Sir: I hereby certify, in accordance with section 71 of the Administrative Code of the Department of Mindanao and Sulu, that the following described real property, Tax No. situated in the barrio of Municipality of Province of and more particularly bounded and described as follows, to wit:

together with the tenements and hereditaments thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, is delinquent in taxes, penalties, and costs for the years 19, 19, 19, 19, 19, in the aggregate sum of P. The period of one year from the date whereon the delinquency began having expired and the said taxes and penalties not having been paid, under the provisions of section 71 of the Administrative Code of the Department of Mindanao and Sulu, you are hereby requested to eject forthwith from said property and keep therefrom all persons having or claiming ownership thereof, or title therein as well as all tenants or occupants thereof, and at the same time to notify all persons so ejected that the owner or his legal representative or any person having a lien on said land or a lease thereof may, within a period of 90 days from the date of ejectment, satisfy said taxes and penalties and redeem said land by paying the amount thereof then due; that such payment if made by any other person than the owner shall constitute a lien upon the land, such person being entitled to recover in the manner provided under the above mentioned section, from the original owner the amount paid; that in case such redemption be not made within the period of 90 days above specified, the Government of the Philippine Islands shall indefeasibly acquire all private right, title and interest to and in said land and thereafter the Director of Lands shall have full control and custody thereof to lease or sell the same or any portion thereof; that at any time prior to the alienation thereof or a contract therefor by the Director of Lands, the original owner or his legal representative shall have the right to recover by purchase the entire amount of his said property by paying for the same a sum equivalent to the amount of the delinquent taxes and penalties due thereon at the time of forfeiture and an additional penalty of 10 per centum. In case the property has been leased or the Director of Lands has entered into a contract for the lease thereof, repurchase may be made subject to such lease or contract.



Pursuant to radioed instructions from CG, Tenth Military District, Mindanao and Sulu, under date of 27 September '44, all Filipino Evacuees in the Free Zamboanga Sector will move to the hinterlands of Zamboanga Peninsula starting from a line, running East to West, twelve (12) kilometers directly north of Port area, Zamboanga City, bounded on the East and on the West by interior lines running parallel to and five (5) kilometers from the National Highway. No civilian will be allowed to stay within the five kilometer radius from the National Highway.

2. In case of overcrowding of civilian evacuees in one particular place, the unit commander in the area will direct those in excess, especially the recent arrivals from the city proper of Zamboanga to move farther to the rear. Those in excess in the 3rd Bn area shall be directed to move to the interiors of Tugawan, Zamboanga, or farther.

3. All civilians thus evacuated in the places above described will, under no circumstance, be allowed to interfere with any army activity nor will they be permitted to mingle with army personnels except when called for.

4. The above orders take effect immediately.

5. Compliance with the above is hereby enjoined.
