SUBJECT: Accident, report of.

To : CO, Sp Tre, 6th Inf Div PA

1. At about 1500 18 March 1946, a verbal report was received by Capt Rafael Gencobragon, CO Hq Co, 6th Inf Div PA from Sgt Lucio Payot, Pg Co that Jeep No 20424734 driven by Pfc Vicente Baggican turned turtle on Sunilag-Mam Road about 3-1/2 miles east from Alao Crossing. Capt Rafael Gencobragon with Major E. L. Bihay, two medical officers, Lt Edges and several MP enlisted men went to the scene of the accident for investigation and the following were found.

(a) That Pfc Vicente Baggican and Pvt Fornea Cruz both of the Hq Co, 6th Inf Div PA at about 1000 18 March 1946 took the above-mentioned car for the purposes of gathering pineapples. That said Pfc Vicente Baggican drove the car without the authority of the MTO nor from his Commanding Officer, Capt Rafael Gencobragon. He made trip to that area without any trip ticket. That while passing the barrio behind the area occupied by the Hq Co they took with them Emilia Bacariza, common-law-wife of Spt Francisco Dionaldo and one Rosebie Nagueta. That returning to station at about 1430 Pfc Baggican in spite of rough road drove the jeep recklessly and made over 30 MPH speed causing the car to zigzag out of control. Then the car turned turtle head facing toward the rear. *while

(b) Emilia Bacariza suffered skull fracture and several contusions on her body which caused her sudden death; Pvt Vicente Baggican, the driver suffered slight bruise on right eye; Rosebie Nagueta suffered shock; and Pvt Fornea Cruz also suffered slight bruised left arm and **left** leg.

(c) The jeep sustained the following damages: Right and left fender smashed; hood dented; left side light broken; windshield broken; radiator leaking; Tie rod connectives (left) bent; right headlight broken.

2. In view of the foregoing, this office concludes that Pfc Vicente Baggican is guilty of offense falling under 96 AW under two counts while Pvt Fornea Cruz is likewise guilty under 96th AP on one count. Charges are being preferred against them.
