDURE FOR PREPARATION OF
PUNCHED CARD INDEX FOR REVISED GUERRILLA AFFAIRS DIVISION ROSTER

1. Plan. To prepare a punched card on each of 37,500 names currently shown on 116 revised rosters in RPRB. The cards will be interfiled with the master file comprising the original Recognized Guerrilla Roster.

2. General Information

a. Personnel rosters will be brought down to the EAM work area in groups or individually from RPRB as time permits. Control of the rosters being processed in the key punch area will be kept by RPRB. A close liaison will be maintained between the Chief, Records Section, RPRB, and the supervisor of the Processing Unit, Records Section, PWW II Branch, to insure a sufficient workflow. A punched card will be prepared for each name on the roster. Key punching and verification will be completed before the individual roster is returned to RPRB. A daily record will be kept of the number of cards handled and the amount of time expended in each of the separate work areas - punching, verifying, sorting, and interfiling.

b. There are four basic types of rosters used (samples attached). The rosters vary in format; however, with the exception of the service number in some instances, the information requested is complete. A sample roster of each type has been prepared with the correct source of information encircled.

3. Card Design. Attached is a work sheet showing the card design. The seven specific items of information are listed on the left side. The maximum number of columns available and the specific location of the items of information are shown to the right.

4. Source of Information for Items on Punched Card and Columns Used

a. Number on roster (1 - 4) found directly to the left of the name on all rosters.

b. Name (6 - 54) found opposite the number on the roster. Name should be typed in the following order - last name, first name, middle initial. Extreme care should be taken with Filipino names since they sometimes differ in arrangement from the English. In addition, some rosters list the names in signature order rather than last name, first, etc. To assist the operator in ascertaining the correct method of punching, and so that order of name will agree with method used by RPRB clerks in searching, the following guide is furnished:

Some names may be illegible and hard to read because of the fuzziness of the type on the carbon copy. In these cases the small letters, a, e, o, and s, may cause trouble. For this reason, when the second letter or the first vowel of the last name cannot be determined as an "e" or an "o," two cards will be punched, one with an "e" and the other with an "o." When it is questionable whether the letter is an "a" or an "s," RPRB should be contacted for further verification of the letter.

c. Service number (56 - 62) may or may not be found in all instances. If available, it should be opposite the name. When no service number is found, or where the service number exceeds six digits, leave columns 56 - 62 blank.

d. Rank/Grade (64 - 66) should be found on all rosters. In most instances, this data will be found opposite the name. Sometimes the rank for a group of names will be shown at the top of the page and apply to all names on that page. Abbreviations as shown on the card design consisting of only three characters should be used.

e. Folder number (68 - 70) found in red pencil on upper right corner of front of folder.

f. Page number / (72 - 75) found in red ink, centered at the bottom of the page.

g. Command symbol / (77 - 80) found under the folder number in red pencil.

5. Verifying. Cards will be verified as soon as practicable after punching so that rosters may be returned to RPRB. Cards will be retained in machine unit area until all are punched and verified.

6. Sorting. Cards will be sorted to the 10th column on the name. On completion of sort, boxes will be marked and forwarded to RPRB for manual inter-filing.
