EXPEDITE IMMEDIATE ACTION

Memorandum for-
All Bn & Unit Commanders, I PR

1. As per instruction of Lt Raffort, RPD, AFWESPAC, now at the Naguillian Bivouac Area, the processing of the 1st Pangasinan Regiment will start this morning, 19, Dec '45.

2. It is hereby directed that you must have all your men ready for the processing with all necessary papers anent their status on hand.

3. For the start, it is hereby directed that all Unit and Bn Commanders must immediately send to the RPD to day any number of EM in your respective units who are ready for the processing.

4. Incl is a Check Sheet from the RPD for your information and guidance. Form # 17 as stated in the Check Sheet will be furnished this Headquarters so you may come to this Office for particulars anent said form.

5. Please take immediate steps to recall all Officers and Enlisted Men now out on pass to return immediately to Camp for the processing. In the meanwhile, all men now in Camp should get busy preparing their papers and every time they are made ready and alright with their respective papers should be directed and ordered to report to the Recovered Personnel Detachment immediately without delay.

6. It is hereby informed that the processing for the Regiment will not be any longer be by units as this is found rather a delaying factor in the processing. So it is clear that any one from your respective units who has all papers ready for processing must be ordered to report to the RPD as directed.

7. All civilians guerrillas are required to present their marriage certificate whether married before and after 1941. If no marriage certificate is available, accomplish an affidavit to that effect.

**Memorandum for-
All Unit & Bn Commanders**

1. The Commanding Officer desires to reiterate and emphasize further that new ranks in the new T/O are now revoked and the authority to wear bars corresponding to the new T/O ranks is hereby withdrawn. Compliance to instructions contained in para 2 & 4 of Ltr, this Hq, dtd 4 November 1945, re: ranks, directed.

2. This does not mean however that the normal functions of your unit as an organization in the ~~the~~ new T/O will be altered. It is hereby instructed that all units in the present organized T/O will function as usual with the exception of course to the changes in ranks. Designations will remain as they are but the old and recognized ranks must be used.

3. In effect, there has been so much confusion in the accomplishment of the daily Strength Report and the Morning Report. Comply with instructions specified above. From hence, new T/O ranks as you have been placing in these two reports must be changed. Use the old and recognized ranks but do not change nor alter the designations as given them in the present set-up(T/O).

4. All unit commanders are hereby earnestly requested and directed to instruct all non-commissioned officers responsible for making reports to comply with specific instructions regarding these changes.

5. Strict and immediate compliance heretofore is enjoined.

MEMORANDUM for-
CO, 2nd Battalion

ATTENTION: CAPTAIN QUINTO & SANTOS AND OTHER OFFICERS.

1. It has come to the attention of this Headquarters that Captain Quinto and Captain Santos of your battalion are not attending to their military duties diligently. The above named officers are all the time out, staying most of the time in the city of Baguio, ignoring totally their duties and responsibilities.

2. This practice of going out for pleasure and good time during duty hours and of sleeping and quartering outside of the camp are highly contrary to Army regulations. All members of this command are supposed to live and quarter themselves in camp and not in any other place. It is hereby directed that the officers concerned be immediately affronted and apprised of such practice. It should be noted that this office can never and once again tolerate such precedents.

3. In the physical check-up made by the undersigned this day, it came out that the majority of the officers in that Battalion are out. This should never be done next and at all times. No amount of explanation and excuses would suffice to justify such inconsistencies in the near future.

4. From hence, it is expected that said officers may reform and abide to instructions hereunto stated. It should be emphasized to them that a repetition of same will be dealt with severely.
