SUBJECT: Remains of Soldiers KIA

To : All Regimental Commanders and Separate
Unit Commanders, USAFIP, NL

1. In the operations of USAFIP, NL in the areas lead-
ing to Bessang Pass, Cervantes, the route toward Bontoc,
and the Cervantes-Mankayan-Km 90 sector, a number of our
soldiers perished valiantly and died as a result of wounds
they received in the encounters. Many were accorded the
Christian way of burial with the graves properly labelled
and identified while there were others whose remains could
not anymore be brought to the cemetery but were buried
somewhere within the USAFIP NL area mentioned hereon.

2. With the aim in view of putting together the re-
mains of all of our fellow-soldiers who have given their
lives to the Cause, in the same place, this Command had
chosen the cemetery at Cervantes as our Military Cemetery.
It is earnestly enjoined, therefore, that all unit com-
manders cooperate with the Grave Registration Personnel in
transferring from all isolated graves, the remains of sol-
diers KIA, irrespective of time, date, and place to the
Cervantes Military Cemetery.

3. All Unit Commanders must within the least possible
delay, furnish the Grave Registration Officer a complete
list of all isolated burials made and all such data as may
be required to properly identify and locate same.

4. The Grave Registration Personnel is under the QM
Bn, USAFIP NL, and holds office at the town of Cervantes.
