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STATEMENT

I, AVILINO P AGOSTA _____, 25 _____ of age, married _____
(full name) (years) (status)

native of Nagillian, La Union, and at present residing at Lipa, Batangas
Philippines, and in accordance to law, hereby dispose and say the following:

That I was among those who were concentrated at Camp O'Donnell Cayas, Tarlac.

During my stay in the camp I found out that treatments of officers and Non-commissioned officers upon the men were not all fair. Most of the able bodied Officers forced the men to work on the burial detail, not minding whether the poor soldier could do the job or not. And it was a tough work, cause you were to carry the dead soldiers to the cemetery the whole day. If you refuse for reason, that you feel you can't do it, 'cause of some sort of sickness, they beat you like an animal and they always insist that you are malingering.

Another incident that happened to me is still fresh in my mind and that I could not forget for the rest of my life. I was sick of Dysentery that time. Early in the morning, I have to go to the latrine because I could no longer help it. I was then late in formation and the First Sergeant of our Group give me two punches on my stomach and it was really painful for I even cried for some moments. As far as I remember his name is CALVO from Cebu or Ilodillo. He always bragged to the men that he is an Olympic boxer.

Medicines were sold in the camp, by doctors and also men who have some. For those who have no money were just contented on the blessings of the Lord. Some had survived but it was one or two out of a hundred.

Food and water were very scarce. Just a handful of rice or even less than that sometimes with a few drops of soup and a little slice of meat will do to the men.

I don't think I was living while I was in the Camp. I was only existing.

For goodness sake I included my name among the list of the Manila release. I left the Camp 15 September 1942.

THAT I know personally CAPT. RENALDO CAPIÑALAO having been under my command since August 16, 1943 as a Company commander of my "H" Company.

THAT Captain RENALDO CAPIÑALAO was commissioned 1st Lieutenant on August 16, 1943 and promoted February 8, 1944 to the rank of Captain by virtue of Special Orders signed by Col. RENALDO J. ALMOCILLA, USA, COLIBAOI, Commanding Officer of the Fil-Amersians' Irregular Troops, Philippines Islands.

That Captain CAPIÑALAO has been actively working with my outfit since his appointment as Company Commander up to the time he went to be processed on March 5, 1945.

That Captain CAPIÑALAO was never granted by me any discharge, verbally or in writing because I did not like him to leave my outfit because his services were indispensable.

O R D E R

There are eight accused in this case, and six of them have already been apprehended and arraigned of the nature of the complaint against them, to which, after reading same to them in Tagalog and English, each had voluntarily and spontaneously pleaded not guilty, namely, Francisco Buhay, Federico Basco, Fermin Aguilar, Alejandro Arsenias, Ladislao Garcia and Patricio Yambao. These have asked for a separate preliminary investigation through counsel, which was granted.

On plea by the defense that the prosecution witnesses be made to appear in Court to let them point to the accused for the reason that in their affidavits they stated that they could recognize the persons responsible for the death of Dee Ching Ting if they saw them, the prosecution, which assented to said petition and which the Court granted in the exercise of its sound discretion same being reasonable and the crime charged being serious, on November 24, 1945, the day set for the holding of the preliminary investigation, let Ireneo Junio and Onofre Peralta point under oath to the accused, who were lined up before them. Ireneo Junio, in answer to the question in Tagalog of private prosecutor Atty. Priscila Angeles-Villacorta to point the accused whom he saw to have had to do with the death of Dee Ching Ting, readily and unhesitatingly pointed to the accused Francisco Buhay, Federico Basco, Alejandro Arsenias and Fermin Aguilar, touching each of them, but he did not point to the accused Ladislao Garcia and Patricio Yambao. Onofre Peralta looked at the six accused above-named and then hesitatingly and readily said that the four soldiers whom he saw push Dee Ching Ting into the river were not in the group. A third witness of the prosecution, Teodoro Oviedo, was not presented to identify the accused because according to the indorsement of the Chief of Police of Bayambang, Pangasinan, in returning the subpoena issued, he is presently residing in Manila and his address thereat is unknown, and the prosecution had chosen not to present him. Thereafter, the Court asked the defense attorneys whether the six accused wanted to present any evidence, or to testify, in their favor, and leading defense attorney Mr. Leonardo Gonzales, stated that they have chosen not to let the accused present any evidence, or testify, in their favor.

"El objeto de la investigación preliminar o de una previa indagación de alguna especie, antes de enjuiciar a las personas acusadas, es asegurar al inocente contra persecuciones precipitadas, maliciosas y opresivas y protegerle contra una acusación pública y manifiesta por un delito y de las molestias, gastos y ansiedades de un proceso público y proteger asimismo al Estado contra persecuciones inútiles y costosas". (E. U. contra Grant y otros, 1^o Jur., 123; E. U. contra Mendoza, 4^o Jur. Fil., 123).

The Court finds that there is probable cause to believe that the crime charged in the complaint has been committed and that of the six accused above-named who have asked for separate preliminary investigation, the accused Francisco Buhay, Federico Basco, Alejandro Arsenias and Fermin Aguilar are probably responsible therefor, and that

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the accused Ladislao Garcia and Patricio Yambao are not.

WHEREFORE, The Court remands the records of this case to the Court of First Instance of Pangasinan for trial thereof on the merits with respect to the accused Francisco Buhay, Federico Basco, Alejandro Arsenias and Fermín Aguilar, and directs the Chief of Police of Bayumbang, Pangasinan, to deliver their persons to the Clerk of Court of First Instance of Pangasinan. The Court hereby sets free the accused Ladislao Garcia and Patricio Yambao and directs the said Chief of Police to release them immediately from his custody. In view of the fact that the accused Adreano de la Cruz and Isayaz Regala have not been apprehended yet, the Clerk of Court of First Instance of Pangasinan is hereby requested to return the expediente to this Court for furtherance of the same with respect to them. 2/8 of the costs de officio.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


