S i r :

I have the honor to quote hereunder suspension of the Provincial Auditor, this province, per his Certificate of Settlement, dated June 30, 1939, with the request that prompt settlement of all differences be made:

"MONEY ACCOUNTS

"Vou. No. 75 - Galap Almora, various - - - - ₱303.34 *Consumed*

1. Your attention is invited to the fact that no subsistence report of the Loo Farm School had been submitted since the month of April, 1938. Pending the receipt of the missing reports, these purchases of subsistence for the Loo Farm School are disallowed. Explanation is also required why an administrative action should not be taken against you for this negligence.
2. Information is also required whether the subsistence herein purchased had already been consumed. If not, it should be charged to supplies account.

"Vou. No. 79 - Galap Almora, M-48-c- - - - ₱79.24 *Consumed*
Same as Voucher 75.

"Vou. No. 124 - Galap Almora, various- - - - ₱199.75 *Consumed*
It appears in our records that the subsistence report of the Loo Farm School from the month of April to December, 1938, had not been submitted. In view of the failure of the Officers concerned to submit same, it is requested that their salaries be withheld until same are submitted. All purchases made during said period are hereby suspended, pending submission of said reports."

In this connection, please be informed that according to the records in this Office, the subsistence reports for the months of April, May, September, October, November, and December, 1938, have been submitted to the Provincial Auditor, but the same are being called up, most probably the above reports as submitted have been misplaced in his Office, the location of which could not be ascertained.

It appears therefor that the Loo Settlement Farm School failed to submit to this office the subsistence reports for the months of June, July, and August, 1938. Please submit these reports without any further delay to reach this Office not later than the end of this month, otherwise your salary for the month of September, 1939 will be withheld, pending receipt of these reports. Please comply.

Information is also requested as to whether or not the supplies purchased under voucher no.75 and 79 had already been consumed.
