1. In view of the reorganization of the Bulacan Military District, hereto enclosed are the corrected unit rosters of the District Headquarters; Hq. Co. Service Troops; 31st Infantry; and the 69th Infantry. The other units - 32nd Infantry; Anilao Bn and the 3rd Bn, Mt. Corps have not yet submitted their rosters.

2. As per SO Nos. 2 & 3 of GHQ, ECIGA dated 13 Jan 45, the Anilao Bn and the 3rd Bn both of the Mt. Corps Regiment were attached for duty with the Bulacan Military District. On 17 Jan 45 all armed men were detached from their respective units and combined to form the Combat Troops under the command of Evt. Lt. Col. J. de la Rosa. These men are only on detached service.

a. Killed - Pfc. Cecilio Alano died of Malaria on 22 Jan 45  
Pvt. Mateo Ocampo while on patrol duty killed by Japs at Bagumbong, Calocan, Rizal during the raid thereat.

b. Wounded - Sgt. Santiago Estrella on patrol duty at Bagbaguin by the Huks on 14 Jan 45.  
Pvt. Blas Magtaka on patrol duty shot by unknown person on 30 Dec 44.  
Pvt. Mario Origen on mission to GHQ, ECIGA shot probably by Japs on 24 Jan 45.

c. Missing - Lt. Amado Manalo since 25 Nov 44 reported to be in the FEU Garrison.  
Lt. Teodoro Herrera since 23 Dec 44 whereabouts unknown.  
Pfc. Hablan Juson since 16 Dec 44 reported taken by Huks.  
Pvts. Patricio Climaco & Candido San Felipe since 8 Jan 45 reported taken by 3rd Bn, Valenzuela Regiment, BMA.

3.2 69th Infantry (Kakarong):

a. Killed - Sgt. Serafin del Rosario died while on mission to Baliwag on 20 Oct. 44.  
Sgt. Pablo Morales died during encounter against Huks at Dalig on 17 Oct 44.  
Pvt. Simeon Tiongson died during encounter against Huks at Dalig on 17 Oct 44.  
Pvt. Arturo de Jesus died during encounter against Huks at Real on 23 May 44.

22 February '45

1. On 4 February '45, all armed men forming the Combat Troops were returned to their respective Organization. The 69th Inf. and some men of the Hq. Co. Serv. Troops, were combined to form the MP section under the District Headquarters, of the Bulacan Military District.

2. District Headquarters:

a. Killed - Captain Aurora de la Rosa, on detached service with the Dist. Hqs. died from a gun shot wound at Malahakan, Meycauayan, Bulacan on 4 February '45.  
1st Lieut. Olimpio Abacan died in action during an encounter against the Japs at Perez, Meycauayan, Bulacan on 16 February '45.

2.1 31st Infantry:

a. Killed - Pvt. Modesto Burgos died of malaria on 9 November '44.  
Pvt. Jose Barason at Nagbalon, Marilao, Bulacan while on mission thereat, burned to death during zonification by Japs on 28 January '45.  
Pfc. Quirico Conteras died in action during an encounter against the Japs at Meycauayan, Bulacan on 3 Feb. '45.  
2nd Lieut. Martin Rivera died in action during an encounter against the Japs at Camarin, Novaliches, Rizal on 15 February '45.  
2nd Lieut. Tomas Ruiz died in action during an encounter against the Japs at Perez, Meycauayan, Bulacan on 16 February '45.  
Pvts. Eligio Urian and Raymundo Montaniel died in action during an encounter against the Japs at Perez, Meycauayan Bulacan on February 16, '45.  
Pvt. Laureano Mendoza wounded during an encounter against the Japs at Perez, Meycauayan, Bulacan on 16 February '45 died at the 71st Evacuation Hospital, US Army on 17 February '45.

b. Wounded- Pvt. Santos Raymundo during an encounter against the Japs at Pandayan, Meycauayan, Bulacan on 15 February '45.  
Pfc. Marcos del Rosario during an encounter against the Japs at Amarin, Novaliches, Rizal on 15 February '45.  
Pvts. Nicanor Anzures and Matias Mendoza during an encounter against the Japs at Perez, Meycauayan, Bulacan on 16 February '45. Evacuated to the 71st Evacuation Hospital, US Army.

X Pvts. Lee Hong, contracted dysentery on 14 February '45, evacuated to the San Lazaro Hospital, Manila on 16 February '45.

X Pvts. Braulio Daet, Julian Barcelino and Isabelo Francisco during an encounter against the Japs at Camarin, Novaliches, Rizal on 19 February '45. Evacuated to the Malolos, Bulacan by American troops.

c. Missing Pvt. Santos Francisco missing since 7 November '44 reported taken by the Japs.  
Pvt. Manuel de Mesa reported missing since 20 November '44, whereabouts unknown.  
Pfc. Ablan Juson captured by the Huks on 16 December '44, escaped and reported to his outfit on 18 February '45.

3. Captain A. de la Rosa, 1st Lt. Olimpio R. Abacan, 2nd Lt. Tomas Ruiz, Pfc. Q. Contreras, Pvts. M. Burgos, E. Urian, and R. Montaniel were buried at the Catholic Cemetery of Meycauayan, Bulacan. Pvt. Jose Barason buried at Nagbalom, Marilao, Bulacan. 2nd Lt. Martin Rivera buried at Camarin, Novaliches, Rizal. Pvt. L. Mendoza buried in an unknown Army Cemetery.
4. Two Taiwanese prisoners captured during an encounter against the Japs at Malahakan, Meycauayan, Bulacan on 2 February '45. Turned over to the 39th MP Co., 6th Army on 18 February '45. One Jap prisoner captured during an encounter against the Japs at Camalig, Meycauayan, Bulacan, on 17 February '45. Turned over to the 39th MP Co., 6th Army on the same date.
5. Many men have reported to the different Army processing centers.
6. Morale of the command is fair.
