

- 1. Reference is made to the attached request from Mr. Jesus A. Villamar for copies of documents pertaining to the guerrilla resistance movement in the Philippines (Incl 1).
- 2. The documents requested by Mr. Villamor were reviewed by Mr. Alexander T. Iorio, USARCEM, during his visit to Washington and by representatives of this office. This review indicated that the majority of the documents did not contain information which, if released, could be used to support a claim for guerrilla recognition. There was, however, a question as to the advisability of releasing the remaining documents. It has therefore been determined that the documents should be given further review and screening before any are released.
- 3. In view of the above, request that a review be made of the documents requested by Mr. Villamor and that the following types of documents be separated from those which should be released:
- a. Documents which contain information of a derogatory nature on public or prominent Philippine nationals.
- b. Documents consisting of personal or private correspondence between individuals the release of which would be inappropriate without the consent of the individuals involved.
- c. Any other documents which contain information considered inappropriate for release.
- 3. Upon completion of the review, request the documents be returned to this office. Copies of the documents requested by Mr. Villamor are being mailed under separate cover. The original documents were classified. However, the Assistant Chief of Staff, Intelligence reviewed the material and indicated no military security objection to their declassification. A copy of ACSI comments is attached as Inclosure 2.



ACTION AGAINST THE UNITED STATES. IN ANY EVENT, I CAN
ASSURE THE ARMY THAT UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL ANY OF
THESE PAPERS BE USED BY ME FOR CLAIMS OR ACTION AGAINST
THE UNITED STATES. FURTHERMORE, I CAN ALSO ASSURE THE ARMY
THAT THESE PAPERS, OR ANY PORTION THEREOF, WILL NOT BE
PROVIDED BY ME TO A THIRD PARTY FOR USE ON ANY CLAIM OR
ACTION AGAINST THE UNITED STATES.

HOPING THAT WAVORABLE ACTION WILL BE TAKEN AT THE EARLIEST DATE POSSIBLE, AND THANKING YOU FOR YOUR ATTENTION ON THIS MATTER, I REMAIN,

One ATR-4A set used by Andrews for local traffic. . set was out of commission at the time I left. There were no spare part available.

One handmade set, operating on 7019 Kilocycles, was sent last June to Sorsogon or Albay with an agent named Arthur Zayco. No contact was established up to the time of my departure.

I would want to give a set to my man in Panay, my man in Leyte, and my man in Cebu. I do not want to depend on guerrillas. Also I would want to have a set in Batangas and one in Bondoc. These sets can very well be of the ATR-4A type.

The Cushing set in Cebu (PNM) is now in con-

tact with Andrews.

Street Street

There are several agents in Manila who are expected to be able to contact Andrews by radio any day now.

Villamor's agents extended throughout the Visayas and Luzcn. A Jist of agents in November 1943 (taken from Villamor's report) together with their qualifications and assignments follows:

Abila, Enrique - 2nd Lt., 4th year law student, very courageous and capable, Bataan veteran, once my chief agent in Cebu (see Cebu Report 15, 15 June 43); now assigned Manila. No. BW-11. Secret name: "Dimples." Assumed name: Andrew Lutao.

Abila, Apolonic, Jr - 3rd Lt., brother of above, commercial student, courageous but not quite so capable as his brother; now assigned as counter-espionage agent in Bacolod. No. DC-3. Secret name: "Shadow." Assumed name: Arturo Melgar. (Killed in Bacolod about November 1943).

Alonso, Florencio - 2nd Lt., commercial student, young, adventurous and capable; assigned to central Luzon. No.

Q-62. Assumed name: Antonio Lopez.

Alunan, Rafael - Prominent politician and government official, both under the Commonwealth and the Japanesesponsored government; qualifications already well known; loyalty unquestionable; excellent contacts.

Alvarez, Santiago - 2nd Lt., C.P.A., graduate LaSalle College, intelligent, capable, but may show some weakness when under strain. Assigned Cebu area at the time I left but may not be there now. No. B-26. Assumed name: Rafael Parez. (With 7th MD, Jan 45.)

Benedicto, Roberto - Maj., lawyer, graduate of University of Philippines, was Chief of G-2 for Apcede; good head, cool and very capable. My intention was for him to run the net during my absence. No. P-38. Secret name: "Lightning."

Castaneda, Modesto - Capt., Bataan veteran, Signal Officer, capable but at times has a tendency to want to do things his own way. Formerly assigned Bohol area, but now on his way to Luzon to contact guerrilla units. No. PT-5. Secret name: "Cactus."

Claraval, Juan - About 38 years old, district inspector Streets and Bridges Div., City Hall, Manila; used by ZT to gather information on installations, supply depots, etc.

Concha, Jose - 2nd Lt., commercial student, Manila, very courageous and loyal; assigned Manila. No. 02. (In

Laguna with Capt. Villanueva late 1944.)

Culminaras, Josquin - Graduate engineer, has built a set for our net in Manila, but has not been able to put it in operation; contacted through ZT. (Later Signal Officer under Lt. Col. Andrews; assigned 4th PA Replace-

Luzuriago, Roberto - Commercial graduate, Luzon courageous, cool, and very capable; assigned Manila and contacted various people there, including AN, "Professor," and ZT; brought back excellent reports; presently with Andrews. No. MW-13. (With Thunderbird at Ramsey's Hqs, near Montalban, Rizal, early 1945.)

Luzuriago, Angeles R. de - Sister of above, excellent contacts, sound judgment; password to be used should she be contacted, "Cadena de amor."

Mack - Col., U.S. Quartermaster; presently a PW in Capanatuan; all information regarding PW's may be obtained through him; may a contacted through AN. No AC.

Manzano, Narciso - Lt. Col., Corps of Engineer., PS; very well known to various members of GHQ; experienced, with sound judgment and excellent contacts; unquestionably

the best agent in Luzon. No. AN.

Mondonedo, Osmundo - Lt., PAAC, very well known to me, having been my Engineering Officer at the 6th Pursuit Squadron. Graduate of Randolph and Kelly Fields; courageous, intelligent, and very capable; may be contacted through AN. No. ON-2.

Montelibano, Alfredo - Governor of Negros, intelligent, very capable, of unquestionable loyalty, excellent contacts; now in vicinity of Bacolod. No. N-90.

O'Classen, Frank - American mestizo, graduate engineer, with responsible position in RCA and Philippine long distance, helped put up radio station in Guam before the war; now compelled to work by and for the Japs, furnishing most data re radio activities of the Japs; intimate friend of AN. No. CL.

Padilla, Ambrosio - Lawyer, bright, loyal, very capable, excellent contacts in Manila; may be contacted through

"Professor."

Seater (first name unknown) - Lt., Engineers, confined in Corregidor; may be contacted through AN. No. EA. (On Corregidor to December 1944; then no trace.)

Silliman, Robert - Deputy Governor South Negros; former Professor of History at Silliman (nc relation) University; intelligent, with a very analytical mind; assigned Dumaguete area. No. T-70. (Since evacuated.)

Soler, Cipriano - Civilian engineer; very good friend of AN, was formerly Chief Engineer of Bataan Province. No. OL.

Suplemento (first name unknown) - 1st Sgt., 14th Engineers; intelligent, with plenty of initiative; contacted through

AN, Manila. No. UP.

Tanada, Lorenzo - Lawyer, brilliant and very loyal, one of the secret society called "Free Filipinos" now in existence in Manila; excellent connections and contacts; if contact with him is desired, agent sent to interview must insist on wanting the advice of a "counselor" and not an "attorney," Secret name: "Hara." Assigned Manila.

Teruel. Raymundo - Commercial student, very quiet but most efficient, courageous, and loyal; formerly with 6th MD in G-2. Has been most helpful to me since the day he reported; now with Andrews. No. UW-19. (In Manila with Luzuriaga late 1944.)

Unknown name - Cpl. of 14th Engineers, foreman at Nielson

Airport, former student of and now used by AN.

Uriarte, Higinio - Spanish Basque, very loyal, helped guerrillas during early days, intelligent and courageous; unassigned due to recent Jap order for his arrest, having been one of those who helped the guerrillas; excellent contacts, however, still maintained. Secret name: "Gudari." (In Negros as of mid-March 1945.)

Veyra, Jesus de - Attorney, very brilliant, very capable, with excellent contacts, main contact man in Manila, AN, "Hara," and ZT may be contacted through him; password from me to him, "Halivo"; password from agent who contacted him (MW-13) to him is "obligations and contracts." Secret name: "Professor."

Zayco, Arthur - Mining engineer, little lazy but cool, capable, and yal; assigned Bicol area v h a home-built set (7019 Kc) which has not been contacted yet. No. AW-21. Secret name: "Camote Bill." Assumed name: Juan Gomez. (Now 7th MD - relieved from Bicols, radio would not work.)

Zayco, Hermenegildo - Chemical engineer, intelligent and capable, helped me in my office work since he joined me; both of above now with Andrews. No. AA-11. Secret name: "Carabao." (Adjutant to Andrews in Negros early

1945.)

Zayco, William - Cousin of above; courageous, not as capable as his cousins but what he lacks in mental ability he makes up in mechanical ability; formerly first mechanic International Harvester, worked in Nichols Field for the Japs; now assigned landing fields in Luzon, at present probably working either in Lipa Airfield or in proposed field in Pasig. No. XW-23. Secret name: "Kargaroo." Assumed name: Eduardo Arce. (In Manila early 1945.)

Members of the "Free Philippines" Secret Society(38) Tanada; Dr. Antonio Bautista; Dr. Anselmo Claudio;
Jose Barrera; Roberto Concepcion; Jose Reyes, B.L.;

Rafael Roces, Jr.

The Villamor net was to have been supplied with radios for the development of communications within his net. This was not done until just before he left Negros and then only a few were sent. In the meantime, agents were sent out on foot to collect intelligence and had to return on foot to the Negros Headquarters. Their intelligence value was largely unrealized, and Maj. Villamor was not given credit for his own efforts. All Visayan agents were later withdrawn and concentrated on Luzon. (39)

This tendency to ignore experience and existing organizations is one of the less creditable characteristics of the otherwise brilliant intelligence enterprise in the Philippines. There was no need for a new broom; the Villamor net, properly supported, was chronologically a full year ahead of Maj. (then Capt.) L.H. Phillips, Smith, and Lt. Comdr. George Rowe.(40) It had direct and important entree into Manila. What little support the intrepid Cruz received, he got from Abcede and the limited means then available on Negros. Another victim of pointless duplication, to be shelved, was Col. Manzano; the bona fide Roxas agent coming from Luzon with incalculable military background and desperately trying to get out of Mindanao to reach GHQ.(41)

21. End of the Hamner (Tenwest) Party:
Maj. Hamner was also withdrawn from the Philippines
with little ultimate credit for work done.

He was sent to Mindanao 23 May 1943, arrived on Tawi Tawi in July, and established radio contact with Australia



- 1. Reference is made to the attached request from Mr. Jesus A. Villamor for copies of documents pertaining to the guerrilla resistance movement in the Philippines (Incl 1).
- 2. The documents requested by Mr. Villamor were reviewed by Mr. Alexander T. Iorio, USARCEM, during his visit to Washington and by representatives of this office. This review indicated that the majority of the documents did not contain information which, if released, could be used to support a claim for guerrilla recognition. There was, however, a question as to the advisability of releasing the remaining documents. It has therefore been determined that the documents should be given further review and screening before any are released.
- 3. In view of the above, request that a review be made of the documents requested by Mr. Villamor and that the following types of documents be separated from those which should be released:
- a. Documents which contain information of a derogatory nature on public or prominent Philippine nationals.
- b. Documents consisting of personal or private correspondence between individuals the release of which would be inappropriate without the consent of the individuals involved.
- c. Any other documents which contain information considered inappropriate for release.
- 3. Upon completion of the review, request the documents be returned to this office. Copies of the documents requested by Mr. Villamor are being mailed under separate cover. The original documents were classified. However, the Assistant Chief of Staff, Intelligence reviewed the material and indicated no military security objection to their declassification. A copy of ACSI comments is attached as Inclosure 2.



AT ONE TIME HE TEMPORARILY COMMANDED THE SEVENTH MILITARY DISTRICT A RECOGNIZED GUERRILLA ORGANIZATION. THERE ARE A LARGE NUMBER OF DOCUMENTS IN THE FILES CONCERNING THE RECOGNITION OF UNITS ALLEGEDLY ESTABLISHED BY VILLAMOR OR HIS SUCCESSOR LIEUTENANT COLONEL E. C. ANDREWS. CHECK NOTES INDICATE THE PRINCIPAL MEMBERS OF THE GHO STAFF WERE INVOLVED AT ONE TIME OR ANOTHER WITH THE PROBLEM OF RECOGNITION. SPECIFICALLY, THE CHIEF OF STAFF, THE DEPUTY CHIEF OF STAFF AND GENERAL WILLOUGHBY. COPIES OF MESSAGES IN THE FILES INDICATE VILLAMOR SERVED AS OFFICIAL REPRESENTATIVE OF GENERAL MAC ARTHUR IN THAT ORDERS APPOINTING COMMANDERS WERE TRANSMITTED THROUGH HIM. MESSAGE 8 JULY 1943 STATES, " YOU WILL REVERT TO POSITION MY REPRESENTATIVE THAT AREA PENDING DEPART-URE." NO INDICATION HAS BEEN FOUND THAT VILLAMOR HIMSELF HAS TAKEN ANY SPECIFIC ACTION TO OBTAIN RECOGNITION OF EITHER INDIVIDUALS OR UNITS AND IT IS IMPOSSIBLE TO DETERMINE WHETHER ACTION TAKEN BY OTHERS WAS AT HIS INSTIGATION OR NOT. 
