SUBJECT: RECOMMENDATION RE-CASE LT. ANACLETO DE LEMOS

TO : CO, GOLD AREA (FOR INDIVIDUAL)

1. It appears that Lt. De Lemos, left Bn. Hqrs., Gold Area, without leave on July, 1944, and reported for duty only today, October 12, 1944, a period of three (3) months of absence, an act punishable under the Articles of War.

2. It appears further, that on 8 Sept. 44, he was called to report for duty in consequence of which he remained unassigned.

3. It appears further, that said Lt. Anacleto De Lemos, left Bn. Hqrs. Gold Area, for Cebu for the purpose of being treated of toothache and tonsillitis, the medical bills being inoperative of relieving him of his ailments.

4. It appears finally, that his departure was such as to classify same as fortuitous, it being for the good of his health, without which he cannot be of any service to the Army.

5. RECOMMENDATION: From the foregoing facts the departure of Lt. De Lemos, for Cebu, without leave, being as it was fortuitous, and we may add quite beyond his control, we respectfully recommend that he be not subjected to Court-Martial. But we strongly recommend that he be reprimanded for not at least leaving a note asking permission to go somewhere else so as not to put Bn. Hqrs., at a loss where to locate him.

1. In connection with your radio message dated 6 March '44, it is with regret that I have to report the continued hostile activities of the ESCUDERO group against my Unit, in complete disregard of your instructions on the matter. On 12 April '44, my 2nd Lt. D. DUCAY, C.O., "B" Co., 1st Inf. Bn., Sorsogon, and his men, while ~~crossing~~ crossing the river at barrio Mató, Bacon, Sorsogon were fired upon by a party of ESCUDERO's following headed by one Lt. LOGRONIO. The attack was without provocation on the part of Lt. DUCAY and his party. We cannot as yet determine our casualty, as up to the present writing our Lt. DUCAY is still missing. Subject: ASSOCIATES OF XEBE THE ESCUDERO'S WILD GROUP AND THEIR ALLIANCE WITH THE NIPS.

To : MAJOR C. H. SMITH, CE-AUS, in the Field

1. You will find herewith, the original and typewritten copies of reports submitted by our Officers and Operatives regarding atrocities being committed by the ESCUDERO'S Wild Group and their alliance with the Nips. These reports are self-explanatory.
2. Letters of the Nip's Garrison Commander in Bulua, Sorsogon, addressed to OCMPC and OLGADRIZ of the ESCUDERO'S Wild Group will also be forwarded to you as soon as we receive them.
3. The presence of Lieut. RIGON, D. BARRIOS, CE-AUS, in this province, was reported to the Nips by the ESCUDERO'S Group. Consequently, the Nips proceeded to Barrio Buenavista, Sorsogon, where Lieut. CONZALES, Contact Officer of the ANDERSON GROUP, to the ESCUDERO'S went to contact Lieut. BARRIOS, on 6 July 1944. He was brought there by the courier boat of ESCUDERO from Casiguran, Sorsogon, via Barrio Gagbolo, Magallanes. Upon their arrival in Buenavista, the couriers were not allowed to land but directed to return at once. On 9 July 1944, 2 days after Lieut. CONZALES passed by that barrio, a contingent of 18 Nip soldiers with Interpreter SAKAKI, investigated the whole barrio as to my presence with Lieut. BARRIOS. This barrio is heart and soul for the cause and for our Unit. It is indeed very surprising that as Lieut. CONZALES passed by that barrio from Gagbolo, conducted by the ESCUDERO'S Group, the Nips immediately penetrated therein. Enclosed is a true copy of our letter to Lieut. BARRIOS regarding this incident.
4. These reports are being submitted to enlighten you of the connection of the ESCUDERO'S WILD GROUP with the Nips. This is the very same group which has been reported to you and which you believe as the "BIGOL LOYAL FORCES." We will continue sending these kind of reports as we deem it our duty to our people for the Higher Headquarters to know. Request that same be transmitted to the GMA-SMFA for the information and appropriate action of that High Command.

1. On 21 July '44, a group of 93 men around 60 of which were armed, under the command of ZABAT arrived at Manite and tied up Mr. JOSE DARP, the municipal mayor of said town who is a loyal supporter of the guerrillas, and our 3rd Lt. JOSE GANON, who was then in town to buy supplies. The group headed by ZABAT and LENARIZAS also caught our 1st Sgt. PENCEON of the "B" Co., 1st Bn. and after dispossessing him of his clothes cold-bloodedly murdered him publicly in the town itself. They claim that they did this because all the men under Maj. LAPUS are brigands and high-way robbers. However, they had no explanation whatsoever for their dispossessing the entire town-folk of Manite of their good clothing, food-stuff and of their subjecting the civilians to rough treatment. Several sworn statements are being taken from civilians of the abuses of these men but up to this writing they have not yet reached this Hqtrs. Enclosed is the Special Report of Lt. GANON on his detention.

2. Lt. GANON and Mayor DARP were released through the help of Lt's. BELFIN YUJICO alias JUAN DE JESUS and JOSE CRISOL. The former is an AIB representative operating in this region under the SWPA. Both of these officers can be called to testify on what really happened at Manite as they themselves were dispossessed of their undershirts by these irresponsible men.

3. Reliable informations have it that these men were on the way to contact ESCUDERO and from there to proceed to your Hqtrs. Should you learn later of your name being vulgarized around this region be advised that ZABAT'S knowledge of your presence in SAMAR cannot have come from us since they are even killing our own men in cooperation with ESCUDERO'S WILD GROUP.

4. Request that this report be forwarded to GHQ-SWPA for the information and appraisal of that high command.

5. This report is being rushed to you in order to inform you that these large group of armed men are proceeding to your place and will certainly creat a great scandal as they openly tell civilians on the way where they are headed for. It would certainly vulgarize your position again.

Subject: MY ARREST BY THE ZABAT WILD GROUP.

To: C.O. 1st INF. BN. 54th INFANTRY

1. On 21 July '44, I was arrested by the group of Col. ZABAT in the town of Manite. Upon identifying myself a Lieutenant of Major LAPUS, I was jabbed two times with a rifle and slashed with a bolo. However I escaped unscathed. I was then bound.

2. A certain Major LLENARIZA told me that he was going to turn me over to ESCUDERO because I belonged to the LAPUS group, and that the said group had been abusing the civilians. I referred him to the Mayor of Manite, but I later found out that they had bound the Mayor too. I saw also the said Major LLENARIZA jab the Mayor on the stomach with his pistol.

3. It was only good that Lieut. DELFIN YUHICO of the 7th MD, now on duty with the AIB, with Lieut. JOSE CRISSOL, P.A. arrived at Manite from Legaspi to contact Lieut. RUBEN DEUNA under Major LAPUS. It was not after Lieut. YU HICO testified on my behalf that Col. ZABAT released me. Before Mayor JOSE DAEP and I were released, we were made to sign sworn statements. Enclosed is a true copy of my sworn statement.

4. Sgt. MONITO PENZON was also caught by the same wild group that arrested me and upon knowing that he was connected with Major LAPUS was hhet, and further relieved of all his clothings and shoes; and also his side arm. We had to bury him naked.

5. Upon my arrest I was also relieved of my jacket and cash. Lieut. DELFIN YU HICO and Lieut. CRISSOL were relieved of their "camisetas" by the same wild group and according to Lieut. YU HICO, had he not immediately identified himself as an intelligence officer on duty with the AIB, he would have been also relieved of his wallet; containing all his allowance money.

6. The said wild group took one sack of rice from the Municipal Bldg. and rebbed the civilians of anything that they wanted for themselves. For instance, they forcibly took a blanket from a certain Miss CAGAT residing in Manite.

7. After the wild group left the town I buried the body of Sgt. PENZON in the cemetery. During the burial a great majority of the townspeople were present. They told me that the ZABAT group is even worse than the Japanese; nor can they be appropriately called a guerrilla group, but a horde of bandits.

8. My Commanding Officer is getting all the names of the wild group's victims and also a list of the articles that they rebbed from the civilians.

Q - State your personal circumstances.

A - Jose Canon, 22 years of age, single, resident of Sorsegen, Sor.

Q - Are you connected with any guerrilla group and if so state the name of the group and under whose command.

A - Lapus group.

Q - Since when were you connected and state your rank.

A - June 1943, with the rank of Probationary 3rd Lieutenant, Inf..

Q - Since your induction in Lapus group what activities have you already performed?

A - I have done nothing but submitting intelligence reports.

Q - Can you explain why Lapus' men are eliminating or liquidating men from other groups?

A - I cannot explain because since my induction I have not been constantly with the armed group. I was staying all the time in the town of Sorsegen and was sending my reports through a runner. The only times I left Sorsegen was when I proceeded to Camarines Norte for my mission.

Q - Do you mean that you ignore the fact that there have been killings perpetuated by your group?

A - I don't ignore the fact, sir, because it is obvious for me to know about the killings but since my staying up in the mountains with the Lapus' group barely two months old I find myself incapable to explain.

Q - In other words you admit now that your group has killed men belonging to other groups?

A - I have only heard two men of Escudero, who were killed by our group after I came up.

Q - You have heard throughout the testimonies of Mayor Daep of this town?

A - Yes, sir.

Q - What can you say about the testimonies of Mayor Daep regarding the ambushing and killing of our men by Lt. Marquez of your group?

A - I am sure you have heard our testimonies.

A - I heard of the testimonies only now. I cannot say anything regards to the killing because I was still in Sersogon town.

Q - Where is Majer Lopus now, do you know?

A - He is in Ticao Islands in the town of San Jacinto.

Q - What are his activities now, do you know?

A - According to what he told us, he was designated S-2 for the Bicol Provinces by Capt. Andrews of Negroes.

Q - Why does he not stay in Sersogon?

A - I think he finds it more safe to stay in that Islands.

Q - Will you tell us why you are here in Manite?

A - I was sent here, sir, to stay in a certain house in order for me to provide accommodations for our intelligence men the report from Legaspi.

Q - Who told you to stay here?

A - Capt. Lariza.

Q - Since when have you been staying here?

A - Twenty-eight days now.
