



10. CIVILIAN POPULATION - Civilians are fast evacuating places designated as danger areas with the exception of a number that could not be neglected who are reluctant to leave their abode for financial reasons and difficulty to secure transportation facilities. However, towns where Japa landing fields are located are almost, if not fully, evacuated.

With regards to civilian cooperation in matters of our procurement of supply, their spirit is quite high except at times when they act slowly owing to the presence of HUKBALAHAPS or Japanese units in their neighborhood.
