Third Battalion Sector- Comprising the northern towns of Ilocos Sur from and including Vigan and the northern towns of Abra north of a line drawn from Bangued to Baay.

2. Battalion Commanders, therefore, will acquaint themselves with their own sector.

1. Reference is made to General Order No. 6, GHQ, USAFIP, NL. which was issued directly to the Military Governor of Ilocos Norte.


