- 2. CONDUCT: Battalion Commanders will maintain close check on their respective Companies and prevent the men reaming at will. During this period Officers and NCO's will be held strictly responsible for the conduct and activities of the neembers of their respective commands.
- 3. LOOTING: Battalion Commanders will take steps to insure against looting of towns and homes as occurred during the early daysof the war. This maybe accomplished by assigning armed units (as a Squad) in the municipalities. Any member or members of this command that are found quilty of said Offense will be dealth with severely.
- BANDITS & ETC: Bandits, spies, pro-Jap, etc, that are apprehended will not be executed, but will he held for proper investigation and trial.
- 5. RECEIPTS: Battalion Commanders will take the necessary measures to make and compile tune copies of all Government Receipts issued within their respective sectors. This includes receipt s issued by other units. These receipts (the true copies) will be forwarded to this HQ. - 1. In comliance with orders from Higher Headquarter the following missions as outlined in G. O. No. 6, Horas Fourth-Seventh Districts, dated 21 October, 1944, will of this order.
- a. Battalion Commanders will put into effect Par. 4 undr General Mission. Although this povision has already been ordered into effect, reports reaching this Headquarters indicates that the Japs are still securing bull carts, horsed, etc. After this date any form of transportation being employed by the Japs will be attacked and destroyed at every opportunity. Means of transportation such as bull carts, calesas, horses, etc., that are found to be where the enemy can secure them from the civilians will be destroyed or confiscated and moved to remote places.
- b. Battalion Commanders will put into effect so much of Par. 1, under General Missions as applies to telephone and telegraph lines. In putting his provision into effect the lines will be entirely removed and poles destroyed. The wire will be rumoved to remote areas by respective units and well hidden. Battalion Commanders will report to this Hq weekl, as to the total amount of communication lines removed (in Km) in their respective sectors.
- every opportunity to destroy enemy fuel and apply dumps (especially airplane fuel and ammunition dumps).  2. Eganize the vivilian population into voluntary companies, with civilian Officials appointed, and arm them with bolos and spears. (At the present the Folo Men are organized throughout the 1st En., 12th Infantry into companies, who are effectively aiding the Army in clearing trails, su plementing the soldiers as guards and

- b. Support the local Commander in your respective areas as appointed by HEADQUARTERS, USAFIP, NORTH LUZON and this HEADQUARTERS.
- c. Avoid any assistance to the enemy in the way of labor, transportation, food supplies, fuel and other vital supplies.
- d. Remove your harvest and food supplies to hidd den places and secure them from the enemy.
- 3. All civilians within your respective sectors will be acquainted with the rollowing message from Gan. MacArthur:

"I CALL FOR UNITY ALONG THE PEOPLE, THAT UNITY SO
ESSENTIAL TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF MAXIMUM STRENGTH
AT THIS CRUCIAL TIME. LET THE REST OF YOUR PATREOTISM BE YOUR LOVE OF FREEDOM. RISE ABOVE
ALL DIFFERENCES? FACTIONAL QUARREDS, I SPUTES
OR PETTY JEAL SIES THAT ALL FILIPINO PATRIOTS,
UNFLINCHING, MAY MARCH SHOULDER TO SHOULDER FOR
DETERMINED ACTION. THE DURATION IN HUMAN SUFFERING WHICH INEVITARLY FOLLOW IN THE WARE OF WAR
