Captain Bilbao was born in Dumaguete, Negros Oriental on March 30, 1892. He enlisted in the Philippine Constabulary on June 10, 1909, graduated in the Philippine Constabulary Academy in Baguio and commissioned Third Lieutenant, PC in December 1916. He served in various places throughout the Islands and was retired in April, 1940. On May 1, 1943 he joined the 116th Infantry Regiment and was assigned Temporary Executive Officer of same Regiment. He served in that capacity honestly and faithfully until the time he died of pneumonia in Camp 2, Glan, on July 13, 1943 at 2:00 P.M.

By his untimely death the United States Army in the Philippines losses a very useful and efficient officer.
