

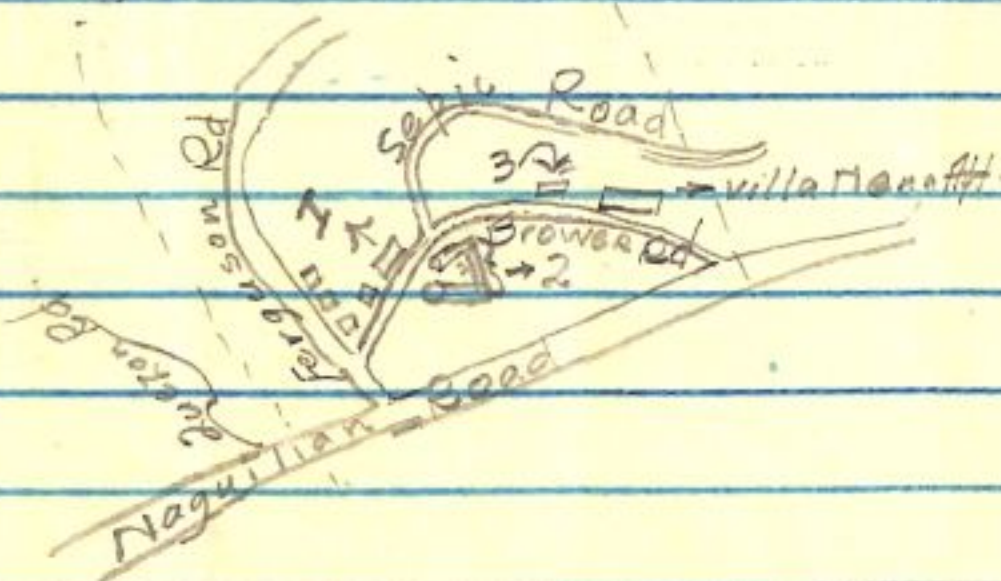
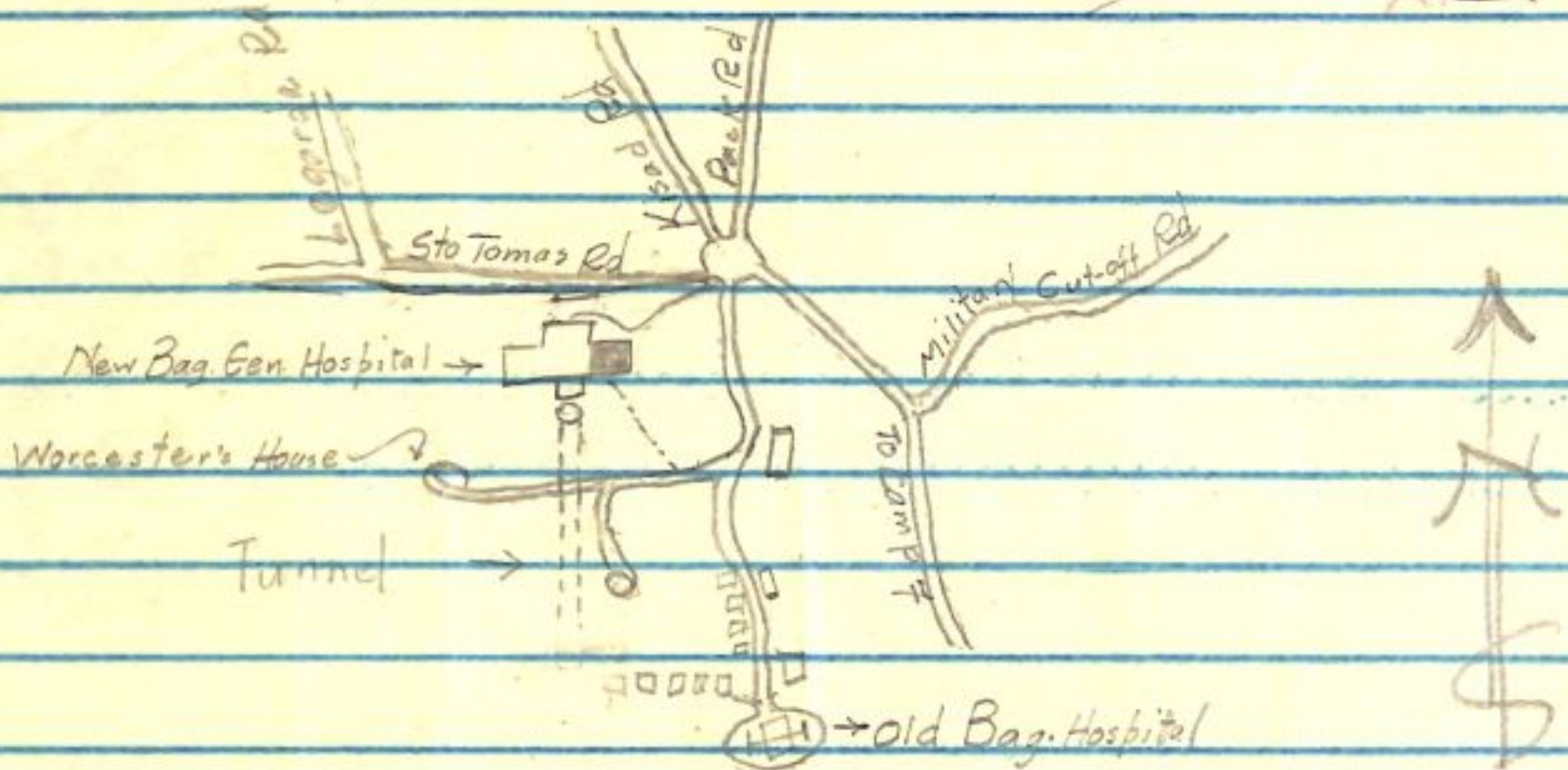

Sketch One (1)

- (I) 1. The Old Baguio Hospital was hit by Incendary bomb and reduced to ashes on January 31, 1945.
2. The Wing of the New Baguio Gen. Hosp. shaded black in the sketch was hit by demolition bombs on Feb. 18, 1945 and it could not be used.
3. The TUNNEL (6' x 8' x 250' more or less) with its entrance from back of the New Gen. Hosp. passing thru and with its opening near the Isolation Hosp. overlooking the Road to Camp 7 or Benguet Road. This tunnel was constructed by Mankayan Miners sometimes last year under the direction of the Army. According to info there are some other openings of the tunnel, IN and OUT, but directions and locations unknown. This tunnel could accomodate about 2,000 men. A-2, 2/28.

Sketch Two (2)

Pointer One (1) is Atty. Isidoro Siapno's Apartment, junction of Brower and Sepic Roads, is occupied by the Navy as Quarters, Office, Commissary and Tailor shop. 4 Jap. women are doing the tailoring work. Pointer 2, is a one tunnel having entrance and exit as shown in the sketch and it could probably accomodate 30 persons. Pointer 3 is the Villa Nena Apart. garage used by the Navy as welding shop and also they have a deposit of 30 drums of over

gasoline in the same building. A-1, 2/28

On the night of Feb. 27, 1945 there were 15 trucks passed Lueban toward Trinidad from Baguio loaded with about 250 soldiers in complete packs and rifles and foodstuffs and other supplies, their destination was said to be Ambuclao. A-2, 2/28.

President Laurel and his Cabinet Ministers will soon be evacuated to an unknown destination. B-1, 2/28.

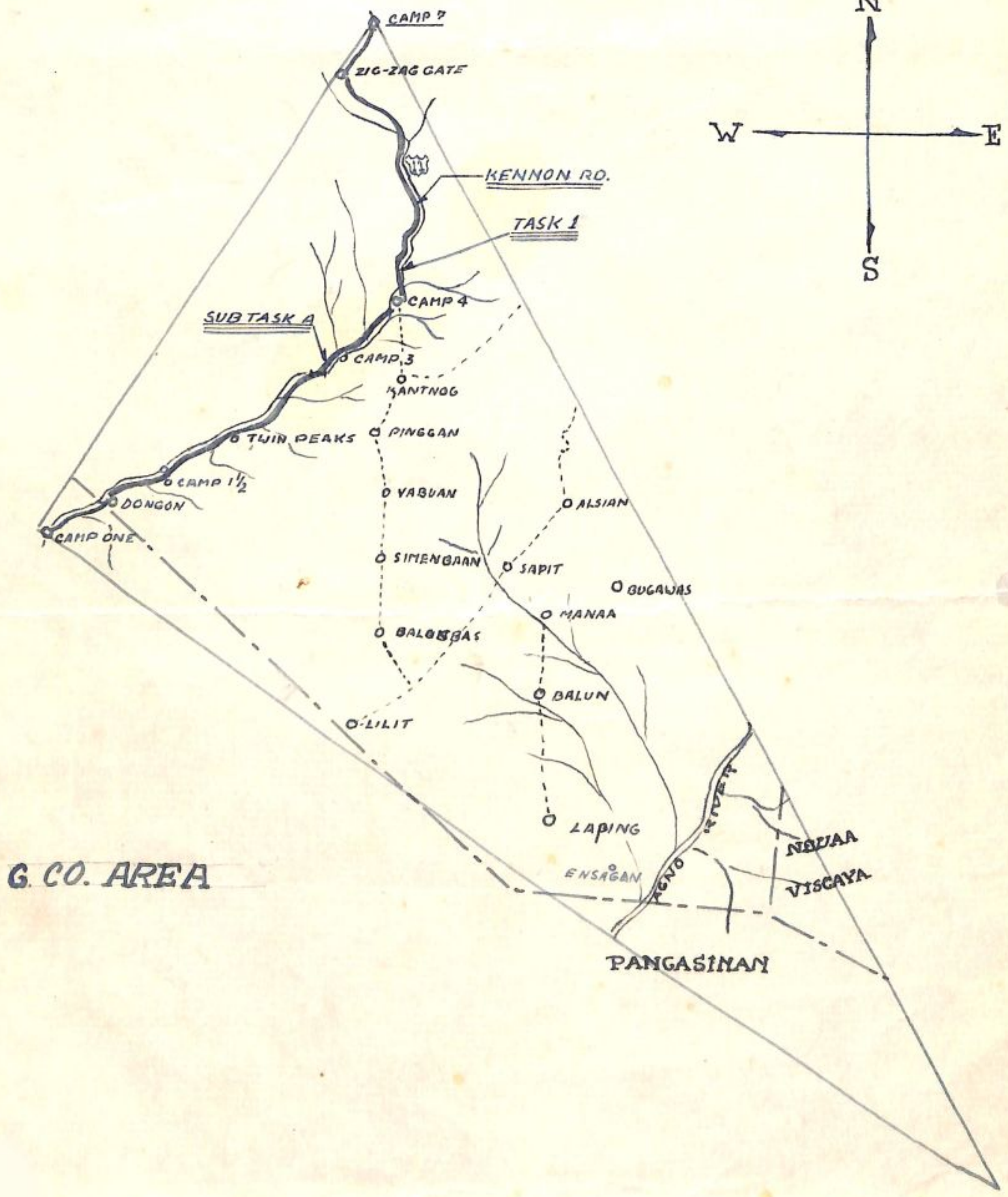
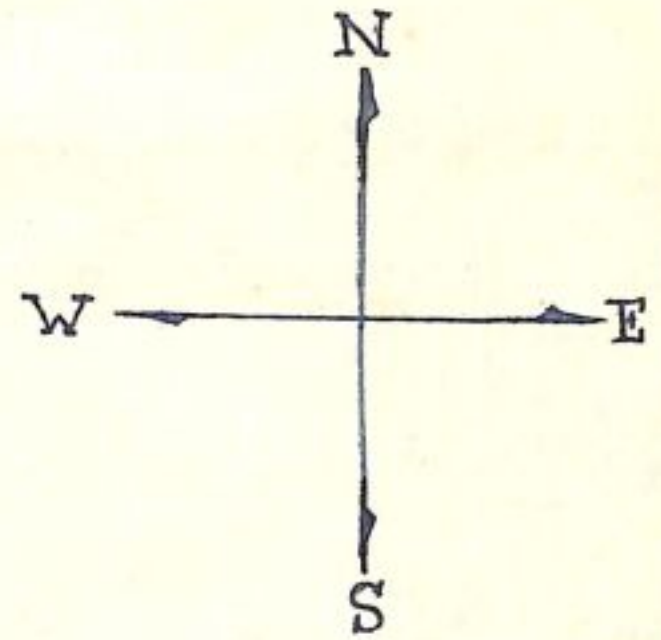
