3. That these USAFFE soldiers remained and joined the guerrilla force which was organized in Western Pangasinan after the fall of Bataan;

4. That said EM remained under my command throughout the Japanese occupation period.





That at about 2200 hrs, 11 Oct. 45 while on my way to my tent within the perimeter of the Camp I tipped over a box and found it. I examined the box and found it containing rations, presumably canned goods.

I brought the box with me to my tent where the C.O. is in order to report it to him because I do not know the owner. My C.O. however is not in the tent so I waited for him in order to report to him what I found.

Before the arrival of my C.O. Capt. Mejia arrived with some men looking for the box, so that I was not able to report the box which I found to my C.O.

One of the boys with Capt. Mejia slapped Pvt. Primitivo Buena who disclaimed ownership of the box in front of Capt. Mejia.


