

1. Effective today the area bounded on the Northeast by Crequieta-Misamis Road from Mr M. SENADOS' house to Mr BASQUINDANG's house Southeast Road junction on the South from Road junction to Road junction (Rizal Street), Northwest from Road junction to a point (200) yards extended Northwest and from this point to Mr BULICAN's house Northeast is hereby declared Military Reservation (Division Area).

a. The area opposite the National Highway Northeastern side bounded from a point extending the imaginary straight line drawn from Mr SENADOS' residence 30 meters towards the interior Northeast and from this point to a line drawn Northeast to Southeast meeting the line extended from Mr. BASQUINDANG's residence (road junction) as defined further herein is hereby declared part of the Military Reservation (Division Area);

b. The National Road (Misamis-Crequieta) shall be opened to Military and Civilian Traffic.

2. The Division Area defined herein will be subject to the following restrictions, enforcements of which will be undertaken by the Div Prov Marshal and in his absence the Commandant, M. Co Serv Trps;

a. Civilians who have returned and stayed within the Divisional area prior to 8 Feb '45 will be allowed to remain, but must submit a list of members of his family, showing names, sexes, ages, occupation and residence, to the Div Prov Marshal.

b. Civilians desiring to return to the area after 8 Feb '45 should report to the Div Prov Marshal and make his intentions known. The DPM will for this matter conduct an investigation and submit his recommendation to the C-3, this Division, who will determine the feasibility of such returning civilians to stay.

c. After 15 Feb '45 no civilian will be allowed to return and reside within the Divisional area.

d. Civilians residing within the area will be required to cultivate the lots within its immediate vicinity and discouraged the raising of poultry and other domestic animals for local consumption.

e. All houses occupied within the area will be subject to inspection by the Division Surgeon for sanitary measures. Every house owner therefore is required to maintain a good latrine and clean surroundings.

f. Any person within the area found sick should be immediately reported to Div Surgeon.

g. For the protection of life and property both civil and military, civilians residing within the Military Reservation shall be subject to strict enforcement of sanitary and security measures that maybe issued from time to time.

h. Any person desiring an audience with the Division Commander will first secure permission thru the Div Prov Marshal or in his absence the Commandant, Hq Co Serv Troops.
