GENERAL ORDERS )  
No. 1 )

1. General Orders No. 2, this Headquarters, dated July 3, 1943, is hereby revoked.
2. Pursuant to par. 3c, G. O. No. 5, Hq., USFIP, NL, dated November 4, 1943, the following units, this Regiment, are hereby assigned to the following areas, this District, for M-DAY MISSION:
  - a. FIRST AREA - ISABELA (to include PINAPPAGAN, N. VIZCAYA) - to 1ST BATTALION and Units Attached.
  - b. SECOND AREA - NORTH N. VIZCAYA - to 2ND BATTALION less detachment.
  - c. THIRD AREA - SOUTH N. VIZCAYA - to 3RD BATTALION.
3. All Battalion Commanders are Area Commanders of the area their units are assigned.
4. AREA COMMANDER, FIRST AREA, will assign sectors to his sub-units and other units attached to his command for M-DAY MISSION.
5. SECOND AREA comprises NORTH NUEVA VIZCAYA from BATO FERRY, BAYOMBONG inclusive and all places North. The following units, 2nd Battalion, are hereby assigned sectors for M-DAY MISSION:
  - a. "E" COMPANY - BATO FERRY, BAYOMBONG inclusive to BONFAL, BAYOMBONG inclusive.
  - b. "F" COMPANY - BONFAL, BAYOMBONG exclusive to LANUT, BAGABAG inclusive.
  - c. "H" COMPANY - BAGABAG FERRY to SAN LUIS, ISABELA inclusive.
6. THIRD AREA comprises SOUTH NUEVA VIZCAYA from BATO FERRY, BAYOMBONG exclusive and all places South. The following units, 3rd Battalion, are assigned sectors for M-DAY MISSION:
  - a. "I" COMPANY - BALETE PASS exclusive to BONE, ARITAO inclusive and places within parallels of latitude.
  - b. "K" COMPANY - BONE, ARITAO exclusive to JUNCTION, BAMBANG inclusive and places within parallels of latitude exclusive of PINAPPAGAN Area.
  - c. "L" COMPANY - JUNCTION, BAMBANG exclusive to BATO FERRY, BAYOMBONG exclusive and places within parallels of latitude.
  - d. "M" COMPANY - Regimental Reserve.
7. The following units will be attached for duty on M-Day Mission with the 1st Battalion, this Regiment:
  - a. "G" COMPANY.
  - b. COMBAT COMPANY.
  - c. All other units now in Isabela Area that may be attached to this Regiment in pursuant to par. 3b, G. O. No. 6, Hq., USFIP, NL, dated Nov. 4, 1943.
8. The Area Commander, THIRD AREA, will be responsible to coordinate his efforts in the BALETE PASS AREA with the efforts of the SIXTH DISTRICT (PANGASIRAN), USFIP, NL.
9. Paragraph 4, G. O. No. 6, Hq., USFIP, NL, dated Nov. 4, 1943, and instructions contained re Plans for Action ..., USFIP, NL, dated July 15, 1943 will be complied with by all Area Commanders in their respective areas.
10. Area Commanders will make provisions to orient and familiarize themselves and their sub-leaders of their respective assignments.
11. All other orders in regards to Intelligence Operatives of this Regiment which may be in conflict with this orders will still be carried in effect until M-Day.

1. This Headquarters announces with deep regret the death of Sgt. Pantaleon Cayaban, Pfc. Feliciano Parrocha, Pvts. Telesforo Campuz, Jose Corpuz, Natalio Cesar and Mariano Siguenza, Sgt. Pantaleon Cayaban, died in active duty in an encounter with the Japs at Darauan, San Nicolas, Pongasinan, on April 27, 1944. Pfc. Feliciano Parrocha and Pvts. Telesforo Campuz and Jose Corpuz died in action in an encounter with the PC at Inagan, Dupax, N. V. on July 21, 1944. Pvt. Natalio Cesar, died in line of duty on July 25, 1944. Pvt. Mariano Siguenza, died of influenza, while in line of duty. These patriotic soldiers had given their precious lives for the sake of the many, not to win the plaudits of their own people but to instill into the Filipino heart the love of country and freedom because of their bravery in the face of great dangers. Their examples of love of country, their unquestioned devotion to duty and obedience to superiors are living examples in the hearts of their comrades. May their soul rest in peace!

1. Pending receipt of appropriate order from HQ, USAFIP, NL and pursuant to instructions of the Commanding Officer, USAFIP, NL, in a letter to Major ROBERT H. ARNOLD, C.O., 14th Infantry, AUS, dated October 28, 1944, the six (6) officers and 116 enlisted men, remnants of the 14th Infantry, AUS, will be tentatively designated as Special Company and component of the 14th Infantry, USAFIP, N.L., effective this date.
2. For administrative purposes, this Special Company is placed under the Headquarters Battalion, 14th Infantry.
3. Special Company, 14th Infantry, USAFIP, NL, is hereby assigned a sector from JONES exclusive to CASIGURAN, inclusive for M and M plus Day Missions, and attached to the 1st Battalion for tactical purposes. C.O., Special Company, 14th Infantry, USAFIP, NL, will thoroughly acquaint himself and be made ready to comply with the M and M plus Day Missions contained in G.O. No. 9 HQ, USAFIP, NL, dated June 27, 1944 as indorsed by this HQ to all Battalion Commanders, dated August 9, 1944.
4. C.O., Special Company, 14th Infantry, USAFIP, NL, will submit to the C.O., 1st Battalion, this regiment, his compliance with G.O. No. 12, HQ, USAFIP, NL, dated August 7, 1944 as indorsed by this HQ, dated August 22, 1944, including all subsequent intelligence instructions, inasmuch as pertains his assigned sector for M and M plus Day Missions.
5. C.O., Special Company, 14th Infantry, USAFIP, NL, will, upon receipt of this order, report immediately to the C.O., 1st Battalion and HQ Battalion, this regiment for important instructions.

"6. Second Lieutenant ARTEMIO RODRIGO, 14th Inf., having, been found to be suffering from Kidney trouble, hence unfit for duty, is hereby honorably discharged from the service effective this date for physical disability contracted not in line of duty.

"7. Former Acting 2nd Lieutenant JOSE CUTARAN, 14th Inf., PA, USAFIP, NL having been found by a board of officers guilty of the charges instituted against him to wit: (1) Two cases of careless discharge of firearms, (2) Wilfull disobedience to a lawful order of his superior officer, both in violation of A.W. 97; and (3) Misbehaviour before the enemy in violation of A.W. 76, is hereby dishonorably discharged from the service, forfeiting all pay and allowances due or likely to become due effective as of November 7, 1944, and to be confined at hard labor in the area now occupied by the 14th Inf., PA for a period of four (4) years effective as of November 19, 1944, dated of his detention.

"8. Former Acting 2nd Lieutenant FRANCISCO TUGAB, 14th Inf., PA, USAFIP, NL having been found by a board of officers guilty of the charges instituted against him to wit: (1) Careless discharge of firearms (2) Absent without leave, is hereby reduced to the grade of Private effective this date and confined at hard labor for a period of three (3) months effective as of Nov. 19, 1944, dated of his detention.
