1. Under authority contained in General Order No. 13, Hq. USAFIP, North Luzon, dated August 7, 1944, the following reorganization of the 11th Infantry, P.A. is hereby announced.
2. Alfredo Bunnol, 1st Lt., P.A. is hereby placed in command of the 1st Bn., 11th Infantry, P.A.
3. J. Dunuan, Captain, P.A., is hereby relieved as C.O. Company "B" 11th Infantry, P.A. and is ordered to reorganize the 3rd Bn, 11th Infantry, P.A.
4. Estaban Lumyeb, 2nd Lt. P.A. is hereby assigned to the 3rd Bn., 11th Infantry, P.A.
5. Company "D", 11th Infantry, P.A. is hereby redesignated Company "I", 11th Infantry, P.A.
6. All Officers and men of the Bn. Hq., 1st Bn., 11th Infantry, P.A. with the following exceptions are transferred to Regimental Hq., 11th Infantry, P.A.

7. The 1st Bn. Sector will include the sub-province of Ifugao and that portion of Bontoc that is West of the national Roads No. 4 and 11.
8. The 3rd Bn. Sector will include that portion of Bontoc that is East of the National Roads No. 4 and 11, and the sub-province of Kaligga.
9. Any units operating in the 1st and 3rd Bns. Sectors are hereby ordered incorporated into the Bn. in which sector the said unit is operating.



10. All inductions, promotions and/or demotions of enlisted personnel will be submitted to this Hq. for approval.

11. The undersigned hereby assumes command of the 11th Inf. P.A. All communications to this or higher Hq. will be indorsed directly to this Hq. Likewise, all communications from higher Hq will be indorsed directly to the Battalions by this Hq. All indorsements of this Hq. being considered one and the same with Hq., 11th Infantry, P.A.



NO. 5.....))

1. To facilitate the handling of administrative matters, the provisions of this order will be effective upon cessation of hostilities or as soon thereafter as possible within the respective Battalion Sectors of this command.

2. CONDUCT: Battalion Commanders will maintain close check on their respective Companies and prevent the men roaming at will. During this period Officers and NCO's will be held strictly responsible for the conduct and activities of the members of their respective commands.

3. LOOTING: Battalion Commanders will take steps to insure against looting of towns and homes as occurred during the early days of the war. This may be accomplished by assigning armed units (as a Squad) in the municipalities. Any member or members of this command that are found guilty of said Offense will be dealt with severely.

4. BANDITS & ETC: Bandits, spies, pro-Jap, etc, that are apprehended will not be executed, but will be held for proper investigation and trial.

5. RECEIPTS: Battalion Commanders will take the necessary measures to make and compile true copies of all Government Receipts issued within their respective sectors. This includes receipts issued by other units. These receipts (the true copies) will be forwarded to this HQ. For every receipt duplicated, the following data will be recorded on a recapitulation sheet: (See attached form) a. To whom receipt is made out.  
b. Address  
c. Amount of receipt  
d. Name, rank, and organization, if any, of one issuing receipt. The total of the duplicated receipts forwarded to this HQ must equal the total shown on the accompanying recapitulation sheet. The writing of the names and amounts of money will be legible and without erasures.

E X T R A C T

M-DAY AND M PLUS DAY MISSIONS

GENERAL MISSION:

1. To destroy enemy lines of communications, roads, bridges, telephone and telegraph lines.
2. To harass, delay, if possible, destroy all enemy troops and supply movements.
3. To destroy enemy supply dumps, truck parks, troop concentrations and command posts.
4. To prevent the enemy from securing locally food supplies, materials (bridges and roads etc) labor, means of transportation (i.e. cargadores, horses, carts, trucks, etc).

5. 6. To be ready carry out the above missions by November 15, 1944 (i.e. reconnaissance, plans, formulated orders, detailed instructions, training, assembled materials, supply details, etc must be completed by 15th November 1944.

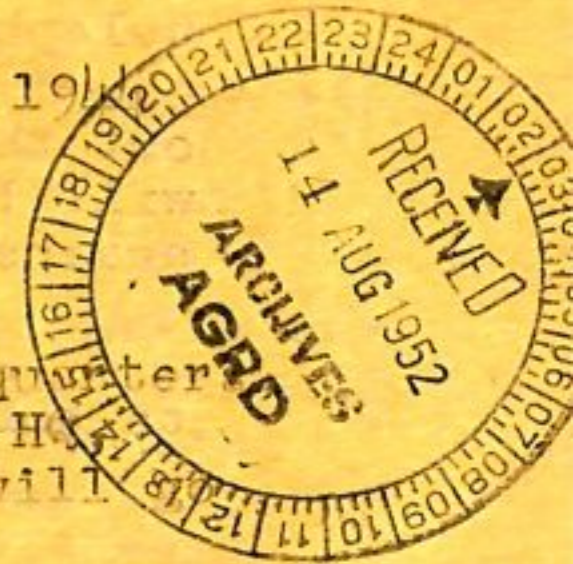

GENERAL ORDER )  
NO.....10 )

1. In compliance with orders from Higher Headquarters the following missions as outlined in G. O. No. 6, Headquarters Fourth-Seventh Districts, dated 21 October, 1944, will be put into effect upon receipt of this order.

a. Battalion Commanders will put into effect Par. 4 under General Mission. Although this provision has already been ordered into effect, reports reaching this Headquarters indicates that the Japs are still securing bull-carts, horsed, etc. After this date any form of transportation being employed by the Japs will be attacked and destroyed at every opportunity. Means of transportation such as bull carts, calesas, horses, etc., that are found to be where the enemy can secure them from the civilians will be destroyed or confiscated and moved to remote places.

b. Battalion Commanders will put into effect so much of Par. 1, under General Missions as applies to telephone and telegraph lines. In putting this provision into effect the lines will be entirely removed and poles destroyed. The wire will be removed to remote areas by respective units and well hidden. Battalion Commanders will report to this Hq weekly as to the total amount of communication lines removed (in Km) in their respective sectors.

c. Battalion Commanders will take advantage of every opportunity to destroy enemy fuel and supply dumps (especially airplane fuel and ammunition dumps). Any such dumps within the respective Battalion sectors will be reported to this Hq upon receipt of this order, or upon the ~~establishment of same~~ *establishment of same by the enemy. Reports re-action taken against same* will be forwarded to this Hq without delay.

d. To permit effective action to be taken against any attempt of the enemy to initiate counter measures as a result of the activities as listed in the foregoing paragraph, the Battalion Commanders will:

1. Concentrate their rifles in large enough numbers to enable a unit to effectively ambush the enemy.

2. Organize the civilian population into voluntary companies, with civilian Officials appointed, and arm them with bolos and spears. (At the present the Folo Men are organized throughout the 1st Bn., 12th Infantry into companies, who are effectively aiding the Army in clearing trails, supplementing the soldiers as guards and

outpost, and performing any duties the Army may call upon them for -----this Bn. plans to use them in tearing up the telephone lines and disrupting the enemy communication lines).

5. Ambush positions will be selected throughout the respective Battalion Sectors from which the enemy will be attacked if and when he ventures to pursue or act against our units.

2. The following instructions will be made public to ALL CIVILIANS THROUGHOUT YOUR RESPECTIVE SECTORS:

a. Secure your families with such food stuffs as are available to you as rapidly as possible at points away from vital enemy installations.

b. Support the local Commander in your respective areas as appointed by HEADQUARTERS, USAFIP, NORTH LUZON and this HEADQUARTERS.

c. Avoid any assistance to the enemy in the way of labor, transportation, food supplies, fuel and other vital supplies.

d. Remove your harvest and food supplies to hidden places and secure them from the enemy.

3. All civilians within your respective sectors will be acquainted with the following message from Gen. MacArthur:

"I CALL FOR UNITY AMONG THE PEOPLE, THAT UNITY SO ESSENTIAL TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF MAXIMUM STRENGTH AT THIS CRUCIAL TIME. LET THE REST OF YOUR PATRIOTISM BE YOUR LOVE OF FREEDOM. RISE ABOVE ALL DIFFERENCES? FACTIONAL QUARRELS, DISPUTES OR PETTY JEALOUSIES THAT ALL FILIPINO PATRIOTS, UNFLINCHING, MAY MARCH SHOULDER TO SHOULDER FOR DETERMINED ACTION. THE DURATION IN HUMAN SUFFERING WHICH INEVITABLY FOLLOW IN THE WAKE OF WAR WILL BE DETERMINED IN A LARGE MEASURE BY THE EXTENT OF YOUR SUPPORT. MAY GOD STRENGTHEN YOU TO MEET THIS TEST. (SGD) MACARTHUR.

NO.....1 )

1. The following re-assignment of Bn Sectors is hereby announced. Battalion Commanders will at once occupy their assigned sectors without delay, and be ready to receive combat orders upon occupation of their new sectors. "Lay Low" policy is hereby REVOKED. Contact enemy wherever possible in your sector.

(A) 1st Bn, 12th Inf.

(1) South Boundary: General line following highway-RIZAL-PIAT-SOLANA exclusive, to the east and exclusive of TUGUEGARAO and PENABLANCA.

(B) 3rd Bn, 11th Inf.

(1) North Boundary: General line, Rd RIZAL-PIAT-SOLANA inclusive and TUGUEGARAO and PENABLANCA inclusive.

(2) South Boundary: LUBUAGAN-ENRILE Rd. From TABUE west, exclusive of road. From TABUK east, inclusive of road.

(C) 1st Bn, 11th Inf.

(1) All of the 7th Dist. not occupied by the 3rd Bn.

2. 1st Bn, 12th Inf.

(A) Co. F will occupy sector: STA MARIA inclusive to coast of CAGAYAN.

(B) Co. B will occupy sector from BLCALA, inclusive, to STA.MARIA, inclusive.

(C) Co. C will occupy sector from IGUIT, inclusive to BLCALA, exclusive.

(D) Co. A will establish its CP within the sector of Co. C as directed by the Bn. CO.

(E) Co. D will remain in reserve in area as ordered by the Bn. CO.

(F) Bn CP will be located in the vicinity of NABANAGAN.

3. 3rd Bn, 11th Inf.

(A) One company sector vicinity of ENRILE, and covering ENRILE, and the ENRILE-TABUK Rd in the vicinity of ENRILE.

(B) One company vicinity of SOLANA, covering SOLANA, SOLANA TUAO Rd.

(C) One company vicinity of MOLANAN covering area RIZAL PIAT.

(D) One company in reserve in vicinity of CALBAYAN.

(E) Bn CP at BULUAN.

4. 1st Bn, 11th Inf.

(A) One company with in the province of IFUGAO with one platoon in the vicinity of PAYAWAN; one platoon vicinity of MT.POLIS; the third platoon in reserve



vicinity of LAGAWÉ.

- (B) One company in vicinity of SABANGAN to cover SABANGAN intersection and BONTOC CENTRAL.
- (C) One Company vicinity of TABUK to cover the LUBUAGAN-TABUK and BALBALAN intersection.
- (D) One company in reserve in vicinity of TINGLAYAN.
- (E) Bn CP in the vicinity of BAIL, KALINGA.

5. (A) Bn. Comdrs. will see to it that their respective companies will carry enough food supplies in moving into the new sectors to subsist their units until they are settled.
- (B) Ammunitions caliber .30 can be drawn from the Reg. Headquarters. Only the necessary number needed by your units can be drawn by submitting your requisition without delay.

6. Bn. CO, 3rd Bn. 11th Inf. will require his S+2 operating in the area of the 4th Dist., in his sector, to submit his report to the Reg. Headquarters, and his S-2 operating in the area of the 7th Dist. to submit his report to the S-2 of the 7th Dist.

8. Road Watchers of 3rd Bn. 11th Inf. operating on Rd LUBUAGAN-BONTOC and PASONGLAO (CALANAN)-ENRILE will continue to operate in such area and to submit their reports to Bn. CO, 1st Bn. 11th Inf. until further order.

9. All Bn Comdrs. will notify this Headquarters immediately upon occupation of their respective sectors.

10. Reg. Headquarters will remain at its present location.
