

DIVISION MEMORANDUM No. 19, s. 1938

FINES IMPOSED UPON TEACHERS

To Supervising Teachers and Principals:

1. Attention of all teachers is invited to the following excerpt from the letter of the Provincial Auditor, San Fernando, La Union, dated July 21, 1938, regarding fines:

For the information and guidance of all supervising and principal teachers, as well as teachers in your division, it is earnestly requested that the spirit and contents of the attached Memorandum be given wide publicity. They should see to it that immediately upon receipt of any decision promulgated by competent authority which imposes an administrative punishment upon any government official or employee, the same (fine) be immediately deducted from any salary due the officer or employee for which official receipt should be issued.

The point to bear in mind is to effect immediately the fine and an official receipt issued therefor upon the receipt of the decision of competent authority imposing the fine.

The instruction further requires that remarks be entered under column 21 corresponding to the official fined and not under column 9 on the face of the payroll, Provincial Form No. 38(A): Number of days fine; P_____, Official Receipt No.____, date
