The following memorandum is hereby published for the information and guidance of all concerned.

1. Hereafter, it is directed that the corresponding pay and allowances for the number of days of absence without leave or any unauthorized absence will be withheld, as the pay and allowances do not accrue to any person in the military service during unauthorized absence in excess of 24 hours. All Unit Commanders and all persons concerned will be guided and governed by the provisions of AR 35-1420 which state in part:

"1 a. * * * * *

b. In the absence of a court-martial finding thereon, it is sufficient to justify the withholding of pay and allowances that the fact of an unauthorized absence appears upon the morning report of the company.

"2. How unauthorized absence computed.- a. Unauthorized absence of less than 24 hours other than those following leave of absence of officers (See Ar 605-115) do not affect pay or allowances and should be omitted from pay-rolls and individual vouchers regardless of whether such absence are in one day or cover part of two days. In unauthorized absence resulting from overstaying leave of absence of officers the day of return is a day of absence, whatever the hour.

b. In an unauthorized absence in excess of 24 hours duration of any person in the military service, the day of departure is a day of absence, and except in cases of unauthorized absence of officers (AR 605-115) resulting from overstaying leave of absence, the day of return is a day of duty for purposes of computing pay and allowances.

* * * * *

c. * * * * *

d. * * * * *

Except in the case of clothing allowances (See par. 9a, AR 615-40) where allowances are fixed on a daily basis, only one day's allowances will be forfeited.


"3. Effect upon accrual of pay and allowances.- a. Neither pay nor allowances accrue to any person in military service during unauthorized absences in excess of 24 hours, unless excused as unavoidable. * * * * *

2. It must be understood that this memorandum does not imply to exempt officers and enlisted men who absent themselves without leave or for unauthorized absences, from being brought before a Court-martial. And whether they are court-martialed for this offense, or not, the withholding of pay and allowances shall be carried out as directed.

3. Unit Commanders will prepare and attach with the payroll or voucher a certified list of all absentees, entering thereon among other things required for audit purposes, the inclusive dates of absences and the amounts to be withheld from each individual, and citing the memorandum order as authority thereof. The list submitted must agree with the entries made in the Morning Report and Duty Roster. The list shall be prepared and submitted so as to reach the Finance Officer in sufficient number of copies that he needs in order to expedite accounting or auditing.

4. This memorandum order shall be strictly complied with.

1. It has been noted for a number of days in the past that some members of the command in this camp are not performing their duties because they like them, but rather, they are performing them because they are required by regulations, or because they were ordered to do so by superior authority. It is obvious that with such spirit as motivating force nothing of great consequence to the organization can be accomplished. Let us not forget what President Quezon once said; "be more missionary rather than mercenary". Following this precept, our conduct then in the past should be revised to make it a more deserving pattern for our subordinates and for those who are coming after us.

2. It has been noted also, among officers and men alike, that there seem to be a race for getting passes to be out of camp. The regulation issued by the GHQ in this connection is clear and must be complied with. Let us not forget that when we accepted our positions and when we took our oath, we sold to the government everything; our energy, our service, our time and even our liberty as an individual. This headquarters will not deny any officer or man for getting legitimate pass if there is good and justifiable reason for it. But what is happening is that an exception is becoming to be the rule. Let us not forget that in the past, one of the main reasons for the GHQ in adopting the policy of not assigning an officer in or near his home province is precisely to cut down to the minimum the number of unnecessary passes of officers. For our own interest it is therefore up to us not to give the GHQ any cause for reviving the aforementioned policy by reducing as much as possible our passes.
