**ADMINISTRATION**

1. Until such time as Army Regulations are available for distribution the administration of the Philippine Army will follow the former system, and that of the United States Army. Temporarily, it will be necessary to use United States Army blank forms in all cases where such forms can be used intact or modified to suit requirements. An initial supply will be furnished all units without request as they become available. Pending receipt of the initial supply, the use of improvised forms is authorized.

2. Directives and instructions from this headquarters to the Army will be issued in the following publications:

- a. General Orders
- b. Special orders
- c. Letter Orders
- d. Circulars
- e. Bulletins

3. Subordinate units will issue:

- a. General Orders (not issued by a unit smaller than a regiment or separate battalion. Orders issued on routine matters by the commander of a battalion forming part of a regiment, or of companies and detachments will be designated as "orders" and number in a single series for each calendar year.)
- b. Special Orders
- c. Letter Orders
- d. Memoranda

Authority of this headquarters will be obtained prior to the issuance of any other type of publication.

4. Correspondence.

- a. Letters and intersements will be forwarded through command channels and will be the normal method for conducting official correspondence. Informal memorandums and carrier notes will be used for inter-office communication.
- b. This headquarters will use the United States Army decimal filing system. Lower echelons will follow this system when instructions in its use are available for issue. Until such time, correspondence pertaining to individuals will show the number "201-", followed by the last name, first name and middle initial of the subject individual. General correspondence will bear no identifying file number, but will be filed locally under the subject matter heading

5. Records.

a. Unit. All units will maintain the following records:

b. Individual.

- (1) officer's Classification Card (W.D., A.G.O. Form No. 66-1, US Army)
- (2) Soldier's Qualification Card (W.D., A.G.O. Form No. 20, US Army)
- (3) Service Record (W.D., A.G.O. Form No. 24, United States Army)

c. Payrolls.

- (1) Payrolls (W.D. Form No. 366, United States Army) and when necessary, individual vouchers, for enlisted men will be prepared by detachments and companies.
- (2) Officers will be paid on individual vouchers (Pay and Allowance account, W.D. Form No. 336, United States Army).
- (3) Payrolls and vouchers will be submitted by the 20th of each month to the Finance Officer serving the unit.

6. Reports to Headquarters Philippine Army.

a. Organization accomplishing enlistments or reenlistments will forward a copy of the Enlistment Record or an Extract from the Service Record.

b. All organizations will forward a copy of each officer's classification Card, unless such copy has already been forwarded by another unit.

c. All organizations will submit initial rosters to this headquarters; and thereafter monthly rosters and returns.

d. Records of discharge, desertion and death will be prepared and disposed of substantially as provided in United States Army Regulations, except that where Army Regulations require that certain records be forwarded to the Adjutant General, United States Army, such records will be forwarded to the Adjutant General Philippine Army.

7. Authentication of official documents.

a. Authentication of official documents and correspondence, Headquarters Philippine Army, will be by:

- (1) Signature of the Chief of Staff
- (2) By command of Major General VALDES, with signature of the Adjutant General or an Assistant Adjutant General.
- (3) For the Chief of Staff, with signature of the Adjutant General, Acting Adjutant General or an Assistant Adjutant General
- (4) General Orders, Special Orders, Circulars and Bulletins will be issued "By order of the Secretary of National Defense" follows below the "By order" line.

b. Units other than this headquarters:

- (1) Signature of the Commanding Officer, or
- (2) When addressed to subordinate units, "By order of (Commanding Officer)", with signature of the Adjutant
- (3) When addressed to higher headquarters or to other activities not under the unit's jurisdiction, "For the Commanding Officer", with signature of the Adjutant.

8. Preparation of official documents and correspondence for authentication of the Adjutant General.

The staff section preparing a document for the signature of the Adjutant General will be responsible for its contents.

9. Records of this headquarters.

The Adjutant General's Office is the office of record for this headquarters. Staff sections may keep files for temporary purposes only. Top Secret, Secret and Confidential documents will be kept secure by suitable locks, safes or guard.

Subject: Activation of the 2nd Leyte Company, Philippine Constabulary.

1. By direction of the President, the 2nd Leyte Company, is constituted as a unit of the Philippine Constabulary, effective 4 December 1944, with headquarters at Dulag, Leyte, P. I.

4. Personnel will be assigned to the 2nd Leyte Company, Philippine Constabulary, in accordance with separate instructions issued by this headquarters.

SUBJECT: Control of Prostitution.

TO: All CO, Philippine Army Units.

1. The following letter, MPX 250.1, Headquarters, Military Police Command, USAFFE, APO 501, dated 17 May 1945, subject: "Control of Prostitution", is quoted hereunder for your information and guidance:

"2. Letter War Department, 24 April 1945, Subject: Prostitution in Overseas Theater of Operation, File AG 726.1 (26 March 1945)-B-S-A-SPGAM-M, transmitted to this Headquarters by 1st Indorsement Headquarters USAFFE, 5 May 1945, is quoted for information and guidance:

"1. Numerous unconfirmed reports have reached the War Department that in various overseas theaters the Army has participated, and in certain areas is now participating, in the operation, supervision, sanction, designation, or condoning of brothels -so-called "G.I. Houses of Prostitution" - for the convenience of military personnel and for the purpose of venereal disease control. There has been nothing in official reports to indicate that prostitution is being supported by the Army in theaters of operation; however, the fact that rumor persists that such conditions exist makes it advisable for the War Department to reaffirm its attitude on this subject.

"2. It is recognized that the social chaos among civilians existing in most overseas theaters presents unusually difficult problems in the adjustment of relationships between soldiers and civilians, and that in many areas it is not practicable for the Army to take action which will materially reduce contact between soldiers and prostitutes. Notwithstanding these considerations, if it is true that the Army is guilty of regulating or even condoning prostitution in overseas theaters, the War Department will be open to the charge that it is supporting conditions inimical to the health and welfare of troops. The eventual result might be public scandal with families of military personnel charging the War Department with an unforgivable violation of trust in neglecting to care for the physical and moral well-being of its personnel.

"3. It has been repeatedly demonstrated that the toleration or fostering of organized prostitution is a completely ineffective method of controlling venereal disease, and that on the contrary prostitution contributes a materially higher incidence of these diseases, especially among troops stationed in foreign countries. Furthermore, the operation of brothels under the partial or complete control or supervision of the Army, or their designation for the use of military personnel is medically unsound, socially objectionable, potentially destructive of civilian and military morale, and in direct contravention of War Department policy.

"4. It is therefore desired that necessary action be taken to assure compliance in your command with War Department policy concerning repression of prostitution by all means of available cooperation with civilian authorities in the countries concerned; and where civilian cooperation cannot be obtained to employ all appropriate measures to minimize the availability of prostitutes to military personnel."

2. Similarly, the Commonwealth of the Philippines has the same policy on the prevention of prostitution, and if the Philippine Army is guilty of regulating or even condoning prostitution, it will be open to the charge that it is supporting conditions inimical to the health and welfare of our men. The eventual result might be public scandal with families of military personnel charging the Army with an unforgivable violation of trust in neglecting to care for the physical and moral well-being of its personnel.

3. It is desired that you extend full cooperation to the military authorities for the purpose of carrying out successfully the policy contained in the letter quoted above.



1. Confidential Memorandum from the Secretary of National Defense, Manila, for the Chief of Staff, PA, dtd 9 October 1945, is quoted here-under for the information, guidance and compliance of all concerned:

"1. In view of the magnitude of the tasks assigned now to the Peoples Court and the War crimes Office, it is the earnest desire of this Department that all available facilities and assistance be accorded these two entities in order to hasten the administration of justice to those people who are being or will be arraigned before them for trial.

2. In this connection, it is desired that all guerilla units be required to forward at once to the Department of National Defense copies of all intelligence reports which they have submitted to Higher Headquarters or kept for ~~their~~ record purposes for the period covering the Japanese regime in the Philippines.

3. The intelligence report will subsequently be forwarded to either the Peoples' Court or to the War Crimes Office whenever they provide a substantial basis for or clue to a case."

2. It is desired that Commanding Officers, or their representatives of all guerilla units be required to forward at once the desired report direct to the Office of the Department of National Defense, Manila, so as to reach the latter office in duplicate, and a copy thereof furnished this Headquarters.



1. Definition of Orders:  
Orders are the usual means by which a commander transmits his instructions to units or individuals of his command.
2. Routine Orders:  
Routine orders are those which cover normal administrative operations in connection with either garrison or field service. Routine orders are subdivided into several classes:

General Orders	Special Court Martial Orders
Special Orders	Bulletins
Letter Orders	Circulars
General Court Martial Orders	Memoranda
	Orders
3. General Orders are directives applying to all or large part of a command. They are permanent in duration and of such nature as to be not readily susceptible to incorporation into established regulations.
4. Special Orders are directives in nature and individual in application.
5. Letter Orders: In place of publishing a directive in Special Orders, the directive may be written as a military letter addressed to the individual concerned through normal military channels. A letter of this nature is known as a letter order.
6. Court Martial Orders are issued by each command having authority to order the execution of the sentence of a court martial for the purpose of announcing the result of trial by court martial or for announcing the mitigation, remission, and vacation of a sentence.
  - a. General court-martial orders are used where trial has been by a general-court-martial.
  - b. Special court-martial orders are used where trial has been by a special court-martial.
7. Daily Bulletins: A daily bulletin is an information sheet and usually contains official directives as well as official and unofficial information.
8. Circulars and memoranda: Permanent or semi-permanent instructions may be published in a series of circulars or memoranda. In most headquarters either one but not both of these are used. Data such as are placed in the official section of daily bulletins of lower headquarters are published in circulars or memoranda by higher headquarters.
8. Orders: Directives of a detachment, company, or battalion which is part of a regiment are issued as orders. No other type of routine orders are issued by these units.
