Sir:

The undersigned has the honor to request your full cooperation in the observance and enforcement of the traffic rules and regulations on national roads of the Philippines, copies of which were furnished to you at the beginning of this year by the City or District Engineer or directly by this Bureau.

These traffic rules and regulations were promulgated for the benefit of the public using public highways. If followed, they render travel on the road by vehicles and pedestrians safer, speed up the flow of traffic on our public highways by the removal of the causes for congestion, and will eliminate the noise nuisance caused by blowing of automobile horns not imperatively necessary, and prevent damage to national roads and their appurtenances.


About 100,000 official copies of the traffic rules and regulations on national roads of the Philippines printed in booklet form were distributed throughout the Philippines, to every driver of motor vehicles, calpasas, carretelas, etc., to every automobile and constabulary inspector, chief of police, provincial and municipal treasurer, justice of peace, provincial fiscal, superintendent of schools and to every principal of public and private schools. The Bureau of Education through the medium of the "School News Review" with a circulation of 325,000, mostly among public school teachers, transmitted to the students the contents of these booklets by means of classroom lectures. It may be seen from the above that this Bureau brought to the greatest number of people mostly concerned with the observance and enforcement of the above rules and regulations the contents of these booklets. With the ground thus fully prepared, the time is now ripe for the immediate enforcement and observance of these traffic rules and regulations over our national highways.

Persons concerned were allowed enough time to familiarize themselves thoroughly with the traffic rules and regulations on national roads before penalties provided for their violations in accordance with the provisions of Commonwealth Act No. 548 are made applicable. The undersigned is requesting your full cooperation to see that these traffic rules and regulations on national roads of the Philippines be observed.

LOO FARM SCHOOL
July 30, 1941

respectfully returned to the District supervisor, Bokod, Benguet, with the following information.

Upon the receipt on March 21, 1941 of the Division Superintendent's letter of February 28, 1941, the undersigned informed and announced to the dormitory pupils and the people concerned that the Loo Boys' Dormitory will be closed as soon as the subsistence supplies already purchased for this said dormitory will have been consumed. It was likewise announced that no further purchases of subsistence supplies will be made. It was further intimated that this school may follow the general curriculum in June, 1941.

The 5th and 6th indorsements of the Director of Education and the Division Superintendent of schools, respectively, relative to the change in the status of this school were again brought to the attention of all pupils, teachers, town officials, and the people of Buguias. This was made on June 27, 1941 upon my return from the Bokod District Normal Institute. In view of this said change, it was explained, the Loo Boys' dormitory will be closed.

Subsistence was given to Loo pupils in June, 1941, on account of the fact that sufficient purchases of subsistence supplies were made prior to the receipt of the Division Superintendent's letter of February 28 (said letter received via Buguias by relay on March 21, 1941). Balances were, therefore, carried over from month to month, and the only way to eliminate the balances was to continue issuing them to dormitory pupils who stayed throughout June.

The former dormitory pupils are now bringing their own provisions. Some are living with Loo people whose homes are close to the school.
