a. b. While no exmet figure can be furnished in reply to this request a reasonably accurate estimate has been made for guarrillas at a conference with members of the Guerrilla Affairs Division, and for USAFFE by an examination of the files of RPD. These estimates are contained in Inol #2 (Tab B) to proposed reply (Tab A).

- c. PHILEYCOM is the only agency of the Department of the Army qualified to make an estimate on this subject. In proposed reply (Tab A) it is pointed out that changes will occur in these data by reason of future determinations made by RFD for USAFFE and possible recognitions or revocations by the Guerrilla Affairs Division.
- d. Detailed inter-division study as to the method of arriving at figures shown in Incl #2 (Tab B) is attached as Tab D.
