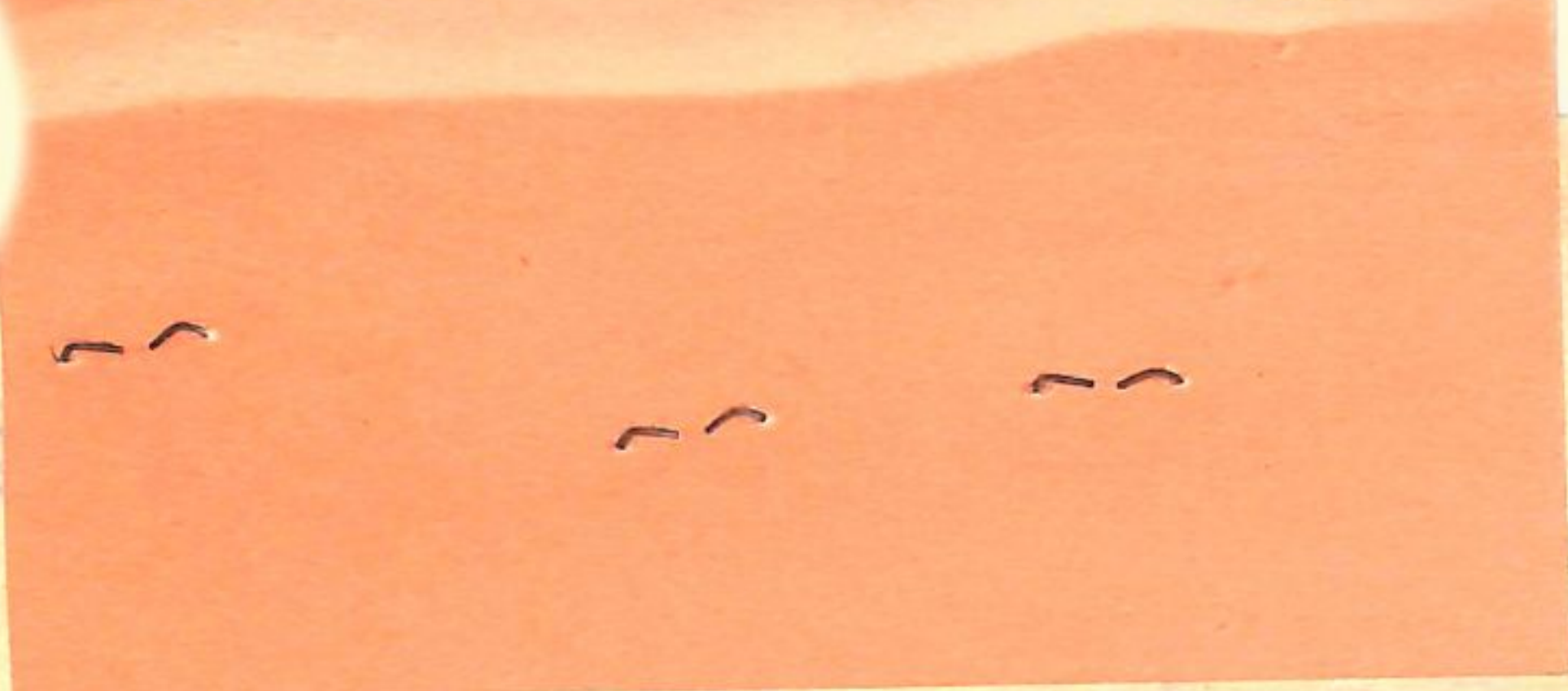

SUBJECT: ROUTINE MESSAGE  
TO: 1122, CO, GFNL, USFIP

1. Copies of your HQ "Miscellaneous Instructions" were prepared and forwarded to adjacent units.
2. Officers and men under my command have been informed of the official designation given by your HQ. Hereafter this command has charge of Company "M", 12th Infantry. 114 takes command of a detachment of this Co. "M" located in Western Benguet.
3. According to my HQ, Sgt. G sent up to you 50 pesos and 2 packages of cigarettes. Fifty pesos were spent, G claims, on two sick boys of M & N. G never turned in these things upon his return from your HQ.
4. Sometime last February we hid a generator in a nearby barrio. We are dispatching a man to relocate it and when taken, it will be relayed to you thru 116.
5. The old man (padre) is still imprisoned by the Japanese. Today is his 49th day. Some friends and relatives tried to visit him but the Japanese permit no visits. Only one on parole by the Jap M.P. was able to see him. This parolee reports that the old man is now quite emaciated. Chicken-feed, consisting of a ball of rice and salt, is given twice a day to inmates of the Jap M.P.
6. Rest assured that inspite of the old man's cruel and unjustified confinement by the enemy, 1113 will keep on with courage and patience until Victory or Doomsday.
7. Re- Par. 3 of Miscellaneous Instructions dated June 15, 1943. The Table of organization and other army publications on hand will be used as bases for determining the number of NCOS in our company.
8. This command requests that a copy of the ARTICLES OF WAR be furnished for use and guidance of our unit.

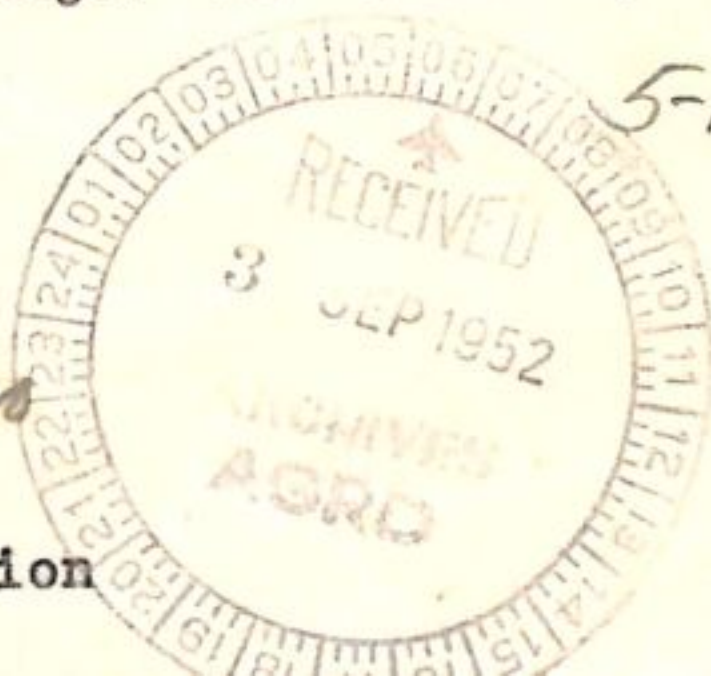




