These officers and enlisted men operated under extremely precarious and hazardous circumstances, unmindful of the dangers to which they exposed their lives and the lives of their families, and conscious only of that high sense of obligation which they so firmly believe to be the apex of their ambition to manifest, at all costs, that spirit of self-sacrifice which the enemy had tried so hard to destroy.





TO : Capt. Emilio Hernandez  
C. O., 3rd Regiment  
Pampanga MD

- (1) It has come to the attention of this Headquarters sometime in the past that you have been conducting yourself in a manner unbecoming of an officer and a soldier and to the detriment of the organization.
- (2) Due to the above-mentioned facts, this Headquarters issued an order to the District Commander of Pampanga to relieve you from duty making a thorough investigation. However, due to his desire to deliver the letter to you personally, the supposed action has not been taken as yet.
- (3) Major Bautista, being interested in you, has interceded in your behalf and requested that you be allowed to make further explanation to correct your action, but due to lack of time he was unable to learn all the facts. Your request to come here is denied. However, I have directed the District Commander of Pampanga, who is the bearer of this communication to review the whole situation and make a complete investigation submitting his report to this Headquarters of his findings. Along with his report, I want you to submit a report of all your actions, with substantiating papers and I will decide whether you deserve to be given a chance.
- (4) I have been deeply disappointed in your past actions. Having known you personally and held you in high esteem is rather hard for me to believe that you would be guilty of such a lack of loyalty to your cause for any reason whatsoever and for that reason, I hope that you will be able to mitigate some of the accusations and forget about personal ambition as we have no time for such things in this organization.

6. Cruz, Gabriel - Pfc

Former unit;- Co. "I" 21st Infantry

Missing in Action at Moron

Got left with 9 men, among whom are Corporal Pablo Zamora, with whom he escaped, and who later died - and Lieut. Leoncio Cristobal, whose whereabouts he doesn't know ever since they got separated.

7. Fronda, Julio -

Attached to \_\_\_\_\_ Company, 21st Infantry. Squadron got cut off because wasn't informed of retreat. With (8) eight men, among whom was Sgt. Rosales Osias, they tried to rejoin unit, but couldn't pass thru the Japanese line. Stayed (1) one week at Porac. Then went home.

8. Diaz, Martin - Pfc

From unit Co. "H" 21st Inf.

During a fire fight in Porac, Platoon Leader got killed (Lt. Melecio de Guzman) and they attached themselves (with Pfc Genaro Gonzales, now in Olivas, and Corporal Roselio, Both of Co. "H") to platoon of Lt. Flores of Company "F", 21st Infantry (now in Olivas). They got short of ammunition and found out they were cut off. They destroyed their arms, and tied to pass through Japanese lines. Not succeeding, he, with Lt. Flores and Corporal Toselio went toward Mabalacat wher they stayed a week. Not <sup>having</sup> getting a chance to slip through Bataan, they went home.

but upon arrival at Malolos, Co. had left. Attempted to go to Bataan, but reached Calumpit only. Later conversation with Co. clerk, Sgt. Olijompo Isidro now at HPA reveals fact that the 2 guards at Radio Station were entirely forgotten when their company *moved out*.

1. Pursuant to your verbal instructions to investigate Maj Eusebio Vivar, the following is submitted.

a. On or about 4 August 1945, Maj Vivar was assigned at the Station Hospital, 4th Camp Complement, Bayambang, Pangasinan, per par 1, SO 317, Hq ECLGA, Bayambang, Pangasinan. Upon receipt of said order, Maj Vivar reported for duty but left the next day, based on verbal agreement with 1st Lt Nuguid, Adjutant of the Station Hospital. However, the registrar forgot to drop Maj Vivar from the Morning Report, so he was marked AWOL till 30 Sep 45.

b. When Maj Vivar was questioned why he has been on AWOL, he produced SO 338 (Exh "C-3") relieving him from the Station Hospital and assigning him to Division Hq, ECLGA.

c. The main anomaly in this case is the fact that the Station Hospital was not furnished with SO 338 as appearing therein in the distribution.

d. Maj Lazaro, the CO of the Hq ECLGA, at Bayambang, Pangasinan, was questioned about this, and admitted that he issued SO 338 but that he failed to furnish the Station Hospital with a copy of the same.

2. In view of the foregoing, it is recommended that Maj Lazaro be administratively reprimanded for failing to furnish the Station Hospital with SO 338 so much so that the said Station Hospital failed to drop Maj Vivar.

3. That Maj Vivar be also administratively reprimanded for not getting clearance from the Station Hospital when he was relieved.

4. That 1st Lt Ernesto P Nuguid be administratively reprimanded for negligence to duty.





To : The Adjutant General HPA, APO 500, Manila  
(Thru C. O., Phil. Army Instructor Detachment)

1. Request that I be released from my present assignment and duties and authorized to adapt my guerrilla rank for the following reasons:

a. I have been commissioned 1st Lieutenant, Inf., on 15 August 1943 and promoted 8 February 1944, to the rank of Captain by virtue of Special Orders signed by COL. EDMOND P. ELLSWORTH, USA, ASN-0112201 Commanding Officer of the Fil-American Irregular Troops Philippine Islands. I have been actively working as Company Commander of "H" Company with the First Tarlac Regiment, under the command of Lt. Col. Jose C. Maristela since my induction until I had myself processed with the 2nd Replacement Battalion on 3 March 1945.

b. The First Tarlac Regiment, to which outfit I belong was recognized on 3 March 1945, by the Commander in Chief of the Southwest Pacific Area and therefore pursuant to the provisions of Executive Orders No. 21, his Excellency the President of the Commonwealth of the Philippines, my commission and promotion in the First Tarlac Regiment was confirmed.

c. I have been a guerrilla with the First Tarlac Regiment since 15 August 1943 and have whole-heartedly worked for the cause. I have rendered my services honestly and faithfully under strict vigilance of the Japanese and I have pledged my true allegiance and support to the government of the United States of America and the Commonwealth of the Philippines. During my connection with the guerrilla I devoted my life and continued my resistance to its enemies, sacrificing my life and even to the safety of my family.

d. I have enlisted with the Regular Force Philippine Army on 9 April 1930 with continuous service. I have mostly devoted my service in the training cadres as Phil. Army Instructor. I have graduated from the different Service Schools for Cadre Instructor with very satisfactory ratings. I have surrendered to the Japanese Forces on 9 April 1942, at Mariveles, Bataan and joined the Death March at Camp O'Donnell until I was released on 27 August 1942.

2. At present I am activated and assigned with the HPA, (Miscellaneous Group) on TDY, with the XLV Corps United States Army as Instructor in the School for Officers and Enlisted men ECLGA.

3. In view of the foregoing circumstances, I pray that for the good of the service and in fairness to myself, I be allowed to hold my guerrilla rank and released for duty with my former outfit the First Tarlac Regiment.

4. Attached are affidavits of witnesses, letters of my release from my former Commanding Officer, as well as appointment and promotion papers.
