1. I have the honor to submit the Puppet's Filipino Employees; Circulars, Communications, Instruction, Orders and Procedures to irradiate, capture remnants (so-called) USAFFE, Guerrillas, Bandits and Hiding Elements.

2. This correspondence was snatched by the undersign for reference and records re this COLLABORATORS within the Province of Nueva Vizcaya. This persons signed the Circulars that appeared in the Blacklist submitted in that HQS.

3. The undersign and inhabitants, further certify that the Circulars and Orders issued were strictly enforced to the inhabitants of the province, executed by MP's, BC, Pro-Japs, and the Subersive Agents with the Imperial Army, which causes severe maltreatment of Innocent persons, captured of some remnants USAFFE or Guerrillas and killings, specially in mountains and remote barrios.


