1. The following is published for the information and guidance of all concerned:

Ration is the allowance of food for the subsistence of one person for one day. For the 70th Military District, ration allowance for Officer-enlisted men, prisoners and sick at hospital are as follows.

Officers	PO.45	day
Enlisted-men.....	0.40	" "
Prisoners.....	0.40	" "
Sick at Hospital	0.50	" "

(a) How drawn:

For Officers and enlisted men and prisoners, a cash allowance for purchase of viands in the amount of PO.75 each day is allowed. viand allowance for those sick in the hospital should be PO.25 in cash. Ration in kind should be drawn from the depots and allowance of each man is as follows.

7/3 grnts of rice or milled corn per man each day.			
0.64 oz of edible oil	"	"	"
2. oz of sugar	"	"	"
7. oz of salt	"	"	"
7. oz of coffee, roasted & ground per man each day			

(Note) : Three items below are irregular depending on supply
(16 oz equals 1 lbs)
(2.2 lbs. equals 1 kgs)

(b) Source of ration:

1. Cash advanced for purchase of viands shall be drawn by Non Officers from Finance Officer of the Regiment.

2. Ration in kind from Depots are requisitioned by Officers from their Division Quartermaster. The Division Quartermaster shall submit a consolidated requisition for all units of his Division to the Force Quartermaster, 70th Military District. In those areas which can not meet procurement rest be resorted to. Such procurement will be done by representative of the Regt's S-1 who will consolidate and report quantities to the Division Quartermaster. Items procured under this authority are those listed under Paragraph 1(a) Division Quartermaster is authorized to pay for these supplies upon presentation of receipts for current purchases.

(c) Returns:

At the end of the month that Commanders will prepare his subsistence Voucher and account for the advanced cash taken by him from the Finance Officer. A copy of the return of subsistence (fund) shall be submitted with the subsistence voucher. No ration savings shall accumulate.

3. All regulations in conflict with this instructions are hereby revoked.

4. This order shall take effect 7 April 1943.

These arrested, if within the area of the 105th Division, shall be forwarded to AC of S, G-2, this Headquarters, for investigation. The Japanese have used released prisoners as spies and fifth columnists to break up the guerilla movement in other islands of the archipelago. Be advised that this Headquarters will hold unit commanders responsible for the strict and impartial enforcement of this order.

1. OPERATION OF COCKPITS.- Hereafter the operation of cockpits within the area of the 115th Infantry, province of Davao will be stopped unless a license has been issued by this Headquarters. As before the war, permissions to operate a cockpit will be approved only upon payment of a quarterly license in the amount of ₱150.00 payable in advance.

2. APPOINTMENT OF DEPUTY TREASURERS.- Pending the appointments of civilian officials, 1st Lieut. CELESTINO IBANEZ, Finance Officer of this regiment will temporarily act as treasurer for all the unoccupied towns of Davao province. In view of the distance involved between the eastern coast and gulf towns and this Headquarters, the Battalion Commander, 3rd Battalion should recommend to this Headquarters civilians who may serve as deputies of the treasurer in the municipalities of Cateel, Compostela, Moncayo, Manay, Lupon, Mati, Baganga and Caraga.

3. COLLECTION AND DISBURSEMENT OF LICENSE FEES.- All license fees collected will be treated as a government general fund and should be taken up in an official cash book. Disbursement will not be made without specific instruction or approval from this Headquarters.

4. TRADING CENTERS.- Trading places known as "Tabotabo" will continue operating but payment of fees or "arcabales" will not be demanded from the respective traders regardless of the location of the trading places, whether be public or private place. However, when local traders operate around a licensed cockpit, the operator may demand a reasonable fee from them depending upon the articles sold. It has been always the policy of this Headquarters that the purpose of trading places is to give a chance to the people to sell, exchange or barter their products. Our objective will be defeated and the interest of our civil population will be prejudiced if small traders could not be given ample protection and encouragement to participate in any retail or home-product business.

5. PROHIBITION.- No officer, soldier or anybody connected with this organization will be allowed to apply for a license to operate a cockpit. Likewise members of our organization are forbidden to engage in salt, dry goods or any other form of business.

6. FIESTAS, BENEFITS, DANCES, ETC.- Due to our proximity to the Japanese occupied districts Filipino-Japanese operatives could easily get through our area especially during fiestas. In order that we could properly check the influx of enemy agents it is desired that before religious fiestas are celebrated, unit commanders should be apprised several days in advance. Balls, dances, beauty contest or any undertaking with the pretext of raising funds for the army should be stopped.

1. In order that a closer coordination of the various outpost of the 3rd Battalion, 115th Infantry could be effected, intelligence work regarding enemy made easier, transportation of subsistence of the troops eased, and transmission of messages from and to the Regimental Headquarters facilitated; the Headquarters of the 3rd Battalion, 115th Infantry will be moved to a location along the Agusan River at Baguiutan, Davao.

2. The new Battalion Headquarters must be occupied not later than July 25, 1943. All personnel now at the present Battalion headquarters, except a reasonable number of enlisted men under one officer of the Battalion Headquarters Company should gradually float to the new Headquarters. The personnel to be left at Patrocinio should maintain liaison with the 115th Infantry.

3. In selecting the location for the New Battalion Headquarters, the Battalion Commander should take into consideration concealment, good drainage, proximity to a good water supply and strategic location from all avenues of approach from the enemy.

GENERAL ORDERS
NO. 2

1. In compliance with radio instructions from HQ, 10th Military District of even date the entire 115th Infantry Regiment, minus 2 officers and 50 MM, will proceed immediately by best means possible with complete field equipment to Misamis, Misamis Occidental.
2. RHQ, at Pagadian will be the assembly area and point of departure. All schedule for troop movements and sequences will be issued from this CP thru conferences, radio instructions and supplementary letter orders from time to time.
3. All unit commanders will see to it that their men have adequate rations for the trip and enough to keep them supplied for at least three days in Misamis. All unit records will be brought and excess rations, supplies and equipment at Pagadian will be turned over to the Regimental S-4 for safe keeping.
4. Upon arrival at Misamis all officers concerned will inform the HQ, 10th MD and this regiment of their arrival and number, via radio or other means.
