Joe:-

David brot your letter in on the evening of Oct 4th. We had to haul out early in the morning being within a hair of all being caught. We were completely surprised and had it not been for a timely rainstorm within extremely heavy and low-hanging clouds we would not have escaped. We have been on the Dodge since but are well settled now for a while as soon as Luge gets in we will be operating again.

A Spaniard by the name of Medina formerly 31st Inf. was caught and he knew a lot about everything and when they finished with him he apparently held nothing back. That is what happened. I am not sure how many more are endangered by his capture, but I am sure of the Mayor of Porac & O'Campo.

The Japs put on a 15 day drive and after netting practically nothing but lost heavily-they reorganized two columns of 500 each to comb the area for me. As they were ready to proceed they were ordered south where it is reported Mindanao is under bombing.

I have reliable authority on the fact they were ordered not to proceed and also that they went South. I believe something is exciting the Japs considerable.

Mac had a furious fight all over Zambales. He reported 143 killed and got all their equipment. He had not reported since. We fed him from this side. Other sporadic fighting here all in favor of guerrillas.

We have had no R news since 4th Oct. Hope to set up again soon. Last news was main Australian focus *forces* fighting in New Guinea, not much resistance, appeared to be about to complete conquest of New G. Bombing continues and reaching northward from New G. & Solomon's. U.S. Airforce in China ready to cooperate in South Pacific.

Rumors; - Cavite bombed; US Troop in Borneo and Bombing in Mindanao; Pangasinan Radio reports Roosevelt offered Hirohito Proposition to make Tokyo Open City, if all Japs leave P.I. to release all Prisoners of Bataan to U.S. Repeated rumors are that activity around Lingayen indicate expected attack etc.

Brooks has done a swell job in the rice Province of Tarlac. He has taken Squadron No 1, Squadron No 10, and most of Aquinos Squadron No 3, away from Huks. All armed Aquino is here in this area with a few men left including Manabat, Taruc, and one other bandit. They are marauding as usual and People quite fed up.

They are taking some USAFFE men forcing them to join. I am convinced it is futile to negotiate and any arrangement they make will not be lived up to. I am also convinced that we will be sadly amiss from the viewpoint of higher authority if we associate ourselves with them in any way. Therefore I am planning to issue Proclamation setting forth their true status and ordering them to turn over arm.& Equip. of US Gov. to U.S. soldiers. Also revoke authorities of Alejandrino and Sapang. Bold and may seem foolish but nevertheless necessary and the only step that can be taken. I am convinced this will at least bring some more subordinates to us, as I have talked

to several and they believe the whole rotten mess can be neutralized by some such actions. Let me know how Bell comes out before I take this step.

I am also planning to break up E.C.L. something as follows, glad to receive any suggestions on that.

East Pangasinan - Cushing

Nueve Ecija ?

Tarlac Brooks

Pampanga (less Porac, F.B. Guagua, Lubao, Dinalupihan and Macabebe) ?

Bulacan (Less ~~also~~ Manila but including excepted municipalities of Pampanga) - Baker

Who can we get to act as liasion as suggested by you ?

I have an organizer for West Pangasinan now, where people are clamoring for leadership in organizing.

By time this messenger return, I will have Hq set up again and get out orders etc.

We are setting pretty fair now and all Japs seemed to have cleared out, and Tarlac is comparatively deserted.

1. Re-analysis of the signature of Lt. Col. C. A. Thorp appearing on page 5-A of 330.32 Rosters, Hq. Sn Nicolas Det., Folder No. 82 (500-3-6) re my findings dated 6 Feb 1952, based on the 25 signatures of Lt. Col. Ca.A. Thorp, which was not presented during my previous examination, appearing in 327.31 Induction LGAF, Folder No. 2, 1942, as follows:

a. This case was first presented to the undersigned on 23 June 1950 for authentication. Findings was rendered on 27 June 1950 unfinished due to non-availability of official specimen signatures of C.A. Thorp, this headquarters.

b. Radio communication was sent to Adjutant General, Washington 25, D.C. on 27 June 1950, requesting said office to furnish this headquarters photostat copies of Thorp's signatures for use in authenticating his signatures on documents he signed during the last World War.

c. On July 1950, two types of Thorp's signatures in photostat copy, were received, but due to pressure of work, no action was taken on this case per my statement in my finding dated 27 June 1950, not until Mr. Richard L. Saillant called my attention regarding receipt of Thorps specimen signatures.

d. On 4 Feb 1952 the case was returned to me for final authentication. My opinion was rendered on 6 Feb 1952 based explicitly on the official specimen signature of Thorp, which resulted in its non-authenticity.

e. On 12 March 1952, 327.31 Induction LGAF, Folder No. 2, dated 1942, bearing the 25 signatures of C.A. Thorp, as Commanding Guerrilla Forces Luzon, USAFFE, was presented by Mr. Wesley R. Fronk, for reconsideration of my determination, dated 6 Feb 1952.

f. Examination of the source of Folder No. 2 bearing the 25 signatures of Thorp is the same as that of Folder No. 82.

g. Examination of the 25 signatures of C.A. Thorp, appearing in Folder No. 2 with the signature on page 5-A of Folder No. 82 and carefully checked against Thorp's official signatures, reveals that characteristics shown in the official specimen signatures of Thorp are definitely present in the 25 signatures of Thorp in Folder No. 2, which also coincide with the characteristics found in the signature of Thorp in Folder No. 82 page 5-A.

g. To further justify the genuinity of the signature of Thorp in Folder No. 82 and No. 2, the ink in both folders were analysed. Most of the signatures of

Thorp in Folder No. 2 and page 5-A of Folder No. 82 were written with the same ink, Carter's ink, permanent midnight blue-black. (Pre-war ink).

h. Chemical analysis in order to determine the proximate age of the ink signatures from date completed to this date of examination by using ink signatures in both folders, deemed most proper for use as specimen, as they are of the same material and appears to have been kept in the same manner, gives the same reaction, showing that they were really signed in 1942.

2. I am fully convinced that the signatures of C.A. Thorp appearing on page 5-A of 330.32 Rosters, Hq Sn Nicolas Det, Folder No. 82 (500-3-6) and the 25 signatures of Thorp appearing in 327.31 Induction LGAF Folder No. 2 dated 1942 to be Thorp's genuine signatures and that my opinion rendered on 6 Feb 52 be null and void.




