





Our Platoon leader, Lt. Matias, in view of the conditions prevailing, decided to proceed to the Valley. Immediately upon arrival we joined the nearest Unit at Pura, N. E. under Major Mervique- 1-12-42. No subsequent encounters.





the HQBN, 12th Inf., of which I was the Bn. Commander, fought
the enemy landing forces in Bauang, La Union. Lt. Donald Black-
burn was in command of the defense. Lt. Blackburn was on our
right flank and I was on the left flank. After offering a stiff
resistance against superior enemy forces, withdrawal was made.
When I and some of my men arrived in the town of Bauang, our Re-
gimental Commander (Major Moses), Lt. Blackburn and the rest of
my men have already left for Baguio via the Naguilian Road us-
ing all available cars and trucks. The town and the Naguilian
Road were already in the hands of the enemy. Fighting our way we
went to the hills northeast of the town, where, I was informed
friendly civilians, there were Filipino soldiers. There we
and Col. Guillermo Nakar and his command to which we were at-
tached. I was assigned supply officer. The plan of Col. Nakar was
that we should go to Baguio and then to Manila. Instead of fol-
lowing the Naguilian Road which was already in the hands of the
enemy. We made our way across the Cordillera Mts. North of the
AGRD Naguilian Road. When we arrived at Tublay, a town north of Ba-
uang we were informed that Baguio was already taken by the enemy.
The next plan of Col. Nakar was to make for Balete Pass to Ari-
tao N.V. by following the trail across the mountains. Upon our
arrival at Aritao we heard that Balete Pass was taken by the
enemy. We were also informed that the 12th Inf. to which I belong-
ed was disbanded at Aritao, by Major Moses. Inasmuch as the way
to the south was already closed, we were not able to go to
Bataan. From the time I joined the unit of Col. Nakar, I was
always under him and under Lt. Col. Arnold who took over the
Command when the (Col. Nakar) was captured by the enemy in
Jonos, Isabela. Sept. 29, 1942.
No subsequent encounters.
