

Low frequency measurements are the most common as electric power is almost universally supplied at 60 cycles; hence, our motors, radios, lights, etc., all operate at this frequency. Voice frequency measurements are necessary in connection with telephone transmission work and especially in conjunction with toll circuit maintenance, also in connection with public address systems. In connection with radio work measurements are often made on the audio circuits of a radio and are termed "audio frequency" measurements. This term implies the same frequency range as the term "voice frequency".

Carrier frequency measurements are made in conjunction with the installation and operation of carrier systems used by the Bell System. Radio frequency measurements are made primarily in connection with radio transmitters and receivers, although high frequency alternating current is now being used for a number of industrial applications, hence all measurements in this range are not necessarily confined to the radio industry. Ultra-high frequency measurements are made in connection with the ultra-high frequencies used in communication work, also in connection with certain ultra-high frequency applications such as fever machines, etc.

Simple Direct Current Instruments

Galvanometers

The simplest type of electrical measuring instrument is the galvanometer. A galvanometer is an instrument useful in measuring the strength of an electrical current by means of the magnetic effect which the current will produce.

Galvanometers may be classified under two heads; viz,

1. Those utilizing a fixed coil and movable magnetic needle.
2. Those utilizing a fixed magnet and movable coil.

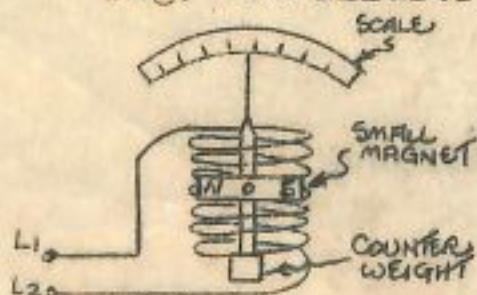


Fig. 100(a) Fixed Coil-Moving Magnet Type of Galvanometer

Fig. 100 illustrates these two basic types of galvanometers.

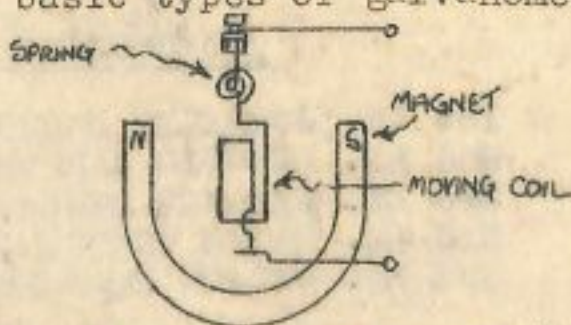


Fig. 100(b) Fixed Magnet-Moving Coil Type of Galvanometer

It will be noted that a controlling force is provided in both types, this being necessary to prevent a weak current from deflecting the moving coil or needle as far as a strong current.

Fixed Coil - Movable Magnet Type Galvanometer

The galvanometer shown in Fig. 100-A operates due to the current being measured passing through the coil creating a magnetic field, and the small permanent magnet attached to the indicating
