MORNING REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY 1945

R E M A R K S

- 2/1/45 Co. "G" CP, established at Barrio Asan Norte, Sison, Pangasinan.
- 2/2/45 Two (2) Squads of the 1st Platoon under Sgt. Fermin Fentanilla and Sgt. Wags Bayason, were sent to patrol at Kapacuan Hill. Sgt. Fentanilla, Cpl. Cornelio Dumpeles, Pvt. Alcampey Yanyam and Pvt. Norberto Butarde were killed in an encounter with the Japs. Cpl. Howard Bate, Pvt. Tainan Mendoza, Pvt. Marcial Garcia, Pvt. Yobes Tilliana and Pvt. Meises Cupite were wounded during an encounter with the enemy. Forty Japs were killed.
- 2/3/45 Two (2) Squads of the 3rd Platoon under Sgt. Pablito Budille patrolled within the vicinity of the Co. CP. One Jap sniper killed.
- 2/4/45 Pvt. H. Basol, Pvt. E. Rosal and Pvt. D. Kusadsad were wounded during an encounter with Jap snipers. One Jap Sniper killed.
- 2/5/45 3rd Platoon under Lt. Lucas <sup>(acty) P.</sup> sent to patrol Kauringan. No Jap encountered.
- 2/6/45 3rd Platoon under Lt. Lucas <sup>(acty) P.</sup> sent to patrol the Question Mark Hill. Sgt. P. Budille and Cpl. A. Acay were killed in their fight. Cpl. A. Altiga, Pvt. H. Galletes, Pvt. L. Lapisac and Pvt. L. Kelly were wounded in the action.
- 2/7/45 1st Platoon under Lt. Lumanas <sup>(acty) P.</sup> sent on patrol around the vicinity of the Co. CP. No Japs encountered.
- 2/8/45 2nd Platoon patrolled east of the Co. CP. No Japs encountered. Co. CP transferred east of the Bn. CP. Pvt. G. Balaget detached from the "G" Co.
- 2/9/45 1st Platoon patrolled the hill east of the Co. CP. Pfc. Libag Pes-ey was hit on his right hand ulna by a Jap sniper.
- 2/10/45 NO CHANGE
- 2/11/45 Pvts. Joe Wayan and Pisco Aliba discharged from the Hospital and reported for duty.
- 2/12/45 Sgt. F. Salveder, Cpl. Pacomio Ventura and Pvt. F. Espinoza, were sent to the Hospital. Pfc. T. Casupang, Pvt. D. Tacay and Pvt. A. Topeng reported for duty from the Hospital.
- 2/13/45 Pfc. Serrano Pengi, Cpl. E. Anicete, Pvt. L. Fernandez and Pvt. T. Bacbac were sent to the Hospital.
- 2/14/45 Lt. F. Gardingan, Sgt. T. Saguid, Cpl. A. Garcia, Pvt. P. Juance, Pvt. A. Aquien, Pvt. L. Taawan and Pvt. L. Pesoy sent to the Hosp.
- 2/15/45 Pvt. A. de la Cruz sent to the Hospital for Medical treatment. Pvt. A. Cortez reported for duty from the Hospital.
- 2/16/45 Co. CP. transferred south of the Bn. CP. Pvt. M. Alindog sent to the Hospital for treatment.
- 2/17/45 Pvt. A. Amangan and Pvt. B. Galas sent to the Hospital.
