APPOINTMENT OF SUBSTITUTE TEACHERS

To Division Superintendents:

1. In order to obviate the necessity of issuing an individual appointment form every time a substitute teacher is assigned to take the place of one who goes on leave of absence, it is desired that a corps of professionally-trained substitute teachers be organized in each province at the opening of each school term. The appointment of all such substitute teachers should be submitted at the beginning of a school term on a form patterned after the inclosed model.

2. At the end of each term, a service report should be submitted to this Office for transmittal to the Bureau of Civil Service. This report should show the inclusive dates of service rendered by each substitute teacher during the term. The monthly report on B. P. I. Form 7 of service rendered by substitute teachers as well as the names of the teachers substituted should be submitted as heretofore.

3. In the selection of substitute teachers, the criteria mentioned in the General Letters of this Office dated August 15, 1942 and August 12, 1943 should be observed.
