"You are warned that duly inducted and enlisted men could be discharged only by higher headquarters." Should some of the members therefore fall under the category of enlisted men, it is suggested that they be transferred to other units of your command. . . Your attention is called for purposes of precaution as it will only increase your administrative problems should you deviate from the present operating procedures, especially in the payment of services rendered prior to 9 January 1945."
- 2. Desire that you submit your final roster attaching a full explanation of how you disposed of those agents dropped in your June Roster of S-2 Agents. Also submit in duplicate oath of inductions and enlistments of all your S-2 Agents whose names appeared in your rosters rendered to this headquarters. If any duly inducted or enlisted agent had been transferred to your companies, true extract copies of the special orders in duplicate covering their transfer should be submitted.

3. A list of all non-inducted or enlisted civilian intelligence personnel (informers, civilian employees, SS agents, etc) should be submitted with remarks for what dates they have been paid or not, indicated opposite their names.
