MEMORANDUM NO. 788
May 3, 1938

SUBJECT: Collection of ante-mortem fees for animals slaughtered in public slaughterhouses or in private meat packing establishments -

To all Municipal and Deputy Municipal District Treasurers, Mountain Province:

Provincial Unnumbered Circular dated March 3, 1938, of the Honorable, the Secretary of Finance, is hereunder quoted, for your information, guidance, and compliance:

"For the information and guidance of all provincial and municipal treasurers, there is quoted hereunder a self-explanatory indorsement of the Director of Animal Industry, dated February 19, 1938, relative to the collection of ante-mortem fees provided for under Commonwealth Act No. 118. The views contained in said indorsement have been concurred in by the Department of Agriculture and Commerce and by this Department:

"Respectfully returned to the Honorable, the Secretary of Agriculture and Commerce, Manila.

"In the absence of any penal provisions in Commonwealth Act No. 118, any person who fails to pay the ante-mortem fees imposed under said Act cannot be prosecuted therein. However, this Office believes that a municipal treasurer who is charged with the duty of collecting ante-mortem fees, may refuse to issue the slaughter permit required under Sec. 532 of the Revised Administrative Code in favor of any person who fails to pay the corresponding ante-mortem fees. The municipality concerned may also refuse the slaughter of the animals in the public slaughterhouse unless the fees in question are paid by the owners."

"Provincial Treasurers are requested to transmit the contents of this circular to the municipal treasurers under their respective jurisdiction." (SGD.) A. DE LAS ALAS,
