To : MAJOR C. M. SMITH, CE-AUS; AIB, In the Field

- 1. On 21 July '44, a group of 93 men around 60 of which were armed, under the command of ZABAT arrived at Manite and tied up Mr. JOSE DASP, the municipal mayor of said town who is a leval supporter of the guerrillas, and our 3rd bt. JOSE CANON, who was then in tewn to buy supplies. The group headed by ZABAT and LLEMARIZAS also caught our 1st Sgt. PENCEON of the "B" Co., 1st Bn. and after dispessessing him of his clothes cold-bloededly murdered him publicly in the town itself. They claim that they did this because all the men under Mai. LAPUS are brigands and high-way rebbers. Hewever, they had no explanation whatseever fer their dispossesing the entire town-felk of Manite of their good clething, food-stuff and of their subjecting the civilians to rough treatment. Several swern statements are being taken from civilians of the abuses of these men but up to this writing they have not yet reached this Hetrs. Enclosed is the Special Report of Lt. CANON on his detention.
- 2. Lt. CARKN and Mayer DAEP were released through the help of Lt's. DEFIN YUNIOG alias JUNN DE JESUS and JOSE CHISSOL. The forwar is on All perpasentative operating in this region under the SMPA. Subject: MY ARREST BY THE ZABAT WILD GROUP.

To : C.O. 1st INF. BN. 54th INFANTRY

- 1. On 21 July '44, I was arrested by the group of Cel.
 ZABAT in the tewn of Manite. Upon identifying myself a Lieutement
 of Majer LAPUS, I was jabbed twe times with a rifle and slashed
 with a bele. However I sucaped unscathed. I was then bound.
- 2. A certain Majer LLENARIZA teld me that he was geing te turn me over to ESCUDERO because I belonged to the LAPUS group, and that the said group had been abusing the civilians. I referred him to the Mayer of Manite, but I later found out that they had bound the Mayer tee. I saw also the said Majer LLENARIZA jab the Mayer on the stemach with his pistel.
- 3. It was only good that blout, DELFIN YUNIOC of the 7th MD, new on duty with the AIB, with Lieut, JUSE GRISSOL, P.A. arrived at Manite from Legaspi to centact Lieut, NUBHIN DEUNA under Major LAVIS. It was not after Lieut. YU HING testified on my beniaf that Col. ZAMAT released me. Before Mayor JOSE DARP and I were released, we were made to sign swern statements. Bunclesed is a true copy of my swern statement.
- 4. Sgt. NONITO PRAZON was also caught by the same wild group that arrested me and upon knowing that he was connected with Major LAPUS was mhot, and further relieved of all his clethings and shees; and also his side arm. We had to bury him nemiced.
- 5. Upon my arrest I was also relieved of my jacket and cash. Lieut. DRLFIN YU HICO and Lleut. CRISSOL were believed of their "camisetas" by the same wild group and according to Lleut. YU HICO, had he set immediately identified himself as an intelligence efficier en duty with the AIB, he would have been also relieved of his wallet; centaining all his allewance money.

- 6. The se wild group took one at lef rice from the Municipal Bldg, and rebbed the civilians of anything that they wanted for themselves. For instance, they ferribly took a blanket from a certain Miss CAGAT residing in Manite.
- 7. After the wild group left the town I buried the body of Sgt. PROZON in the cemetary. During the buriel a great majority of the tewnspeeple were present. They told me that the ZABAT group is even werse than the Japanese; nor can they be apprepriately called a guerrilla group, but a horde of bendite.
- 8. My Commanding Officer is getting all the names of the wild group's victims and also a list of the articles that they rebbed from the civilians.

A - I cannot explain because since my induction I have not been constantly with the armed group. I was staying all the time in the town of Sersegen and was sending my reports through a runner. The only times I left Sersegen was when I proceeded to Communical Norte for my mission.

Q - Do you mean that you ignore the fact that there have been killings perpetuated by your group?

A - I don't ignore the fact, sir, because it is obvious for me to knew about the killings but since my staying up in the mountains with the Lapus' group barely two months old I find myself incapable to explain.

Q - In other words you admit now that your group has killed men belenging to other groups?

A - I have only heard two men of Escudere who were killed by our group after I came up.

Q - You have heard throughout the testimonies of Mayor Daep of this town?

A - Yes, sir.

Q - What can you say about the testimenies of Mayor Duep regarding the ambushing and killing of our men by Lt. Marquez of your group? A - I am sure you have heard our testimenies.

- A I heard of the testimonies only now. I cannot say anything regards to the killing because I was still in Sørsogeh tewn.
- Q Where is Major Lapus new, de you knew?
- A He is in Ticao Islands in the town of San Jacinto.
- Q What are his activities now, do you know?
- A According to what he told us, he was designated S-2 for the Bicel Provinces by Capt. Andrews of Negroes.
