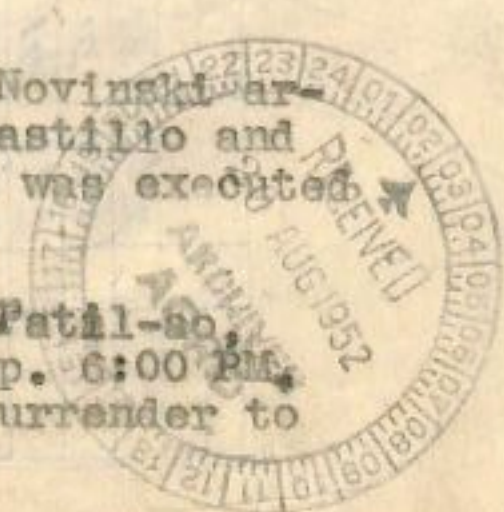

- 7-1-44 : Capt. Borje, Lts. Vergara, Garcia, as Bn. officers, Lt. Arizabal attached for duty; Sgts. Elgarico, Patil-ao, Pimentel,; Cpl. Cutal-ey, Galima, Pvts. Balitnang, Doliente, Garrino; Pvts. Ayumen, Banizal, Disono, Galleto, Isauro; Sgt. Taqueban, Cpl. Felix, Pvts. Asuncion, Bantas, Gabayan, Gagarin, Matias, Urmen; Recruits Crisostomo, Pagalanan and Rious taken up for duty 6:00 AM. Capt. Borge, Sgts. Elgarico, Patil-ao, Pimentel, Cpls. Galima, Cutaley, Pfc. Balitnang, Doliente, Garrino; Pvts. Ayumen, Banizal, Disono, Gagarin, Isauro, Pagalanan, Matias and Urmen duty to special detail at San Emilio, I. Sur. Capt. Borge duty to sk in qrts
- 7-2-44 : 3:00 PM. Major Barnett, Capt. O'Day, Lts. Vergara, Mirando and all the men of the Executive Officer's command moved to the so-called "Land of Paradise". 11:40 PM. Capt. Borge with all the members of his group arrived to the place of the Executive officer. Capt. Borge still sk in qrts.
- 7-3-44 : No change.
- 7-4-44 : 3:00 PM. a program was held in honor of the Independence Day. Maj. Barnett, Capt. O'Day and Borge gave a very memorable speech to the audience.
- 7-5-44 : 2:30 PM. Lts. Garcia, Arizabal, Sdt. Pimentel, Cpls. Cutal-ey, Galima, Pfc. Balitnang, Doliente, Garrino,; Pvts. Escobar A., Pagalanan, Bantas, Garlejo, Gagarin, and Isauro with some men of "M" Co, and the RHQ under Capt. O'DAY started for Manabo.
- 7-6-44 : Capt. Borge, Lts. Green, Escobar and with 15 men from "M" Co., BHQ. and RHQ men departed for Dalit 7:30 AM to meet the BC who were reported moving to our place. Pvt. Niaz taken up for duty and duty to special detail 8:00 PM.
- 7-7-44 : 8:00AM, Major Barnett ordered for the assembly of all men in Camp and read his decision re Lt. Galang. A lot was drawn and Pvt. Pang-oden, Tomas was drawn to pair Lt. Galang to be executed. 9:00 PM. Lt. Soria arrived for instructions. Lt. Cacatian reported for duty and same has been taken up immediately.
- 7-8-44 : 6:30 AM. Lt. Galang and Pvt. Pang-oden were executed in accordance with the Major's decision. 8:00 AM. Lts. Green and Herbert with their guards from "M" Co. and 2 men from the Executive Hq. departed for duty to special detail to the south. Pvt. Vitales taken up for duty 6:00 AM.
- 7-9-44 : 9:30 AM. Maj. Barnett, Capt. O'Day, Borge and all the boys with rifle prepared themselves to the entrances of the barrio on the way coming from Tamac because Japs were reported to come to the barrio.
- 7-10-44 : 6:00 PM. Lt. Cabuena arrived for instructions. Lt. Novinski arrived for duty to RHQ under Capt. O'Day. Vicente Castillo and Sgt. Lacsamana arrived with them. 6:30 PM. Castillo was executed for he is guilty of espionage.
- 7-11-44 : Capt. Borje, Lts. Vergara, Cacatian, Sgt. Pimentel, Patil-ao, Elgarico and some men from "M" Co. departed for Ocup. 6:00 PM. 1:30 AM. Pvt. Trinidad, Juan of the BC arrived to surrender to the Army.

- 7-13-44 : 6:30 AM. Cpl. Tamayo departed for duty to special detail with Lt. Mirendo of the Executive Officer's staff. 8:30 AM. all men in camp with rifles including the men of Lt. Dona guarded the way coming from Dalit, because Japs were reported to be there. 3:00 PM, all men returned. No Japs came. Lt. Garcia sk in qrts.
- 7-14-44 : 6:00 PM all men moved to their former Hq. Lt. Garcia sk in qrts.
- 7-15-44 : 8:00 AM. Pvt. Banizal duty to special detail. Lt. Garcia sk in qrts.
- 7-16-44 : 12:00 PM. Ponciano Caranza arrived with Cpl. Gaspar (S-2). Carranza was executed 4:30 PM for leading the Japs to the hide-outs of Lt. Sipin's rifles place. 1:30 PM Lt. Soria arrived from Nagbukel, bringing with him Lt. Ladiocan, BC officer and 12 of his men. 4:00 PM. Lt. Vergara, Pimentel, Balitnang, started for duty to special detail. Lt. Vergara and Sgt. Pimentel departed with Capt. O'Day for Luba. 9:00 AM Pvt. Galleto duty to special detail. Lt. Garcia sk in qrts.
- 7-17-44 : 8:00A M. Lt. Escobar of the RHQ, Cpls. Galima, Cutal-ey, Pfc. Doliente, Garrino, Pvts. Escobar A., Asuncion, Pagalanan, Garlejo, Gagarin, duty to special detail for Burgos.

- 7-20-44 : Left Bn.Hq. on the 20th passing thru Asin, Lunch at Lancuas. From Lancuas pass thru Baang to San Emilio, poblacion. Arrived at Lidaoan about 5:00 AM the same date. Supper and sleep at Lidaoan, San Emilio.
- 7-21-44 : Early in the morning we moved to Cayos, Angaki, Lunch at Cayos. Executed spies of Cayos, Malideg and Itab who evacuated there. After lunch we moved to the poblacion of Angaki. The place Angaki poblacion is evacuated. The C.O. ordered the destruction of the trenches of the of the enemy. At the same time ordered to dispose the bad elements left by the enemy. Proceeded to Legleg and killed some more spies. We returned to the poblacion after the burning of houses of spies at Legleg. Burned also the garrison in the poblacion and the houses of spies in Angaki, Ilocos Sur. After supper we left Angaki, pursuing the enemy which left for Concepcion the same day. We took Borboran and flank the enemy on the night. We sleep at the top of the hill overlooking the barrio of Borboran.
- 7-22-44 : Borboran, Concepcion, I.S.:- Breakfast at Borboran. Proceeded to Concepcion. Enemy started early in the morning upon knowing that we are in the area, for Bauguen. Reached Kubkubuan in the evening. Executed spies of Kubkubuan, Matweo, Alfonso, barrios of Concepcion. Moved to Ananao executed spies from Ananao and Tangaoan.
Night operation:-Moved to the poblacion of Concepcion. Since the place is evacuated the Capt. ordered the burning of the poblacion. Returned to Kubkubuan the same night after the burning of the poblacion. In those two Municipalities the Capt. ordered the return of the civilians so that they could assume their work. Total butchered spies 47 for the two Municipalities.
- 7-23-44 : San Emilio, I. S.:- Moved from Kubkubuan to San Emilio, I. S.
- 7-24-44 : San Emilio, I. S. :- Rest
- 7-25-44 : Captain Borge ordered the boys to moved to Banayoyo and contact D-3-2 to contact Lt. Gabat and Lt. Blanco for a joint raid on the B. C. garrison at Candon. The job was a failure due to the fact that the boys were spied. They were met by at one of the barrios of Galimoyod the nearest base to raid the P.C. garrison.
- 7-26-44 : San Emilio, I. S.:- The Bn. Hq. personel left at San Emilio, I. S. At 6:00 AM Sgt. Jacob arrived and taken for duty. Pvt. Crisostomo duty to special detail 7:00 AM.
- 7-27-44 : No change
- 7-28-44 : Pvts. Banizal and Galleto duty to special detail 8:00 AM.
