OFFICIAL.

1. ORGANIZATION FOR MALARIA CONTROL.

Paragraph 3, Section IV, War Department Circular 117, 14 April 1945, is quoted for information and compliance:

"a. Unit Control. Commanders will exercise malaria control through the regular military channels of command. Commanders will be assisted by the antimalaria details mentioned in "b" below, by organic medical personnel, and when appropriate, by special Medical Department organizations for malaria control. The commander is charged with the supervision and enforcement of malaria control in his unit with particular emphasis on the development of malaria discipline. The commander is charged with the timely requisitioning of antimalaria supplies for his unit. The commander will maintain liaison with any Medical Department malaria control organization in his area.

b. Antimalaria Details. In order to assist unit commanders in the control of malaria there will be formed in each company, battery, or similar unit, an antimalaria detail to consist of a minimum of two enlisted men, including one noncommissioned officer. In non-medical units this detail will be made up of non-medical personnel. This detail will be specially selected by the commander and will be given immediate training in use and minor maintenance repairs of screening and bed nets, hand-killing and spray-killing adult mosquitoes, larvicidal ciling of puddles and minor collections of water, minor ditching, minor water tidiness around a company encampment, and individual measures of malaria control in rear areas and in combat. These antimalaria details will carry out ordinar, ntimalaria housekeeping measures such as those listed above, in and immediately around the company encampment."

4. 31ST INFANTRY DIVISION STOCKADE.

- a. The 31st Infantry Division Stockade is located at Agusan.
- b. Garrison prisoners having more than a month of sentence yet to serve may be committed.
 - c. Each prisoner will be accompanied by the following:
 - 5 copies of court-martial order ordering confinement.
 2 fatigue uniforms, mess equipment, toilet articles, stationery (optional).
- d. Prisoners, other than those mentioned in "b" above, will not be admitted without prior approval of this headquarters and then only under exceptional circumstances (units in the Bugo-Del Monte area contact Provost exceptional and those south of Del Monte the Staff Judge Advocate).
